17TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



This Gospel reminds us of three things. First of all the disciples asked Jesus how to pray and he gave them a model we call the Our Father. Jesus gave the disciples a form of prayer that praises and petitions God. Next there was the example of a friend who came in the middle of the night to another's house asking for bread. The visitor awoke his friend with a plea for bread, but the sleeping friend did not want to be disturbed. Perhaps it would not be their friendship that got the first man his loaf of bread, but his persistence. So, the only way to continue his night's sleep was for the second man to give his friend the bread. In this parable, Jesus made clear that we need to be persistent in prayer. Finally, Jesus asked what father would hand his son a snake when asked for a fish, or a scorpion when asked for an egg. The point of this illustration was to show the disciples that God would give us the most important gift, the Holy Spirit.

GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke 12: 13-21

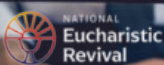
Pay attention to the man in next week's parable and who he talks to. He never talks to a neighbor. He is not talking to his family if he has one, and we never hear him talking to God. He just talks to himself. He is isolated and alone. He seems so isolated from others that he cannot see them or their needs, and he is so busy building his bigger house and barn that he doesn't even notice anyone else. He never seems to ask himself the right question and wonder why he has all those things. I think he is a victim of a pandemic that has been around a long time. He has a condition called, "Denial." One of the symptoms of this condition shows itself in a lifestyle that assumes whoever has the most stuff wins, and anything goes as long as you don't get caught, and it can't happen to me. This must not become our story. I remember very clearly once when I was a child our pastor said: "You can't take it with you, but you can send it on ahead." My father often repeated that to us at home and I pass it on to you. There can be no denial that we have a lot, and that in this country we have most of what there is in this world. Only a complete fool would fail to wonder and ask why and what should we do with it.

HOW DO WE PRAY?

Prayer is a profound and personal way to connect with God. It involves lifting our spirits and opening our hearts to divine communication. Jesus teaches us to "ask...seek...knock" with persistence. But why does God, who already knows our needs before we ask, desire our persistent prayer? Prayer is not primarily about changing God's mind; rather, it is about transforming our hearts to align with His will and helping us recognize our dependence on divine grace.

Here are some essential elements of prayer:

- **Faith** – We pray because we are convinced of God's power and trust in His love and providence.
- **Humility** – In prayer, we acknowledge that God is the source of everything in our lives. We are nothing without Him.
- **Communication** – Prayer is our dialogue with God. It is always a two-way communication: we speak, and God listens; God speaks, and we must listen. Since God knows all our needs, prayer should be more about listening to Him than simply talking.

Some ways to pray include:

- **Adoration:** Praising God for His greatness and acknowledging His power and majesty.
- **Confession:** Admitting our sins and seeking His forgiveness.
- **Thanksgiving:** Expressing gratitude for God's blessings and grace.
- **Supplication:** Asking for God's help, guidance, and provision for ourselves and others.

Prayer is ultimately the lifting of our spirit to God. However, our desires and prayers may not always align with God's will. Like Abraham, we must learn to surrender to God's plan, no matter how difficult it may be. Jesus gave us the perfect example when He prayed: "Not my will, but yours be done."

¿CÓMO ORAMOS?

La oración es una manera profunda y personal de conectar con Dios. Implica elevar nuestro espíritu y abrir nuestro corazón a la comunicación divina. Jesús nos enseña a "pedir...buscar...llamar" con perseverancia. Pero, ¿por qué Dios, que ya conoce nuestras necesidades antes de que las expresemos, desea nuestra oración constante? La oración no es principalmente para cambiar la mente de Dios, sino para transformar nuestro corazón, alinearlo con Su voluntad y ayudarnos a reconocer nuestra total dependencia de Su gracia divina.

Estos son algunos elementos esenciales de la oración:

- **Fe:** Oramos porque estamos convencidos del poder de Dios y confiamos en Su amor y providencia.
- **Humildad:** Al orar, reconocemos que Dios es la fuente de todo en nuestra vida. Sin Él no somos nada.
- **Comunicación:** La oración es nuestro diálogo con Dios. Siempre es una comunicación de dos vías: nosotros hablamos y Dios escucha; Dios nos habla y nosotros debemos escuchar. Ya que Dios conoce todas nuestras necesidades, la oración debería ser más escuchar a Dios que solo hablarle.

Algunas formas de orar son:

- **Adoración:** Alabar a Dios por Su grandeza y reconocer Su poder y majestad.
- **Confesión:** Admitir nuestros pecados y pedir Su perdón.
- **Acción de gracias:** Expresar gratitud por las bendiciones y la gracia de Dios.
- **Súplica:** Pedir la ayuda, guía y provisión de Dios para nosotros y para los demás.

La oración es comunicación con Dios. Más específicamente, la oración es elevar nuestro espíritu hacia Dios.

Nuestro deseo y oración pueden no ser la voluntad de Dios. Necesitamos aprender de Abraham y aprender a rendirnos a la voluntad de Dios, sin importar cuán dolorosa sea. Jesús oró: «No se haga mi voluntad, sino la tuya».

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The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

Formerly called Last Rites or Extreme Unction, this Sacrament is for those experiencing a serious illness, facing an operation or dying. Anointing of the Sick should be performed before death is imminent, when a person is conscious and able to receive comfort from the sacrament.

We make every effort to provide pastoral care and the sacrament of anointing to all who request it; however, families are encouraged to call sooner rather than later. If a loved one is at home and needs the sacrament, please call the office at 592-1949 to arrange for a priest to visit.

In the Hospital?

Please ask the nurse to contact the parish that serves the Hospital you are in for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick.

This is the most efficient way to be sure you or your loved one will receive the sacrament. Be aware that because of HIPAA Privacy regulations, hospitals do not necessarily notify the parish regarding your hospitalization unless requested by the patient.

EL PADRE NUESTRO

La reflexión de hoy no podía ser otra que la del Evangelio según San Lucas 11, 1-3. Más que una reflexión, es una catequesis: "Jesús enseña a sus discípulos a orar."

Los discípulos se dan cuenta de que la buena relación que Jesús tiene con el Padre depende de la oración. Jesús, como Juan el Bautista, tenía una visión especial de la oración, que brotaba de su misión. En respuesta a la petición de sus discípulos, Jesús les enseña la oración dominical.

Aquí, el contexto es uno de oración, mientras que en Mateo 6, 6-13 el "Padre Nuestro" forma parte del Sermón de la Montaña.

La comparación de ambas versiones revela una estructura y un contenido básicamente idénticos, lo que refleja la enseñanza original de Jesús.

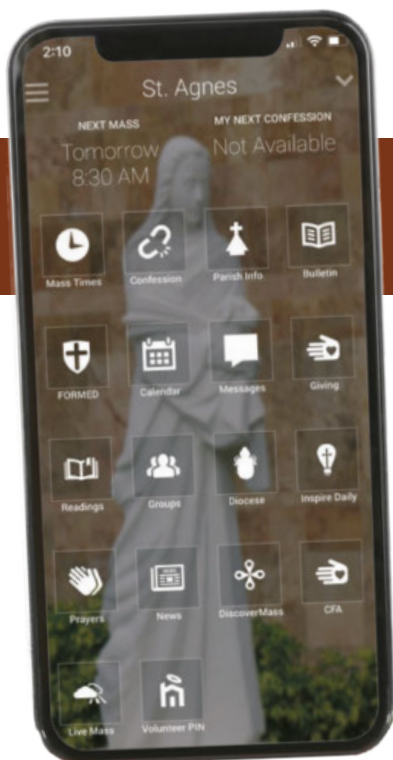
El texto de Mateo fue adaptado para el uso litúrgico, y es el que rezamos en la Misa hasta el día de hoy. El texto más breve de Lucas es menos conocido. Ambas versiones comienzan con la palabra "Padre" (Abba, en hebreo), que revela cómo Jesús se refería a Dios.

La oración comienza pidiendo la glorificación del nombre de Dios en la tierra y el establecimiento pleno de su Reino. Luego, se dirige a las necesidades del discípulo: la protección diaria y continua de Dios, y su apoyo en medio de las adversidades.

Con palabras muy similares, ambas versiones relacionan el perdón que recibimos de Dios con el perdón que ofrecemos a los demás.

La historia del amigo que viene a medianoche y las frases que la acompañan subrayan la perseverancia en la oración. Dios siempre responde a nuestras oraciones de la forma que más nos conviene, no necesariamente como esperamos o deseamos.

El Padre celestial desea lo mejor para sus hijos. "Pidan... busquen... llamen" son los tres modos de describir la oración de petición; pero buscar implica también la búsqueda del Reino de Dios y de la unión con el Padre. Y concluye: "el Padre del cielo dará el Espíritu Santo a quienes se lo pidan" (v. 13). El salmo para meditar esta semana es el Salmo 137, que nos recuerda: "Cuando te invoqué, me escuchaste, Señor."



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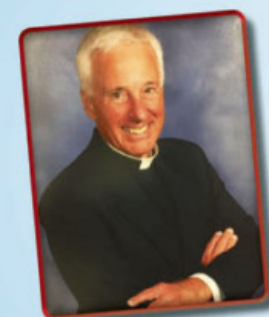
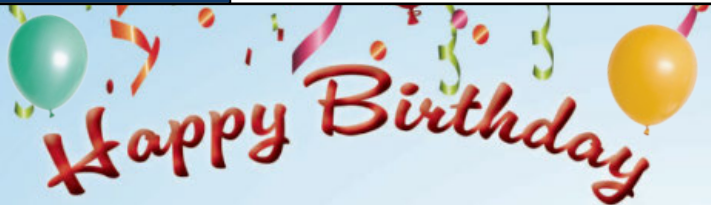
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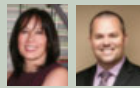
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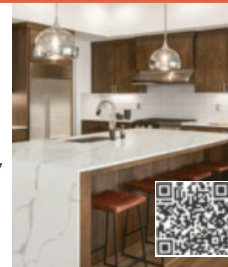
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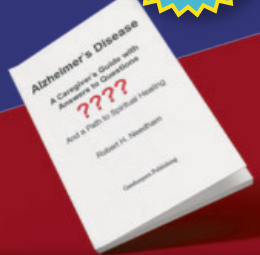
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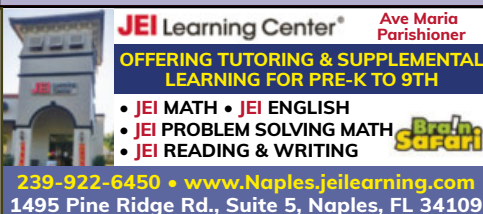


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
