The angel Gabriel announces to Mary that she will conceive and bear a son and name him Jesus. Mary does not understand how this can be, and the angel explains that the Holy Spirit will come upon her and "the power of the Most High will overshadow [her]." Gabriel then tells Mary that Elizabeth, too, will bear a son, emphasizing that "nothing will be impossible for God." Mary replies, "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word."

As Christmas nears, what seems most impossible to you? Does it seem impossible that all the gifts will be bought, wrapped, and under the tree in time for Christmas morning? Does it seem impossible that you will have time to complete the preparations for and cooking of the Christmas meal? Does it seem impossible that family members will get along? Take time to talk to the Lord about these seeming impossibilities. Quietly repeat the promise of the angel Gabriel, "nothing will be impossible for God."

GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Feast of the Holy Family

Luke 2, 22-40

Maybe it is television and the Internet that has made us a spectator people. Children watch sports and become overweight. We sit in church and watch as though that is what we came for. We watch the homeless and victims of violence confused about what to do. Spectators hear next week's Gospel not knowing what to do with it, so they turn it into pageants or a movie to look at. Spectators wonder what angels look like or how a woman might conceive by the power of the Holy Spirit. At some point, we must ask the question: "What does this mean?" because this story is our story. It's about you and me with a God who has a plan for us. It is about what can happen when bad news comes, when something happens that changes our plans, our dreams, and possibly our whole life. It suggests that after pondering we might come to understand, and then with a courage that can come only from the Spirit, we might consent to the Will of God and say, "Yes" to a spirit that will bring to life what is hidden deep within us from the beginning. Every life is visited by revelations and calls for commitment. We either turn away in weakness and say: "Not me" or agree reluctantly becoming joyless people who feel cursed, or maybe let this story become our own and see what God can do with us when we let God's will become our own.

I realize that the only way for us to stay well in the midst of the many "worlds" is to stay close to the small, vulnerable child that lives in our hearts and in every other human being. Often we do not know that the Christ child is within us. When we discover him we can truly rejoice.
