WORD of LIFE

Family Faith Formation & First Communion Year 2

Dear parents and guardians,

We look forward to fulfilling together the parental responsibility accepted at Baptism to "train the child in the practice of the faith" through Family Faith Formation. This program is a healthy balance of Family, Faith, and Formation. It is designed to assist you in building a firm foundation for the rest of their life. Faith Formation has eternal significance; please prioritize accordingly: mark your calendars and set reminders so that sharing the treasure of our Catholic Faith with your children doesn't get lost in the shuffle. If the busyness of life tries to get in the way—don't get overwhelmed or discouraged! Reach out to us early with any concerns; we are here to work with you to make the best plan for your family.

Checklist for Family Faith Formation:

St. Agnes:

- □ Be a registered and active member of the parish community, making a trackable family donation at least 4x/year.
- ⇒ Optional: pass on the habit of stewardship by helping your children use the Childrens Envelopes.

Family:

- Participate in at least 7 monthly classes/events, no more than 2 absences. 2-4pm classes are in the parish center, beginning with a light lunch 2-2:15. At least one parent or guardian must attend with their student. Bring your bag with the *Word of Life* chapters completed and the *Guide*. If you miss a class, attend the make up class at home via Teams Meeting; watch your email for the link.
- ⇒ Optional/go further: Find additional family event opportunities in the Sunday bulletin or announced at class.

Faith:

- Regular Sunday Mass attendance (at least 15 times at St. Agnes, completing Mass Journal entries by 4/03/26).
- ⇒ Optional/go deeper: participate in Children's Liturgy of the Word at the 11am Mass.

Formation:

- □ Complete student textbook by 4/03/26 (student writes in all spaces).
- ⇒ Optional/go beyond: create a free formed.org account and enjoy children & family content; it's like Catholic Netflix!



How to do the Word of Life homework:

- 1. Plan a time and place to meet weekly as a family, completing one chapter per week.
- 2. Preview the student chapter, check out chapter resources on the Parent Portal, and gather any materials needed.
- 3. Open with prayer. You may choose to do one of the traditional prayers that children should practice memorizing, full text is in the back of the student workbook.
- 4. Sit with your children, guiding them through the lesson. This can be done by the parent working one-on-one with each child or the older siblings pairing up with the younger ones, helping to read sections to them and guide them through the activities.
- 5. Make sure every activity in the assignment is complete before turning in the student workbook.
- 6. Close with prayer.
- 7. Reward your child for a job well done.

If you have any trouble completing the chapters at home, contact the Faith Formation office as soon as possible so that we can serve you though a workbook instruction appointment.

Preparing for First Communion?

Two complete consecutive years of faith formation are required. During Year 2, students must complete the **additional Year 2 requirements**:

- □ Participate in the monthly Year 2 classes, no more than 1 absence; the appropriate chapters in the *Signs of Grace* book must be submitted complete within 1 week of any absence. 2-4pm classes are in the parish center, beginning with a light lunch 2-2:15. At least one parent or guardian must attend with their student. Bring your bag with the *Signs of Grace* books to each session.
- Recite the Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be, and Act of Contrition from memory; email a video of the student praying clearly with their eyes closed to rose@stagnesnaples.org by Dec. 4 or stay after class to recite in person on Dec. 7.
- □ Review the Study Guide to be ready to pass the exams on Dec. 7 & April 26.
- □ Attend rehearsals & celebrations.
