Today's Gospel finds Jesus teaching in the synagogue in Capernaum. The people were surprised that he taught with such authority. They were amazed when he confronted and cast out an evil spirit from a man who was among them. The evil spirit called Jesus "the Holy One of God." Those who witnessed this power and authority spread word of Jesus throughout Galilee. Today is a good day to consider how we use our power and authority as parents, as bosses or supervisors, as coaches, as captain of the team or class president. Do we use our power and authority for the good of others? Do we use our power and authority to bring about positive change? Do we use our power and authority

to guide our children or others in the ways of holiness and righteousness? Our use of power and authority has the potential to lift people up or to tear them down. The words we choose, the tone of voice we use, and the actions we take reveal to our family members, to friends, and to others that it is Jesus Christ who has authority over our lives.


GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time Mark 1, 29-39

It's just the first chapter of Mark's Gospel, and already Jesus is making it clear that what matters is not power, but service. It is not about Jesus, but about what God can do. I think that is why he keeps telling the demons to keep quiet because they keep pointing to him, making him the focus of attention making it more difficult for Jesus to get his point across that we must go and do what he does. The crowds

want to watch, but there can be no spectators when it comes to service. Excusing ourselves from doing what Jesus does because he was the "Son of God" is exactly what the demons are out to accomplish. It puts a stop to the work of God in this world. This story is not about power. It is about service. It is about seeing what needs to be done and doing it. Notice where this miracle happens. There is no one there to see it and no one to impress. Miracles are not a show of power to stir up the curious. They are moments when one human being sees the need of another and quietly responds to that need with the gifts they have. Nothing Jesus did was for crowds in spite of how impressed the apostles seem to be by their growing numbers. He knows the crowds will be gone one day. What Mark would have us see is what can happen when one person does whatever is in their power to ease the suffering of another. That is a miracle.

BEGIN WITH THE END

What are your plans? We often hear that from co-workers, our boss, our family they want to know what we are doing and how we have planned to accomplish our goals. It is a road map for how and when to achieve what we have set out to do.

The management guru Stephen Covey in his best-selling book "The Seven Habits of Highly Successful People" lists the second habit as "begin with the end in mind." Have a clear understanding of your destination and then take the steps that will move you in the right direction.

As disciples of Jesus, if we genuinely want to get to heaven, then we need to start with the end (heaven) in mind and begin preparing for it daily. Our friendship with Jesus does not remain static. Every decision we make, even the tiny ones, either moves us closer to Jesus or moves us farther away. Because God loves us so much, He does not want us to move backwards.

Here are some ideas to help us prepare...

Become God-centered. What are those other "gods" that you place before God? Try giving some of them up and spend time in daily conversation with God. Fasting is not a punishment. Fasting allows us to gain power over physical desires, grow in gratitude, accept suffering, be more patient and ultimately "empty" ourselves to be "filled" by God.

Become others centered. Our relationship with Jesus is personal, but it is not meant to be private. Share your faith story with others. No one can argue with you about your relationship with Jesus! It is your story. That should give you the strength and courage to share it with others. It may be uncomfortable at first, but that is the cost of a great reward. Someone said, "Isn't a little awkwardness on earth worth eternal life with God in heaven?"

Focus on children, youth, and young adults. As kids, we were asked, "What do you want to be when you grow up?" We should change the question to, "What do you think God wants you to become." Unfortunately, too many children and young adults do not see God as an option in their lives because no one talks to them about it.

Start with the end in mind. Prepare for the coming of Jesus. Encourage others to do the same.

Centrarse en los demás. Nuestra relación con Jesús es personal, pero no debe ser privada. Comparte tu historia de fe con otros. ¡Nadie puede discutir contigo sobre tu relación con Jesús! Es tu historia. Eso debería darte la fuerza y el coraje para compartirlo con los demás. Puede resultar incómodo al principio, pero ese es el costo de una gran recompensa. Enfocarnos en niños, jóvenes y adultos jóvenes. Cuando éramos niños, nos preguntaban: "¿Qué quieres ser cuando seas grande?" 



What is Eucharistic Adoration?


The Eucharist is the True Presence of Jesus, the son of God who died so that humankind could have eternal hope. Catholics believe that, in Holy Communion, we receive the actual body of Jesus. In that moment, you share in Christ's suffering on the cross. It's a sobering, beautiful concept to meditate on, one that can leave you overwhelmed with love and adoration for Jesus and His salvation by His cross and resurrection.

What to Expect. The symbol of the cross is front and center during Eucharistic Adoration. A consecrated Host is displayed in a monstrance and respectfully placed in a special place to be worshiped and adored, usually on the altar or a smaller room nearby. At St Agnes, the Adoration chapel is in the Narthex of the main church. As you enter through the front doors, the chapel will be on the right, near the bookstand and the Blessings store.

When you enter a time of adoring the Eucharist, you can have faith that you're entering into the true, substantial presence of Jesus. As you contemplate drawing near the blood, body, divinity, and soul of Jesus Christ, you can experience a rejuvenation of spiritual nourishment and strength in a more unique, powerful way than you might experience in your daily prayers.

What do I do? There are no specific rules about what you should do during Eucharistic Adoration. Just "be there" in Jesus' presence. Reflect on His work on the cross and adore Him for all He has done for you and humankind. That would be a time of Eucharistic Adoration well-spent. Traditional things to do during Adoration are: pray the rosary, journal, read scripture, daily devotional or a religious book, listen to music on your headphones, pray on your own.

Etiquette. Dress modestly and respectfully, your attire reflects the sanctity of the occasion. Turn off or silence your electronic devices to maintain the tranquility of the space. Genuflect or bow as you approach and leave the Blessed Sacrament to express your reverence. Keep conversations to a minimum, allowing others to immerse themselves in the sacred silence. Be mindful of your movements, minimizing distractions to ensure a focused atmosphere.




