#### THE EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS



John 3:16 is quoted often and many people claim it as their favorite passage in all the Bible. It is where John tells us that God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son so that those who believed would have eternal life. This passage expresses the essence of God's love for us. It was not that God wanted to whip us into shape by threatening and demanding us. Rather God, more than anything we can know, wants us to come back to him in the same glory as Jesus. So that we might fulfill God's desire, Jesus came to witness how we should live and to show us the deep love God has for us. The cross reminds us of God's great gift of love for us. In El Salvador, people make crosses that are bright and colorful. The crosses include illustrations that say something about their belief in God and also something about themselves. Using cardstock or some other medium, create a family OSalvadorianO cross that illustrates your family's beliefs. Let the cross show ways that you experience God's love for your family and ways in which you are grateful for that love.



#### GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

#### The Twenty-fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time Luke 16: 1-13

There is a tough parable coming next week if you take it personally, and we should. If you start thinking it is about someone else, it is a lot easier to hear. The parable is not about someone else because we are stewards. The Gospel asks us a question. "What shall I do?" "What shall I do with all the stuff I have?" "What shall I do with the opportunities I have?" "What shall I do with the life I have?" Jesus proposes that we look at everything we have in a new way; to see every skill, talent, opportunity and possession as something given to manage, use, or invest for one purpose, and that is the forging of an unbreakable bond between ourselves, God and other people. What lasts, Jesus suggests is people. When there is no more work because you're too old, or no more money because you have squandered it all, there will still be people around us. This is the wisdom of the steward in this parable. It is not that he is buying friends, but that he knows what will last. He is asking the question: "What will my life be like in the future?" His response is to build up relationships because he knows that those relationships are a greater prize than all the master's wealth. To be a disciple of Jesus, we must be wise enough to know the difference between have a lot of stuff and having a lot of friends.



#### THE EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS



Today, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, a reminder that in every season of our lives we are called to turn to the Cross and to the love of Christ it reveals. On the Cross, Jesus gave Himself completely. He held nothing back. From that total gift of love, we have received everything: salvation, mercy, forgiveness, love, and hope. These gifts are not meant to be passively received—they are an invitation to live differently.

The Cross boldly calls us to the life of stewardship, a life modeled perfectly by Jesus. Having been given so much, we are called to give generously in return: our faith, our time, our resources, and our talents. This will not always be comfortable. True giving demands sacrifice; it may even invite rejection. But the Cross teaches us to love without counting the cost, to find life by holding nothing back.

Each of us carries a cross, and each of us carries it differently. For some, it is the burden of loss, illness, unemployment, disappointment, or loneliness. For others, it is the profound awareness of God's great love, and the

call to respond with generous love in return. Sometimes we choose to take up our cross; at other times it is placed upon us unexpectedly. What matters is our response. With God's grace, we learn to carry our cross, remembering that Christ bore His freely, and that He walks with us as we bear ours.

The Cross is not the end of the story—it points us to the Resurrection. For those who enter Christ's passion and death as disciples and stewards, new life awaits. In dying to self, we rise with Him. In giving as faithful stewards, we share His life and His light with the world.

As St. John reminds us: "For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son" (John 3:16). God created us to live in relationship with Him, but sin broke that relationship. Jesus came to reconcile us to the Father, to restore what was lost. When we follow His example, we discover true joy in this life and eternal life in the next.

This is the heart of the Gospel—the kerygma, the first proclamation of our faith. It is the core message we proclaim as Catholics. The challenge is simple yet profound: How do you live this out in your daily life?

#### FROM THE OPERATIONS DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

It has now been about two months since I stepped into the role of Business Manager. With some personnel changes in our parish, and summer being the prime time for major projects, I've been fully immersed in ensuring everything continues to run smoothly.

We've had a busy and productive summer, and I'd like to share an update on the completed and ongoing projects:

- April: A full pressure washing of the Parish Center
- May-June: A major parking lot project, which included cleaning, resealing, restriping, and laying/grading asphalt millings on the grounds.
- July-August: Polished all the Jerusalem Stone floors in the Church and Chapel. We also cleaned all carpets, pews, and kneelers across the campus. Sidewalks, bollards, and surrounding areas were pressure-washed.
- Chapel Kneelers: Eight new Chapel kneelers were built from scratch, and the remaining eight were completely refurbished. All were reupholstered to match the chairs.
- Columbarium: We have been working on designing

an expansion of our Columbarium over the last four months and are getting ready to move into the construction phase. Look for that to unfold next year.

In addition to our internal projects, there's a significant external development: the ongoing construction on Vanderbilt Beach Road at our main entrance. Here's what we know about the roadwork going forward:

- The main entrance will be closed for a short period when work gets to that point. The County will coordinate with us in advance.
- A **new exit**, located between the main entrance and exit is expected to be completed in Fall, 2025. This will accommodate traffic turning left onto Weber Blvd or making a U-turn to head east.
- The **existing exit** area is scheduled for completion by **December**, 2025. I hope this update is helpful.







#### LA LUJURIA

El pecado de la impureza es uno de los que con más fuerza domina al ser humano. La reincidencia suele ser frecuente, y cuando una persona se deja arrastrar por la pasión de la lujuria, corregirse se vuelve difícil. La falta de pudor y de modestia son signos claros de que la flor de la pureza ha perdido su fragancia. Quien vive esclavizado por la lujuria deja de valorar estos detalles, incluso los ridiculiza. Sin embargo, este pecado degrada y envilece al hombre, seca su corazón y le impide aspirar a ideales nobles y elevados.

San Tomás de Aquino define la lujuria como "el abandono de la razón por un placer desordenado de la carne". Es importante notar que el santo no condena la sexualidad en sí misma, sino el desorden en su vivencia. El sexo no es sucio ni malo: es sagrado. Y como todo lo sagrado, merece un respeto profundo. Está llamado a un propósito específico y elevado: la unión matrimonial de los esposos y la apertura a la vida.

Algunas personas creen erróneamente que la Iglesia Católica está en contra del sexo. Nada más lejos de la verdad. La Iglesia enseña que la sexualidad humana es un don de Dios, portador de dignidad, belleza y sentido trascendente. Como dice el Evangelio: "Por sus frutos los conocerán" (Mt 7,16). Cuando se vive el don de la sexualidad en el amor verdadero, produce frutos de comunión, fidelidad y vida. Pero cuando se distorsiona en nombre del "amor libre", los frutos han sido dolorosos: aumento del divorcio, degradación de las relaciones humanas, abusos y esclavitud del placer.

En nuestra sociedad, muchos jóvenes reemplazan el encuentro real y la intimidad auténtica por la estimulación virtual. El abandono de la castidad ha hecho que el sexo sea visto como un objeto artificial, separado de la persona y de su dignidad. De ahí nacen relaciones superficiales, sin compromiso ni

respeto, incapaces de sostener un verdadero amor. Frente a esto, urge reclamar la pureza y el respeto por el cuerpo. La castidad no es represión, sino libertad interior para amar con un corazón limpio. Los padres tienen un papel esencial: hablar con sinceridad a sus hijos sobre la sexualidad, acompañarlos en su crecimiento, y supervisar con amor lo que consumen en redes sociales, videojuegos o televisión. La sociedad del futuro dependerá en gran parte de nuestra capacidad para vivir la sexualidad con responsabilidad, respeto y santidad. La pureza no es un ideal imposible: es un camino de amor auténtico que conduce a la verdadera alegría.




