From the crowd, a man called out to Jesus asking for help in a family matter. The man wanted his share of the family inheritance from his brother. Jesus first made it clear that he was not the man's arbitrator and refused to enter the quarrel.

But Jesus did use the opportunity to teach the crowd that placing too much emphasis on the acquisition of material wealth would lead to greed and greed would lead to conflicts in families. Jesus continued by making the point that true security did not exist in a surplus of goods when he relayed a parable about a man who had a bumper crop. So huge was the harvest's yield that the man decided to tear down his storage buildings and build new ones to hold all his grain. Once everything was stored, the man would have no worries and could spend his life without care. But God demanded the man's life that night and we are left to wonder what good did all the abundance do the man?

GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke 12: 32-48

There is an odd mentality among some followers of Christ that thinks Jesus can fix things. That thinking has been around for a long time. The Christians Luke writes for, fifty or so years after the Ascension, seem to be standing around waiting for Christ to come back and bring that Kingdom he promised. That idea that someone else should take care of what bothers me is still around. Luke writes to remind us that Jesus did not come to fix anything except our relationships with one another and with his Father. Jesus speaks to us and says that the Kingdom of God has been given to us. That is the present tense, not the future. The Kingdom and all its glory, peace, and justice does not come because we think someone else should make it happen. It comes when we live in the present and pay attention to how he taught us to live. The short version is: Live today as if it were your last and watch what happens. You express thanks and love to those you have taken for granted. You find healing and forgiveness now because you don't want to die without making amends to those you have hurt and refused. You quit hoarding the stuff you have piled up and give it away without worry over who deserves it but those who need it. Suddenly, Justice and Charity are all you thank about and care about.

AVARICIA

La avaricia es uno de los siete pecados capitales. Es una forma de apego al dinero que impide al ser humano vivir la generosidad. No se trata de un pecado que afecte únicamente a quienes poseen grandes patrimonios, ya que muchas veces no tiene nada que ver con el saldo en la cuenta bancaria. La avaricia es una enfermedad del corazón, no de la cartera.

En mayor o menor escala, se manifiesta como un apego obsesivo a objetos, del cual parece imposible desprenderse. Es como regresar a la etapa infantil en la que un niño agarra su juguete repitiendo: "¡Es mío! ¡Es mío!". Ese apego nos quita libertad.

Esta actitud esconde una relación enfermiza con la realidad, que puede desembocar en formas de acaparamiento compulsivo o acumulación patológica. Para sanar de esta enfermedad del alma, es útil meditar sobre la muerte: por muchos bienes que una persona acumule en esta vida, hay una verdad inevitable — ninguno de ellos cabrá en el ataúd.

No podemos llevarnos nuestros bienes con nosotros. Y ahí se revela el verdadero sentido de este vicio. El vínculo de posesión que construimos con las cosas es solo aparente. No somos dueños del mundo: esta tierra que tanto amamos no nos pertenece, y caminamos sobre ella como extranjeros y peregrinos.

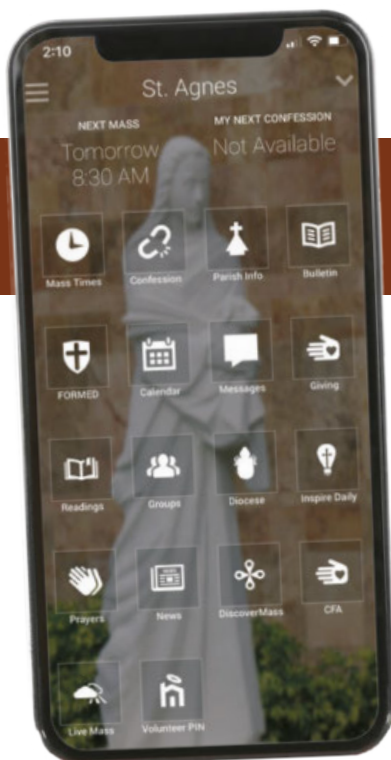
Hoy reflexionamos con la parábola del hombre necio, cuyo campo había producido una gran cosecha. Él, en lugar de compartir, se puso a pensar en cómo agrandar sus almacenes para guardar toda su riqueza. Había calculado todo y planeado su futuro... pero no tomó en cuenta la variable más segura de la vida: la muerte. "¡Necio!", le dice Dios en el Evangelio.

Podemos creer que somos dueños de los bienes que poseemos, pero muchas veces ocurre lo contrario: los bienes terminan por poseernos a nosotros. Algunos hombres ricos no son libres; ni siquiera tienen tiempo para descansar, pues deben proteger y cuidar constantemente sus posesiones.

Al final, entregaremos nuestro cuerpo y nuestra alma al Señor, y todo lo demás quedará atrás. Por eso, estemos atentos y seamos generosos. La generosidad es la virtud que vence la avaricia. Cultivemos virtudes, reconozcámoslas, hagámoslas crecer, y saquemos de nuestra vida el pecado.

Seamos generosos con todos, y especialmente con quienes más lo necesitan.
