

2ND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



In today's Gospel Jesus begins to call his disciples. The first two to be called were disciples of John, who pointed out to them that Jesus was the Lamb of God. Andrew, one of the two, then brought his brother Simon to Jesus, saying that Jesus was the Messiah. Those who responded to Jesus' call sensed that there was something different about this Teacher, though they did not yet understand what following him would require of them. We can sense the excitement of those first disciples when they saw Jesus and received Jesus' invitation to follow him. They literally stopped what they were doing and followed him, inviting others to join them along the way. Today is a good day to think about our own level of excitement when we hear the words of Jesus spoken in the Gospels or see him in others around us. Do we share enthusiasm for our faith in Jesus with our children? Do we, through our words and

actions, lead them to him? How so?



GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Third Sunday in Ordinary Time *Mark 1, 14-20*

Mark's Gospel has few words. They all count. He wastes no words on unimportant details. Peter and Andrew were successful at their trade. We know that because they had extended family living in their home. Remember Peter's mother-in-law? There were boats and nets and men. Jesus was calling people with skills who were using them well. He did not call them to stop what they were doing exactly. He did not say: "Stop fishing." He asked them to do it all in a different way, for a different reason, with a different motive. What we hear today is an invitation to look at our skills, our gifts and pay attention to what we are doing and why we are doing it. God does not ask us to abandon what we do best, what we do well, what we know how to do. God asks us to use our gifts and skills for the right reason - for the glory of God and the building up of the Kingdom of God. He does not ask mothers and fathers to leave their children, doctors to leave their patients, teachers to abandon their class or students to leave their studies. He simply says that for the Kingdom of God to come we must nurture each other with a parent's love, encourage, and protect. We must heal broken spirits, learn wisdom and truth and help others discover their skills and gifts. This is discipleship. It is not something unusual. It is what we are doing and why.



In the first reading, Eli, tells Samuel to say, "Speak Lord, for your servant is listening."

Are we listening for the Lord to speak to us? We need to quiet our hearts and mind to listen to what the Lord wants us to do. What is Jesus asking us to do, in this beginning of the new year, are we listening? Do we give Jesus a chance to speak to us?
