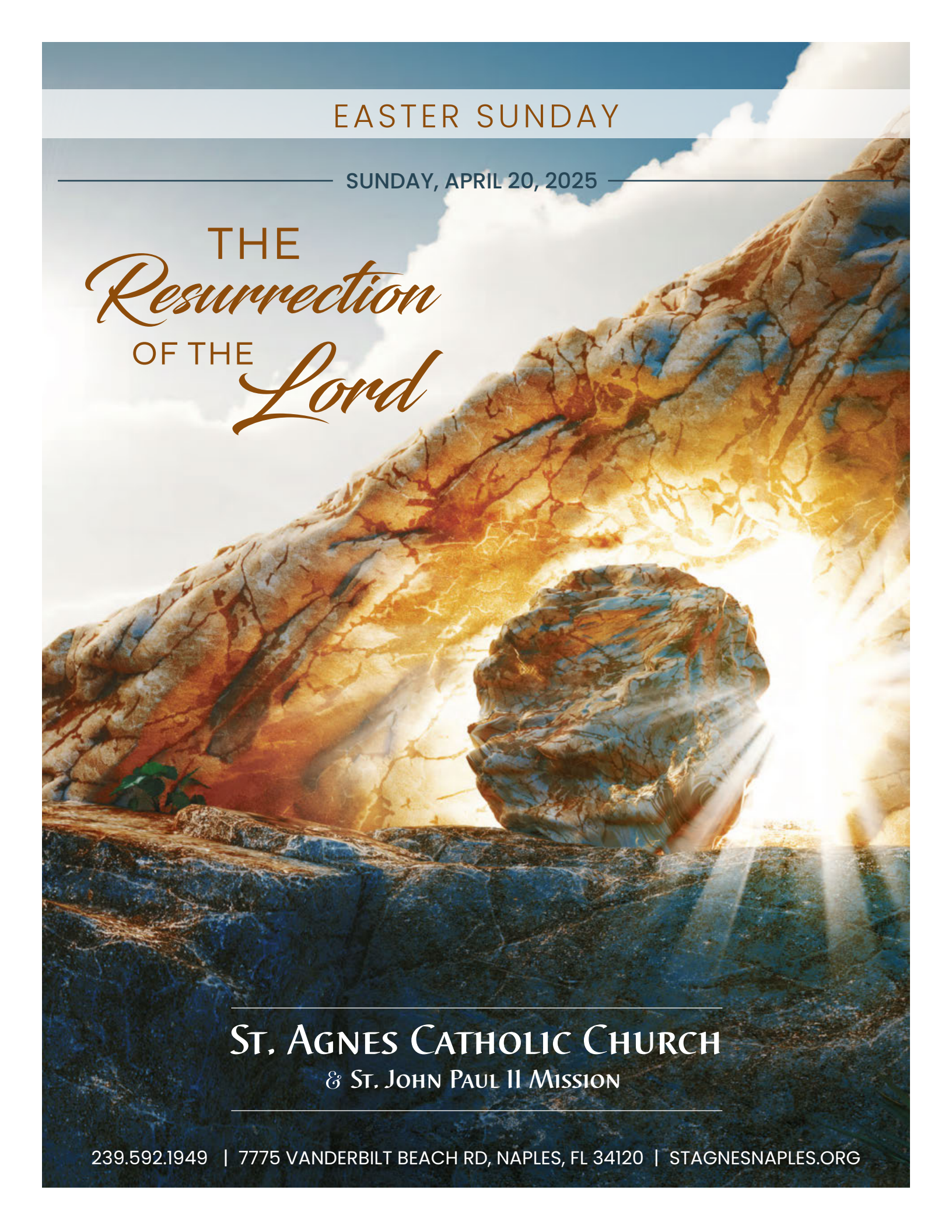

EASTER SUNDAY OF THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD



On Friday afternoon when Jesus died, the women had not been able to finish the customary preparation for burial. The Sabbath began at sundown on Friday, so Mary of Magdala hurried to the tomb Sunday morning to complete her task. She found the tomb empty. Certain that Jesus' body had been stolen, she ran back to get the other disciples. Peter and the other disciple also found an empty tomb but with Jesus' clothing rolled neatly and placed where his body had been. The disciples still didn't understand about the resurrection and Mary wept. As she cried, two angels appeared asking why she was crying. She then saw a gardener and asked him where the body might be. When he called her by name, Mary immediately recognized Jesus. Place symbols of Easter such as lighted candles, eggs, and lilies on your dinner table today. Discuss how these items might have become symbols for Easter. What do they suggest to us about the gospel story we read today? How can we be symbols of the Easter message to each other and those outside our family?

GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Second Sunday of Easter (Divine Mercy)

John 20: 19-31

The familiar story of Thomas comes to us next week. Something kept him from believing. I think he could not believe because he could not imagine that God would act this way; that God would let his friend and companion, Jesus, die. He could not imagine that God could accomplish something this way. He wanted evidence. He wanted "scientific proof." He wanted to touch. But, when he had the chance, he didn't touch. The invitation invited to do more than touch. He was invited to believe in something he did not understand. He was invited to believe that God could do more than Thomas could imagine, and that God could turn a tragedy into some extraordinary and good. The limits that Thomas had placed on what God could do as well as where God was had to go before Thomas could believe. What happened to him that day when he spoke those words, "My Lord and my God" was that the boundaries of his limited expectations of how God works and where God is to be found broke open. God was present in that nail-pierced man with an opening in his side. God was acting and saving, raising up, and healing in a way no one ever thought of. Easter is still a challenge to the boundaries we imagine and the expectations we have about how God works. It is also a challenge to our ideas about life and death, power and weakness, suffering and strength.

Easter Reflection from Fr. Bob

Easter is the high point in the life of Christians. So many come to church on this day because the Resurrection is the most important defining event of our Faith. Jesus' birth, life, and teaching would have been enough, but God had something greater in store. Even occasional churchgoers know this is the day above all days because Jesus really did rise from the dead. And we must celebrate!

One of the interesting things about encounters with the risen Christ in the Bible is that Jesus was not immediately recognized by those who saw him. Mary Magdalene mistook our Lord for a gardener. The apostles who returned to their fishing profession realized it was Him at the seashore only after he prepared them a meal. The disciples on the road to Emmaus recognized Him in the breaking of the bread when they came together for dinner. Today also, God is not always immediately perceived in the events of our life. But rest assured that he is there in our joys and sorrows, in our triumphs and tragedies, and they all lead to eternal life with Him if we keep our eyes fixed on Him and remain faithful.

At Easter, the joyful hymns, white lilies, and proclamation of an empty tomb are more than mere tradition. Easter lives in us, raising our hearts and minds to God and giving meaning to suffering and sacrifice. Today, there are many in the world who are enduring the darkness of war in places like Ukraine and the Middle East, not far from where Jesus walked the earth. Others are recovering from terrible natural disasters that have caused death and destruction in our country and around the world.

Where is God in all of that? Right with those who are suffering most. And God is in every person who performs an act of kindness to uplift or assist someone in need. If we are true disciples of Christ, our indwelling God makes himself known in us, and we must carry the light of the risen Christ to them. May the Risen Christ bless and strengthen your families this Easter. May you remain safe and well in body, mind and spirit. SACRED HEART HOLY HOUR Friday, May 2nd • 4pm • In the Church



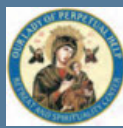

- Keep Plastic Bags Out of Recycling: Keep plastic bags of all kinds out of your recycling bin.



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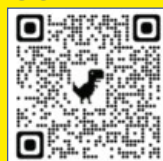
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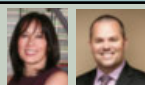
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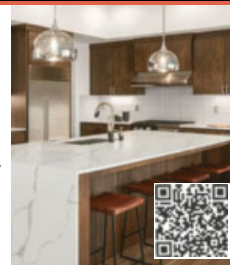


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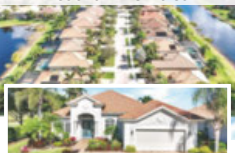
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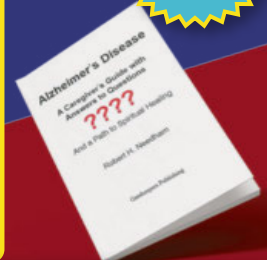
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
