# 19TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



Jesus told the disciples not to be afraid, but rather to get sturdy purses to hold all they will receive from God. If they served God, their reward would be great—but it would not be the reward of worldly wealth. In the second part of the Gospel, Jesus preached the message of watchfulness and being ready for his return. In a servant explanation of his point, Jesus told them that God would be so happy to see them at the banquet that God would put on an apron and cook a meal for them. This is similar to the message Jesus gave the disciples at the Last Supper when he washed their feet in service. Look around your home and see evidence of where Jesus is present. What will people know about your family and its faith when they walk into your home? What items, activities, or actions in your home show visitors that you are ready for Jesus if he were to return for you today? After considering all you do, share with one another if you think there is more or something else you could do to prepare for Jesus' return. Perhaps you will think of things you should stop doing. Try to help one another in each person's efforts to serve others.


Ushers play a vital role in creating a welcoming and reverent atmosphere at every Mass.

# GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time Luke 12: 49-53

Be prepared for next week's Gospel as Jesus describes the

consequence of taking his message seriously. It upsets things and changes relationships. He describes his mission and desire to set the world on fire. It may only be a metaphor, but it is a powerful one. Fire is not something one can remain indifferent to. It is not a lifeless thing. It warms and comforts. It also burns up what is useless. It refines what is impure. That fire in the soul is what it takes to live as Jesus taught us, and what happened to him will happen to any of us who choose to live as he taught us. It is tough to be merciful and kind in a world more interested in retribution and revenge. It is tough to work for peace where the sale and manufacture of weapons is a top economic driver. It is tough to remember that Jesus, Mary, and Joseph were once refugees fleeing the threat of violence. Our problem is that the fire Jesus came to ignite is little more than smoke these days as the real mission of Jesus is reduced to cheap sentimentality that has no fire or passion. There is anything worth dying for without that fire and passion. It was Justice and integrity that brought Jesus into conflict with those who exploited the weak and poor. His integrity brought him into conflict with the dishonest. His tolerance brought him into conflict with the narrow-minded and bigoted. This world could us a little fire, and we have the fuel.

### **HOW FAITHFUL ARE WE?**

This week, Jesus reminds us to be faithful and watchful, for we do not know the hour when we will meet the Master.

Stewardship is not just about how we manage our resources, but also about our commitment to live faithfully in the responsibilities entrusted to us. When we recognize that everything we have comes from God, we begin to see our role as stewards—called to serve and honor Him. Stewardship is not merely about management; it is a walk of faith, trusting God to guide us in using what we have for His glory and the good of others.

### Key Aspects of Biblical Stewardship

- **Responsibility:** Acknowledge that you are a caretaker, not an owner. God entrusts you with the management of His resources, which calls for thoughtful and prayerful decision-making.
- **Integrity:** Handle every resource with honesty and transparency. Acting with integrity reflects your commitment to God's principles.
- **Generosity:** Be willing to give. Whether through financial support or acts of service, generosity fulfills the biblical command to care for others.

- **3. Create a Budget:** Manage your finances wisely. A thoughtful budget reflects your priorities and helps you track both spending and giving.
- **4. Volunteer:** Seek opportunities to serve in your parish or community. Acts of service deepen your commitment to living as a faithful steward.
- **5. Feeling Overwhelmed?** Break responsibilities into smaller tasks. Focus on one area of stewardship at a time to avoid burnout.
- **6. Motivating Your Family:** Talk with your family about the meaning of stewardship. Engage them in charitable activities and set shared goals that reflect your faith.

These are just a few ways to help yourself, your family, and others grow in service to the Lord as faithful stewards. Stewardship isn't about the Church needing our resources, it's about our need to express gratitude. Yes, the Church and our parishes have financial needs, but our giving should not be driven by obligation alone. Instead, we are called to gratefully return a portion of our time, talent, and treasure to God, in recognition of the countless blessings He has given us.

### PECADO CAPITAL DE LA IRA

La ira es un vicio tenebroso y uno de los más fáciles de identificar físicamente. La persona dominada por la ira difícilmente disimula este ímpetu: se percibe en sus movimientos, en la agresividad y en la respiración agitada. Cuando nace de una injusticia sufrida, muchas veces no se desata contra el culpable, sino contra el primer desafortunado que se cruza en el camino. Algunos contienen su ira en el trabajo, mostrando tranquilidad y compasión, pero en casa se vuelven insoportables para su esposa e hijos.

La ira es un vicio desenfrenado: puede quitar el sueño y mantenernos atrapados en pensamientos y razonamientos sin hallar paz. Es destructiva para las relaciones humanas porque refleja la incapacidad de aceptar la diversidad del otro, especialmente cuando sus decisiones de vida difieren de las nuestras. Se comienza a detestar su voz, sus gestos y su manera de pensar. Cuando la relación llega a ese nivel, se pierde la lucidez, y la distancia o el silencio sólo agravan el

Por eso, el apóstol Pablo recomienda no permitir que la noche nos sorprenda enojados, sino buscar la reconciliación antes de que termine el día. Si surge un malentendido y dos personas se alejan, no hay que entregar la noche al diablo. Cuando alguien está bajo la ira, siempre culpa al otro y no reconoce sus propios defectos. En el "Padre Nuestro", Jesús nos hace orar por nuestras relaciones, que son un terreno minado y nunca están en equilibrio perfecto. Todos hemos fallado en amar como deberíamos; todos somos deudores y pecadores. Por eso debemos aprender a perdonar para ser perdonados, siempre que sea posible.

La ira se contrarresta con benevolencia, paciencia y mansedumbre. Los antiguos sabían que la parte irascible en nosotros no debe negarse. No somos responsables de la ira al surgir, sino en cómo la manejamos. A veces es bueno que la ira se exprese adecuadamente. No enfadarse nunca, ni indignarse ante la injusticia o la opresión, sería inhumano y poco cristiano. Existe una santa indignación, un movimiento interior justo que Jesús vivió, como cuando expulsó a los mercaderes del Templo (Mc 3, 5).

Nos corresponde, con la ayuda del Espíritu Santo, encontrar la justa medida de las pasiones.
