25TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



At first it would seem that this Gospel passage praises dishonesty, but in fact, it gives credit for a clever and guick response. There was a man who managed the land for his master. What his misdeeds were is not quite clear, but something had gone wrong in their relationship and the manager was about to be fired. Not physically able to dig ditches and too proud to beg, the manager worried about how he would live. In a quick response, he went to all the people who owed his master produce and had them change their bills to reflect a lesser amount. In this way the people who saved money would welcome the manger into their homes once he had been fired. The master wasn't rewarding the manager for his dishonesty, but for his cleverness and quick thinking. The point Jesus wanted to make with this parable was to let the crowd know that they should be wise in their use of the world's goods, because if they are used selfishly, they will fail us. However, if we share our resources with others, true wealth will await us in the Kingdom.

The final point of Jesus' words was that we cannot serve two masters, God and money.

GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Twenty-sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time Luke 16: 19-31

There is only one way for us to hear next week's parable. We are not Abraham. We are not Lazarus or the Rich Man. They are dead. We are not the Pharisees either. We are this Rich Man's brothers, and according to Abraham who speaks with great authority, we have Moses and the Prophets. There will be no other signs or wonders to teach us, only the Word of God. That Rich Man is described by his dress and food, all externals. This is shallow. He is only what he looks like. He has no depth or real soul. Lazarus has something the other man lacks. He has an identity. He has a name. One man is wealthy. The other man is blessed. We need to decide which it will be for us. We need to hear this story now because this nation of which we are a part is eating itself to death and living in luxury with Lazarus at the gate. We ought to hear this story now so that we may never think that we have earned anything and always remember that everything we have is a gift. Ancient wisdom comes from St John Chrysostom who said hundreds of years ago: "Remember this without fail, that not to share our wealth with the poor is theft from the poor and deprivation of their means of life. We do not possess our own wealth, but there's."

- We must be prudent about the use of wealth. Yes, Jesus praises the dishonest steward, but not because of his dishonesty, but "for acting prudently" "for the children of this world are more prudent in dealing with their own generation than they are the children of light." We want to go to heaven. But how much time do we spend praying? We want to invest heavenly riches. But how generous are we in sharing our blessings? If we compare ourselves with the worldly people, we will be embarrassed.
- The next concerns trustworthiness. Those who can be trusted in small things can also be trusted in great things. If Christians handle money and other passing things responsibly, then they can also be trusted with the affairs of the Kingdom of God.
- Stewardship and trustworthiness. All the things in this world belong to God. He is the absolute owner. We are only His stewards or managers of these worldly goods. As good managers, we ought to follow the wishes of the true owner God. So, we must administer these goods according to His will, namely, to use them, not for ourselves, but to help others.
- Like the steward in the parable, those who would follow Jesus must put transitory affairs in proper perspective. Christians should handle the affairs of temporal life with an eye toward eternal life.
- Let us also examine the way we relate to God. There are many Christians who pray, not because they are ready to follow His will, but mostly because they are asking for material favor. If they do not need anything from God, they seldom see the need to pray. This means, therefore, that they are only using God. This is an abomination that many people are not aware.
- Finally, Jesus tells his listeners that no one can serve two masters simultaneously. God must be put ahead of money.

- Debemos ser prudentes con el uso de las riquezas. Sí, Jesús elogia al administrador deshonesto, pero no por su deshonestidad, sino «por actuar con prudencia»: «porque los hijos de este mundo son más prudentes al tratar con su propia generación que los hijos de la luz». Queremos ir al cielo. Pero ¿cuánto tiempo dedicamos a la oración? Queremos invertir las riquezas celestiales. Pero ¿cuán generosos somos al compartir nuestras bendiciones? Si nos comparamos con la gente del mundo, nos sentiremos avergonzados.
- El siguiente punto se refiere a la confiabilidad. Quienes son confiables en las cosas pequeñas también lo son en las grandes. Si los cristianos manejan el dinero y otros bienes pasajeros con responsabilidad, también se les pueden confiar los asuntos del Reino de Dios.
- Mayordomía y confiabilidad. Todas las cosas de este mundo pertenecen a Dios. Él es el dueño absoluto. Nosotros solo
 somos sus administradores de estos bienes terrenales. Como buenos administradores, debemos seguir los deseos del
 verdadero dueño: Dios. Por lo tanto, debemos administrar estos bienes según su voluntad, es decir, usarlos, no para
 nosotros mismos, sino para ayudar a los demás.
- Al igual que el mayordomo de la parábola, quienes sigan a Jesús deben poner los asuntos transitorios en la perspectiva adecuada. Los cristianos deben manejar los asuntos de la vida temporal con la vista puesta en la vida eterna.
- Examinemos también nuestra manera de relacionarnos con Dios. Hay muchos cristianos que oran, no porque estén
 dispuestos a seguir su voluntad, sino principalmente porque piden favores materiales. Si no necesitan nada de Dios, rara
 vez ven la necesidad de orar. Esto significa, por lo tanto, que solo están usando a Dios. Esta es una abominación de la que
 muchos no son conscientes.
- Finalmente, Jesús les dice a sus oyentes que nadie puede servir a dos señores simultáneamente. Dios debe estar por encima del dinero.
