SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



Jesus upset a few Jewish norms in this Gospel about Mary and Martha. First it was unusual for a single man to be a guest in the home of a single woman, and secondly, it was usually the most acclaimed male student of a rabbi who received tutoring such as Mary. It was not the break in these norms that disturbed Mary's sister, Martha, so much as the fact that Mary sat listening to Jesus' teaching instead of helping her sister with the responsibilities of hospitality. Jesus, of course, knew that it was important to tend to the household chores, but he also wanted to make the point that in order to love and serve God, it was important to hear the Word of God. Listen to God's Word together as a family. Have each member of the family share a favorite Bible story. Depending on the ages of people, either retell a story, read it from the Bible or use a children's Bible. When the family member is finished telling his/her story, have that person explain why it is a favorite story and how the story helps us live today according to the way God wants us to live.

GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke 11: 1-13

In ancient times, the words that Jesus gives his disciples were never shared with anyone not trusted and known to be a follower of Christ. It is no accident that these words are spoken just before Communion at Mass followed by the greeting of peace. This prayer is about relationships. There are only plural pronouns like we and us. It is hard to understand in a world of individuals that finds relationships disposable. The private and isolated individuals who live in a world of singular pronouns like "me" and "I" never get it. Their world of possessions, protection, and hoarding does not enter into the mystery of prayer as Jesus teaches. This prayer is never better said, offered, and spoken than when it is prayed together in your homes and in our church. It is never more effective than when it draws us together as different religious traditions, as different people, and as different families. Spoken alone, it is a promise of what is to come in the communion of saints and the private longing we have to never be alone. Spoken together it is the realization of what Jesus has come to fulfill; the unity, the reconciliation, the peace and the promise of the Kingdom that some by his presence.

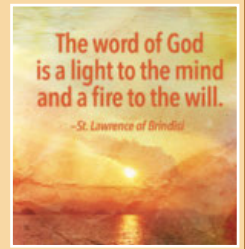

Martha was annoyed that Mary simply sat and listened to Jesus while she did all the work. How often do we feel the same way, whether at home or at work?

Mary shows us how a true disciple listens. As a woman in her society, Mary was a marginalized figure, just like the Samaritan. Both did what was not expected of them. In that time, women like Mary were expected, like Martha, to focus on preparing hospitality for guests. Yet again, Jesus breaks with the social conventions of his era. Just as no one would expect a Samaritan to be a model of compassion, no one would expect a woman to sit among the men at the feet of a teacher.

These two examples — the Samaritan and Mary — highlight the essentials of life in God’s Kingdom: loving God with all our heart and loving our neighbor. By using these unexpected figures, Jesus shows us that to truly love God and our neighbor, we must sometimes break social norms and boundaries. The Kingdom of God is a society without distinctions, where everyone is called to both action and contemplation — moments of doing and moments of listening and learning at the feet of the Teacher.

Jesus did not minimize the importance of Martha’s service. He focused instead on her attitude while serving. The last thing Jesus wants is for us to simply sit passively while others do all the work. That is neither the Christian way nor the example Jesus gave us.

Like Martha, we are called to serve and work hard for others. But we are called to do so with Mary’s spirit — to have Martha’s hands and Mary’s contemplative heart. When we work, study, or care for our families, we should remain focused on Jesus, letting ourselves be nourished by Him even as we act. In this way, we not only serve through our work but also share Christ Himself, working within us.

This is the vocation of every Christian: to be active like Martha, but with the heart of Mary — deeply centered on Christ.

LA MEJOR PARTE

Marta estaba molesta porque María simplemente se sentó a escuchar a Jesús mientras ella hacía todo el trabajo. ¿Cuántas veces nos sentimos igual, ya sea en casa o en el trabajo?

María nos muestra cómo debe escuchar un verdadero discípulo. Como mujer en su sociedad, María era una persona marginada, al igual que el samaritano. Ambos hicieron lo que no se esperaba de ellos. En aquella época, a las mujeres como María se les esperaba, al igual que a Marta, que se dedicaran a preparar la hospitalidad para los invitados. Una vez más, Jesús rompe con las convenciones sociales de su tiempo. Así como nadie esperaba que un samaritano fuera modelo de compasión, tampoco se esperaba que una mujer se sentara entre los hombres a los pies de un maestro.

Estos dos ejemplos —el samaritano y María— destacan lo esencial de la vida en el Reino de Dios: amar a Dios con todo el corazón y amar al prójimo. Al utilizar figuras inesperadas, Jesús nos muestra que para amar verdaderamente a Dios y al prójimo, a veces es necesario romper normas y límites sociales. El Reino de Dios es una sociedad sin distinciones, donde todos estamos llamados tanto a la acción como a la contemplación —momentos para hacer y momentos para escuchar y aprender a los pies del Maestro.

Jesús no minimizó la importancia del servicio de Marta. Más bien, se enfocó en la actitud con la que ella servía. Lo último que Jesús quería sería que todos nos sentáramos pasivamente mientras otros trabajan para servirnos. Ese no es el camino cristiano ni el ejemplo que Él nos dio.

Como Marta, estamos llamados a servir y trabajar arduamente por los demás. Pero debemos hacerlo con el espíritu de María: tener las manos de Marta y el corazón contemplativo de María. Cuando trabajamos, estudiamos o cuidamos de nuestras familias, debemos permanecer enfocados en Jesús, dejándonos alimentar por Él incluso en medio de la acción. De esta manera, no solo servimos a través de nuestro trabajo, sino que también compartimos al mismo Cristo que obra en nosotros.

Esta es la vocación de todo cristiano: ser activos como Marta, pero con el corazón de María, siempre centrados profundamente en Cristo.

A STATEMENT FROM BISHOP FRANK J. DEWANE ON IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT, JULY 3, 2025

As the new detention center becomes operational at Dade-Collier Airport, or “Alligator Alcatraz,” it seems necessary to take stock of recent developments in immigration enforcement and the need for further improvements to our wider immigration system.

Broad Support for Actions Against Criminals

In describing immigration enforcement initiatives, the Trump administration has stated its focus is on removing criminal aliens who endanger public safety. This concern is widely shared. There is no argument with this. However, the need for just immigration enforcement and the government’s obligation to carry it out must be undertaken in a way that is targeted, humane and proportional.

Growing Recognition of Contributions of Immigrants

There is also a growing recognition that many, indeed most immigrants, even those who are not lawfully present, are not dangerous but peaceful, law-abiding, and hardworking contributors to our communities and to our economy. President Trump has acknowledged this in his recent remarks establishing a farm pass for those working in the agriculture industry.

Concern for strategies and rhetoric failing to respond to the dignity of persons

It is alarming to see enforcement strategies which treat all unauthorized immigrants as dangerous criminals. Masked, heavily armed agents who fail to identify themselves in enforcement activities are surprising. So is an apparent lack of due process in deportation proceedings in recent months.

Along this line, much current rhetoric is obviously intentionally provocative. It is unbecoming of public officials and corrosive of the common good to speak of the deterrence value of “alligators and pythons” at the Collier-Dade facility. I do not speak so glibly in regard to convicted felons in Florida Department of Corrections facilities. Decency requires that we remember individuals being detained are fathers and mothers, brothers and sisters of distressed relatives. This dignity of every person always remains unchanged: it is the dignity of a creature willed and loved by God (Pope Leo XIV, 16 May 2025).

Regarding the Center and Conditions

Observers note that people will be held at the new center in temporary structures, in the heat of the Florida summer, crowded in confined spaces, far from medical facilities and possibly located in the path of hurricanes. I have every hope that for brief stays, the conditions will befit human dignity.

Concern for pastoral needs of detainees and staff

As this and other planned facilities become operational, it should be ensured that chaplains and pastoral ministers will be able to serve those in custody, to their benefit and that of the staff.

Reiterating a call for reforms to U.S. immigration system and support for those involved

The bishops of the United States have long been advocates of reforms to our immigration system. Thoughtful observers of the challenges faced by our country cannot help but recognize that serious reforms are necessary to preserve safety and the integrity of our borders, as well as to accommodate needs for labor, family stability and the ability of those at risk of grave harm to migrate with due process. Enforcement should be proportional. We continue to propose reforms that will enhance our immigration system, respect human dignity and promote the common good. I call on all people of goodwill to pray for our government officials, for those in immigration custody and their families, for those who work in enforcement, and for justice and prosperity across our nation.

UNA DECLARACIÓN DEL OBISPO FRANK J. DEWANE SOBRE LA APLICACIÓN DE LA LEY DE INMIGRACIÓN, 3 DE JULIO DE 2025

A medida que el nuevo centro de detención entra en funcionamiento en el Aeropuerto Dade-Collier, o “Alligator Alcatraz”, parece necesario hacer un balance de los desarrollos recientes en la aplicación de la ley de inmigración y la necesidad de más mejoras en nuestro sistema de inmigración en general.

Amplio Apoyo a las Acciones Contra los Delincuentes

Al describir las iniciativas de aplicación de la ley de inmigración, la administración Trump ha declarado que su enfoque es expulsar a los extranjeros criminales que ponen en peligro la seguridad pública. Esta preocupación es ampliamente compartida. No hay discusión con esto. Sin embargo, la necesidad de una aplicación justa de la ley de inmigración y la obligación del gobierno de llevarla a cabo deben abordarse de una manera específica, humana y proporcional.

Creciente Reconocimiento de las Contribuciones de los Inmigrantes

También hay un creciente reconocimiento de que muchos, de hecho, la mayoría de los inmigrantes, incluso aquellos que no están legalmente presentes, no son peligrosos, sino pacíficos, respetuosos de la ley y trabajadores contribuyentes a nuestras comunidades y a nuestra economía. El presidente Trump ha reconocido esto en sus recientes comentarios al establecer un pase agrícola para aquellos que trabajan en la industria agrícola.

Preocupación por las estrategias y la retórica que no responden a la dignidad de las personas

Es alarmante ver estrategias de aplicación de la ley que tratan a todos los inmigrantes no autorizados como criminales peligrosos. Es sorprendente que agentes enmascarados y fuertemente armados que no se identifiquen en las actividades de aplicación de la ley. También lo es una aparente falta de debido proceso en los procedimientos de deportación en los últimos meses.

En este sentido, gran parte de la retórica actual es obviamente intencionadamente provocadora. Es impropio de los funcionarios públicos y corrosivo para el bien común hablar del valor disuasorio de los “caimanes y pitones” en las instalaciones de Collier-Dade. No hablo con tanta ligereza con respecto a los delincuentes convictos en las instalaciones del Departamento Correccional de Florida. La decencia exige que recordemos que las personas detenidas son padres y madres, hermanos y hermanas de parientes angustiados. Esta dignidad de cada persona permanece siempre inalterada: es la dignidad de una criatura querida y amada por Dios (Papa León XIV, 16 de mayo de 2025).

Sobre el Centro y las Condiciones

Los observadores señalan que las personas serán retenidas en el nuevo centro en estructuras temporales, en el calor del verano de Florida, hacinadas en espacios confinados, lejos de las instalaciones médicas y posiblemente ubicadas en la trayectoria de los huracanes. Tengo la esperanza de que, para estancias breves, las condiciones sean adecuadas a la dignidad humana.

Preocupación por las necesidades pastorales de los detenidos y del personal

A medida que esta y otras instalaciones planificadas entren en funcionamiento, se debe garantizar que los capellanes y ministros pastorales puedan atender a los detenidos, en su beneficio y en el del personal.

Reiterating a call for reforms to U.S. immigration system and support for those involved

Los obispos de los Estados Unidos han sido durante mucho tiempo defensores de reformas a nuestro sistema de inmigración. Los observadores atentos de los desafíos que enfrenta nuestro país no pueden dejar de reconocer que se necesitan reformas serias para preservar la seguridad y la integridad de nuestras fronteras, así como para satisfacer las necesidades laborales, la estabilidad familiar y la capacidad de quienes corren el riesgo de sufrir daños graves para migrar con el debido proceso. La aplicación de la ley debe ser proporcional. Seguimos proponiendo reformas que mejoren nuestro sistema de inmigración, respeten la dignidad humana y promuevan el bien común. 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UNA SOLA COSA ES NECESARIA

DOMINGO 20 DE JULIO, 2025

El evangelio de hoy nos narra el episodio en casa de Marta y María. Esta narración se encuentra únicamente en el Evangelio de Lucas, que podemos llamar el Evangelio de la misericordia. Quizás por eso mismo es también el que presenta a la mujer de una manera más digna, en contraste con la cultura judía de la época, donde la mujer era considerada inferior, casi como un objeto.

Llama la atención que esta escena va inmediatamente después de la parábola del Buen Samaritano. A juzgar por esta parábola, Marta merecería alabanza por su servicio práctico a Jesús. Sin embargo, su acción no es ni alabada ni condenada, sino que se le invita a repensar sus prioridades.

El servicio amoroso a los demás no abarca todo el Evangelio, aunque sea muy importante. El discípulo cristiano es, sobre todo, alguien que vive una adhesión personal a Jesús. Es necesario tomarse el tiempo para escuchar su "palabra"; la devoción a Jesús es "lo único necesario".

Esta relación íntima con Él se manifiesta luego en el servicio amoroso, pero sin la oración y la escucha, el interés por los demás puede ser amor verdadero o no serlo.

La parábola del Buen Samaritano y la historia de Marta y María presentan el doble mandamiento del amor, pero en orden invertido: la acción del samaritano enfatiza el amor al prójimo, mientras que la actitud de María destaca el amor a Dios.

Y repitamos a lo largo de la semana, junto al salmista: "Señor, ¿quién puede hospedarse en tu tienda?"
