Dear parents,

Thank you for seeking the Sacrament of Confirmation for your child. The preparation is a healthy balance of Community, Knowledge, and Spirituality. It is designed to assist you in building a firm foundation for the rest of their life. Since each element is indispensable for their growth in the faith at this age, everything listed on both sides of this page is mandatory. If the busyness of life tries to get in the way of building this firm foundation in the faith—don't get overwhelmed or discouraged! Reach out to us early with any concerns; we are here to work with you to make the best plan for your family.

# **Checklist for Teen Confirmation Preparation Year 1 (C1) & Year 2 (C2)**

Pre-requisite: complete registration paperwork. All additional paperwork and chapters are included in the *Confirmation Guide* **All items due by 3/01/26 so that Confirmation be not delayed.** 

## Community

- □ C1 & C2: attend mandatory parent/student night Sept. 7 at 6:30pm in the parish center & pick up the *Confirmation Guide*.
- □ C1 & C2: Participate in Life Nights, special Masses, and events listed on the calendar and in weekly emails. Attend as often as you can and don't forget to sign in.
- □ C1 & C2: Complete 3 service reflections. Students will have the opportunity to complete this requirement during Youth Group Events; details are sent in weekly emails.
- □ C1: Complete sponsor form. A local sponsor is preferable because their role to assist parents throughout preparation and beyond; if you do not know anyone qualified, we can help you find someone.
- □ C1 & C2: Be a registered and active member of the parish community, making a trackable family donation at least 4x/year. Optional: pass on the habit of stewardship by helping your student use the Children's Envelopes handed out at orientation.

### Knowledge

- □ C1 & C2: Complete all Chosen Confirmation chapters in the *Guide* (ch.1-12).
- □ C2: Prepare for a written/oral exam using the Confirmation Study Guide.
- □ C2: Write a letter to the Bishop following the instructions in the *Guide*.

## Spirituality

- □ C1 & C2: Regular Sunday Mass attendance (at least 15 times at St. Agnes completing Mass Journal entries).
- □ C1 & C2: Bring your *Guide* in **December 7, 4:30-7:30pm** for a mid-year check; 7 Mass Journals must be completed and the Chosen Confirmation chapters begun. Any missing paperwork must be turned in.
- □ C1: Complete the Saint Essay about a canonized saint (of the same gender as the student) to help the candidate reflect on their unique call to live a faithful Catholic life.
- □ C1: Participate in at least one retreat and complete the Retreat Reflection in the *Guide*; options will be sent in the weekly email as they become available.
- □ C2: Dress rehearsal and celebration of Confirmation for teens and sponsors is determined by the Bishop and is usually announced in January.

No matter what is going on in your life that makes this journey toward Confirmation difficult, know that you belong in the Church and that we are here to work with you!
