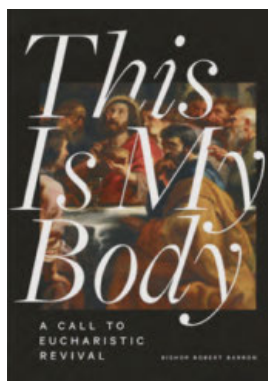
GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Mark 1, 21-28

Amazement gets Mark's attention next week, or the amazement of the people he reports. What I think amazes those people is that something they lived with and avoided or ignored all the time got the attention of Jesus. The authority of the past told them to avoid evil. Pretend it isn't there. Stay away, look the other way and everything will be fine. And so, things only got worse. Notice where this episode takes place: in a holy place at a holy time, Synagogue and Sabbath. Holiness confronts evil! This new authority suggest that holiness is not possible by ignoring evil or pretending it is not there. This is not about evil in someone else. This is about how one attains holiness within themselves. Holiness is about getting it out, silencing the tempting voice of evil not pretending it isn't there. Ultimately holiness is about confronting denial, and we have plenty of it. We have accommodated and denied the seductive voice of violence, avoided facing the evil of poverty and homelessness. We make boundaries where there ought to be none setting ourselves apart out of fear and suspicion about others when their ought to be compassion and respect. Any accommodation of evil within us will not bring us to holiness. We might be amazed at what can happen when we cease denial and embrace the kind of change and conversion to which Jesus calls.

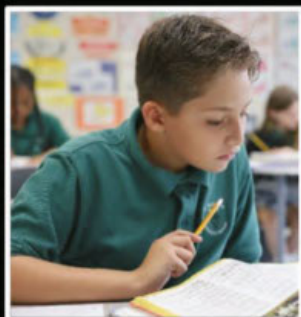

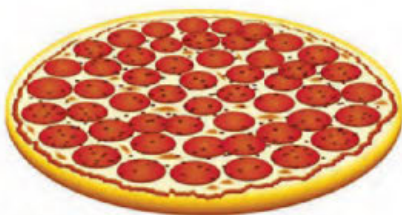

What is Eucharistic Adoration?

The Eucharist is the True Presence of Jesus, the son of God who died so that humankind could have eternal hope. Catholics believe that, in Holy Communion, we receive the actual body of Jesus. In that moment, you share in Christ's suffering on the cross. It's a sobering, beautiful concept to meditate on, one that can leave you overwhelmed with love and adoration for Jesus and His salvation by His cross and resurrection.

What to Expect. The symbol of the cross is front and center during Eucharistic Adoration. A consecrated Host is displayed in a monstrance and respectfully placed in a special place to be worshiped and adored, usually on the altar or a smaller room nearby. At St Agnes, the Adoration chapel is in the Narthex of the main church. As you enter through the front doors, the chapel will be on the right, near the bookstand and the Blessings store.

When you enter a time of adoring the Eucharist, you can have faith that you're entering into the true, substantial presence of Jesus. As you contemplate drawing near the blood, body, divinity, and soul of Jesus Christ, you can experience a rejuvenation of spiritual nourishment and strength in a more unique, powerful way than you might experience in your daily prayers.

What do I do? There are no specific rules about what you should do during Eucharistic Adoration. Just "be there" in Jesus' presence. Reflect on His work on the cross and adore Him for all He has done for you and humankind. That would be a time of Eucharistic Adoration well-spent. Traditional things to do during Adoration are: pray the rosary, journal, read scripture, daily devotional or a religious book, listen to music on your headphones, pray on your own.

Etiquette. Dress modestly and respectfully, your attire reflects the sanctity of the occasion. Turn off or silence your electronic devices to maintain the tranquility of the space. Genuflect or bow as you approach and leave the Blessed Sacrament to express your reverence. Keep conversations to a minimum, allowing others to immerse themselves in the sacred silence. Be mindful of your movements, minimizing distractions to ensure a focused atmosphere.
