4TH SUNDAY OF LENT



Jesus tells us in today's Gospel that he is the Good Shepherd. He makes a distinction between good shepherds and hired hands. Good shepherds truly care for, guard, and protect their sheep. Hired hands are more likely to run at the first sign of trouble. As a good shepherd, Jesus knows his sheep and his sheep know him. Jesus is so devoted to his sheep that he will lay down his life for them. Think of all the people who share in the task of teaching, guiding, and protecting your child. Who among those people is truly a good shepherd—a person who invests himself or herself in your child's life? Who are the "hired hands"—those who are less personally invested, but are still a part of your child's circle of formation and care? Think about your own role as a parent. How are you being a good shepherd to your child and to your family? Are there any "wolves" in your life, drawing your attention away from the flock God has placed

in your care?

GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Fifth Sunday of Lent John 12, 20-33

They want to see Jesus. They want to see this Rabbi who out talked the Pharisees and humbled the Scribes. Then he talks about falling to the ground and being lifted up. They know what that means. So, they just want to see Jesus not get mixed up in this service and forgiveness stuff, turning the other cheek, and losing one's life. This business of "seeing" Jesus means understanding much as when something has been explained to us and we say, "Oh, I see." With that

been explained to us and we say, "Oh, I see." With that understanding comes the decision to look and watch or follow and participate. One or the other. The question this Gospel will raise for us next week is whether we want to look or do we want to go further. This Gospel calls us to distinguish between admiring Jesus and following him. It looks at whether or not we just keep our distance or actually step in and become what we admire. In Johns' Gospel there are twenty-six references to "the hour" by which Jesus means not a time of day, but the beginning of the reason for which he has come among us, the redemption of sinners and his return of them to God. We have come now in Lent to the "hour," when we shall determine who is here to see and who is here to understand: who is here to look at Jesus and who is to become one with him. It is now our hour - Holy Week begins.



You are mine. You belong to me, and I love you with an everlasting love."

THE JOURNEY OF FAITH

Do you believe in the Son of Man? That question of Jesus to the blind man whom He had cured is the climax of the Gospel we will hear this coming Sunday, the Fourth Sunday of Lent. Jesus had cured him of his physical blindness, but that was only the beginning of the story. Jesus was intent on doing infinitely more for him — to bring him to a greater light, the vision of faith in Him as the Light of the world. Jesus gave the man born blind physical sight so that he would come to see with the new eyes of faith the truth about Him, about life and about its destiny.

I invite you to meditate on the journey of faith of the man born blind. At first, he did not know who Jesus was. Gradually, he came to recognize Jesus as a man of God, a prophet, then he came to believe that Jesus is the Son of Man, the Son of God. Jesus asked him: Do you believe in the Son of Man? Very honestly, the blind man asked in reply: Who is he, sir, that I may believe in him? Jesus told him that it was He. The man then said: I do believe, Lord. And then he worshipped Jesus.

We are all on this journey of faith. We can call it "a baptismal journey." That is how Lent began — a journey of catechumens, a journey to baptism, to illumination by the light of Christ. Through Baptism, we received the light of Christ. We will remember this in a dramatic way in the liturgy of the Easter Vigil. But after Baptism, we can fall back into darkness because of our sins. That is why we have this season of Lent, a time of conversion and spiritual renewal, to live our identity as those St. Paul calls "children of light."

A whole new world opened for the blind man when he professed his faith in Jesus and worshipped Him. He entered a new relationship with God by following Christ. The same happens to us. We learn to adapt our life to the will of God and to bring Christ's light to our neighbors.

EL VIAJE DE LA FE

¿Crees en el Hijo del Hombre? Esa pregunta de Jesús al ciego a quien había curado es el clímax del Evangelio que escucharemos el próximo domingo, el Cuarto Domingo de Cuaresma. Jesús lo había curado de su ceguera física, pero eso fue sólo el comienzo de la historia. Jesús tenía la intención de hacer infinitamente más por él: llevarlo a una luz mayor, la visión de la fe en Él como la Luz del mundo. Jesús le dio la vista física al hombre nacido ciego para que pudiera ver con los nuevos ojos de la fe la verdad sobre Él, sobre la vida y sobre su destino.

Los invito a meditar sobre el camino de fe del ciego de nacimiento. Al principio no sabía quién era Jesús. Poco a poco llegó a reconocer a Jesús como un hombre de Dios, un profeta, luego llegó a creer que Jesús es el Hijo del Hombre, el Hijo de Dios. Jesús le preguntó: ¿Crees en el Hijo del Hombre? Muy sinceramente, el ciego preguntó en respuesta: ¿Quién es, señor, para que yo crea en él? Jesús le dijo que era Él. Entonces el hombre dijo: Yo sí creo, Señor. Y luego adoró a Jesús.

Todos estamos en este camino de fe. Podemos llamarlo "un viaje bautismal". Así comenzó la Cuaresma: un camino de catecúmenos, un camino hacia el bautismo, hacia la iluminación por la luz de Cristo. Por el bautismo recibimos la luz de Cristo. Lo recordaremos de manera dramática en la liturgia de la Vigilia Pascual. Pero después del bautismo, podemos volver a caer en las tinieblas a causa de nuestros pecados. Por eso tenemos este tiempo de Cuaresma, un tiempo de conversión y renovación espiritual, para vivir nuestra identidad como aquellos que San Pablo llama "hijos de la luz".

Un mundo completamente nuevo se abrió para el ciego cuando profesó su fe en Jesús y lo adoró. Entró en una nueva relación con Dios al seguir a Cristo. A nosotros nos pasa lo mismo. Aprendemos a adaptar nuestra vida a la voluntad de Dios y a llevar la luz de Cristo a nuestro prójimo.

A tradition of those with Polish and Eastern European ancestry is the traditional blessing of Easter Food Baskets on Holy Saturday. In earlier times, the priest came to people's homes to bless the food, but today, the people go to church for these blessings and prayers. It has been a tradition at St. Agnes for people to bring baskets of food that they will serve on Easter to be blessed in the church in English and Polish at 2 p.m. on Holy Saturday.

There is a symbolic meaning to some of the foods included in the baskets; Bread for new life with Jesus seen as the "Bread of Life;" Sausage or ham for health, prosperity and

the belief in the Resurrection; horseradish/vinegar to ensure physical strength and remind us of the agony suffered by Christ on the cross; and salt for wisdom, justice and purification. Candles also signify Jesus as the Light of the world and finally, eggs indicate hope, new life and Jesus' Resurrection which may or may not be colored. These are just a few! We invite you to join us and find meaning in this beautiful tradition!

The Easter Egg Hunt takes place immediately following the Food Blessing for ages 1-10 (older children are welcome to help).

Each participant is asked to bring 12 filled plastic eggs (no chocolate) & one non-perishable item for St. Vincent DePaul food bank.



Meet Gloriose, our neighbor in Rwanda

Living in Kigali, Rwanda, Gloriose Uwamahoro and her husband Karekezi Jean Pierre are no strangers to hardship and hard work. Driven by a dream to send their three children to a good school, Gloriose sells vegetables and water in a kiosk and Karekezi sells vegetables at a market. They faced many challenges. Their daughter was malnourished—like many other children in their village. In Gikuriro, a project led by CRS, Gloriose learned how to prepare balanced meals for her children, about the importance of good hygiene, and how to grow a kitchen garden. She later joined a CRS-led micro-savings group and learned how loans could help her grow her business and make more money. Now she earns enough to support her family. She and Karekezi can now afford to fulfill their dream of sending their kids to school.

Gloriose says that by participating in the program, "a woman has been given a voice...It wasn't a thing before for a woman to speak up...or borrow a certain amount of money and use it to make profit and pay it back," she says. "That is something to be thankful for."

Each person is made by God and therefore each life is sacred and valuable.

programs.




