21ST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



At first reading, this Gospel passage is missing some of the hopeful words we read elsewhere about God's love for us and all of creation spending eternity in the Kingdom. In this Gospel we read that the door is narrow, that not many people will get through it, and once it's shut, there's no opening it again. One way that scholars interpret this passage is that it was geared for the religious leaders of Jesus' time. They were fairly confident that they were among God's chosen people and just because of who they were, they were automatically entitled to enter the Kingdom of God. Jesus came to be sure all people had a chance to enter the door of heaven. Many other people, according to Jesus, would enter before the arrogant leaders. We are cautioned in this Gospel to be more than mere acquaintances with Jesus. We are challenged to have a deep and loving relationship with him. What's the difference between the two? We are probably best at answering that question ourselves, but perhaps we attend worship services every week to fulfill an obligation.

GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Twenty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time Luke 14: 1, 7-14

Privilege! Jesus takes offense at the whole idea. Does someone have a "right" to be invited or included? If invited does someone have a "right" to sit in one place or another? While we can't seem to sort out what "rights" we have in this country, next weekend Jesus settles it when it comes to the Kingdom of Heaven. It is likely that Luke tells this story to get us thinking about our behavior at the Eucharistic Table. In reflecting on this story, we might examine how we might exercise both roles: host and guest. We are always guests at the Divine Table. We don't have any right to be there. It is a privilege, and we ought to ack like guests, grateful and thoughtful. We can also imagine ourselves as the host who invites, nourishes, and provides for others. So, while next weekend's Gospel might, on the surface, seem to be about pride and humility, it is really about eating and being a guest. It may also be about how to be a host. It is about gratitude, not rights and privilege. It is about a right attitude in the face of the abundance in which we find ourselves, how we share it, as well as how we feel about being at that abundant table. This is what Jesus revealed at that dinner in the house of a Pharisee; and it is what he reveals to us today.

"Once one chooses to become a disciple of Jesus Christ, stewardship is not an option." – Stewardship: A Disciple's Response "For if we live, we live for the Lord, and if we die, we die for the Lord; so then, whether we live or die, we are the Lord's." – Romans 14.8

This is the heart of stewardship: everything we are and everything we have is a gift from God. We are not the true owners of anything; we are stewards entrusted with God's gifts — especially the gift of life itself. Each day, we are invited to turn to God in prayer and ask how He is calling us to live the life He intended for us. (St. Louis Diocese)

A stewardship way of life involves:

- Recognizing everything as a gift and blessing from God. All that we are and have comes from Him. Scripture reminds us that we bring nothing into this world and we take nothing out of it (Job 1). God is the Creator and Owner of all; we are simply the stewards or managers of His blessings. Our mission is to use them wisely, responsibly, and for His glory.
- Cultivating a lifestyle of generosity. As we grow in stewardship, generosity becomes a natural expression of our faith. A generous life is evidence that we truly believe God owns it all. When we hoard our gifts and talents, we deny God's ownership and treat them as if they are ours alone.
- Living with accountability in mind. One day, we will stand before God and give an account of how we managed His gifts. Did we use them to bless others? Did our lives reflect His love?



PECADO CAPITAL DE LA PEREZA

El Papa Francisco advirtió que la pereza es un pecado que "el diablo puede usar para aniquilar nuestra vida espiritual" y recordó que la tristeza "es la semilla del diablo". Invitó a tener presente que el agua de nuestro Bautismo es "símbolo de nuestra fuerza".

Pidió reflexionar: si alguno corre el riesgo de caer en la pereza, en ese pecado aparentemente "neutral" —ni blanco ni negro—, que sepa que el diablo puede valerse de él para destruir tanto nuestra vida espiritual como nuestra vida personal. "La pereza es un veneno, una niebla que rodea el alma e impide vivir. Nos lleva a la comodidad, a servir a medias; a adueñarnos de la situación y pasar de siervos a patrones, lo que conduce a la soberbia, al orgullo, a tratar mal a los demás, a sentirnos importantes solo por ser cristianos o por pensar que ya tenemos asegurada la salvación", afirmó el Santo Padre.

Comparó la pereza con una droga: si se prueba con frecuencia, termina gustando y uno se vuelve "perezadependiente". Sin embargo, explicó que la pereza suele ser más un efecto que una causa. Cuando una persona se queda inactiva, indolente o apática, la llamamos perezosa; pero, como enseñan los Padres del Desierto, muchas veces la raíz es la acedia, que significa "falta de cuidado".

Quien cae víctima de la acedia es como si fuera aplastado por un deseo de muerte: todo le disgusta; su relación con Dios se vuelve aburrida; incluso los actos más santos, que antes encendían su corazón, ahora le parecen inútiles. Llega a lamentar el paso del tiempo y la juventud perdida. La acedia ha sido llamada "el demonio del mediodía": nos ataca en mitad del día, cuando la fatiga es más intensa y las horas por delante parecen monótonas e imposibles de sobrellevar.

El Papa subrayó que la fe probada por la acedia no pierde su valor. Al contrario, es una fe más verdadera y humana: la que, a pesar de las tinieblas, sique creyendo humildemente.

Es una fe que permanece en el corazón como las brasas bajo las cenizas, siempre presentes. "Si alguno de nosotros cae en la tentación de la acedia, procure mirar dentro de sí y custodiar esas brasas de fe", exhortó.






