



Welcome students from St. John Neumann & homeschool students seeking Confirmation!

While Religious Education takes place in Catholic Schools or through a Homeschool Curriculum, Sacrament Preparation takes place through a two year program in your home parish.* If St. Agnes is your home parish and you are seeking Confirmation for your child, here are some notes for you.

Notes for Catholic School & Homeschool Students Seeking Confirmation

Registration (early discount deadline 8/18/25):

- Be sure your family is officially registered as parishioners of St. Agnes as your home parish.*
- Have a copy of the student's Baptism and First Communion certificates ready to upload.
- Fill out the faith formation registration form at www.StAgnesNaples.org, uploading documents.
- Pick up the Confirmation Guide at Parent/Student Night on 9/07/25.

Follow the Confirmation Calendar and Checklist, with these special considerations:


- **Youth Group** attendance is not required but highly encouraged. The SJN students involved in the St. Agnes Youth Group have shared that they have significantly developed their leadership skills, enjoyed the blessings of group missionary trips, and bonded with a broader community of youth than they ever thought possible. Their presence has made a profound difference by fostering understanding, friendship, service, leadership, prayer, joy, adventure, community, and fun!
- **School Mass** attendance excuses the student from the same Mass when it is part of the Confirmation calendar, such as Ash Wednesday and Holy Thursday. The Mass Journal should be filled out at Sunday Masses (and other holy days of obligation) at St. Agnes.
- **Service** done outside the parish is to be pre-approved by Robert Massey, Youth Minister via email. Include the dates, hours, name of the service agency/supervisor, and the description of the activity. As you complete the service, record it on the Service Reflection Log pages in the *Guide*.
- **Retreats** made with groups other than St. Agnes is to be pre-approved by Robert Massey, Youth Minister, via email. Record completion of the retreat on the Retreat Reflection page of the *Guide*.
