### 29TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



Like a relentless child, the widow in Jesus' parable wouldn't give up. She continually begged the judge for justice against her opponents. Not because the judge wanted to see justice done, but because he grew tired of the woman's pleading, he granted her request. The point Jesus wanted to make with this story is how much our loving God will answer our prayers if we persist in our asking. What happens when our children pester us long enough for something? If it's not life threatening and they've bugged us long enough, we usually find a way of giving in without losing face. We know just how the judge in Luke's Gospel felt! Let the story of the persistent widow strengthen your prayers. Even if they are not answered in just the way we ask, God hears our prayers and cares for us.

## GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

### The Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

*Luke 18: 9-14*

Luke shares a lesson on prayer and justification next weekend with a story about two men coming to the Temple to pray. What we are invited to learn from this instruction of Jesus is that our dialogue with God must be about what is on our minds and where we are in our lives. The way we live our lives, day in and day out, reveals the truth about us. Our failures, sins, and imperfections are always with us. Think about the prayer of the tax gatherer. God loves us just the way we are. Yet we often think that what we do or what we say will change the way God sees us. It does not. God has already loved us. We can't get more. So, doing good things to get God's favor or earn some heavenly points reveals doubt that God loves us. The good things we do, how we pray, and how we live with one another must spring from a real and personal conviction that we are loved by God. What this parable teaches us about prayer is that it is far better to simply come before God just as we are simply asking for understanding and mercy. Then we can go home justified not because of what we have done or for that matter how we have prayed, but because of how we live and how we love.

## PRAYER AND THE PERSISTENT WIDOW

How do we pray? Do we pray like the persistent widow, or do we give up when we feel the answer is not coming soon enough?

In Jewish society at the time, widows were among the most vulnerable members of the community. They lacked the protection and provision typically offered by a husband, often facing economic hardship and social marginalization. By choosing a widow for this parable, Jesus underscores the challenges faced by the powerless and disadvantaged, emphasizing the importance of their cries for justice.

The judge in the parable is explicitly described as someone who neither feared God nor respected others. He represents the complete opposite of God, highlighting the greatness of God's justice and compassion. Despite the judge's initial indifference, his eventual response to the widow's persistence serves as a reminder that even an unjust human authority can be moved by persistent appeals.

If an unjust judge finally gives in to the constant requests of a widow, how much more will our heavenly Father respond to us when we persist in prayer?

- This parable encourages believers to:
- Pray continually without losing heart.
- Trust in God's justice and timing, even when answers seem delayed.
- Believe in God's goodness, knowing He is far more compassionate than any earthly authority.

## LA ORACIÓN Y LA VIUDA PERSISTENTE

¿Cómo oramos? ¿Oramos como la viuda persistente, o nos rendimos cuando sentimos que la respuesta no llega lo suficientemente rápido?

En la sociedad judía de la época, las viudas eran de las personas más vulnerables de la comunidad. Carecían de la protección y provisión que normalmente ofrecía un esposo, y a menudo enfrentaban dificultades económicas y marginación social. Al elegir a una viuda para esta parábola, Jesús resalta los desafíos que enfrentan los desamparados y desfavorecidos, enfatizando la importancia de sus clamores por justicia.

El juez en la parábola es descrito explícitamente como alguien que no temía a Dios ni respetaba a las personas. Representa lo completamente opuesto a Dios, lo que resalta aún más la grandeza de la justicia y compasión divinas. A pesar de la indiferencia inicial del juez, su respuesta eventual ante la insistencia de la viuda nos recuerda que incluso una autoridad humana injusta puede ser movida por la persistencia.

Si un juez injusto finalmente accede a las peticiones constantes de una viuda, ¿cuánto más hará nuestro Padre celestial por nosotros si perseveramos en la oración?

- Esta parábola anima a los creyentes a:
- Orar continuamente sin desanimarse.
- Confiar en la justicia y el tiempo de Dios, incluso cuando las respuestas parezcan tardar.
- Creer en la bondad de Dios, sabiendo que Él es mucho más compasivo que cualquier autoridad terrenal.

## SEEING GOD IN EVERY FACE

### A CALL TO PROTECT THE SACREDNESS OF LIFE AND UPHOLD HUMAN DIGNITY



Have you ever wondered what God looks like? You do not have to search the heavens. Just look at the person beside you. Now glance in the mirror. You will find the sacred imprint of God's image in every person - stranger, neighbor, loved one. Our sacred origin is revealed in Genesis: "God created human beings in His image."

Every human being bears God's likeness - the *imago Dei* - regardless of birthplace, background, skin color, or beliefs. This includes the most vulnerable among us: children living in poverty, those seeking a better life in our Country, veterans with visible or unseen wounds, seniors navigating declining health, and all who endure isolation or profound hardship. When we start to recognize the image of God in others, we begin to recognize the holiness of every life and the sacred ties that bind us as one human family.

To be a Christian is to recognize the image of God in every person. The true disciple of Jesus does not turn away from the hungry, the thirsty, the stranger, or the suffering. Catholic Social Teaching teaches that protecting human dignity comes with a responsibility to defend rights and fulfill duties - to family, community, and society at large. When we fail in our responsibility to protect the vulnerable, the foundation of our common humanity is weakened. St. Maximillian Kolbe, a Franciscan priest murdered at Auschwitz, referred to such indifference as "the most deadly poison of our time." No authority or circumstance can take away the sacred worth of a person. Our founding fathers echoed this truth: "All men are created equal, endowed by their Creator with unalienable Rights - Life, Liberty, and the pursuit of Happiness."

During Respect Life Month, the Justice and Peace Committee of St. Agnes Parish asks readers to seek and recognize God's image in every person and take action to protect the sacredness of life and the dignity of every person from conception to natural death, and every moment in between. Let us resist the pull of indifference knowing that as true followers of Christ, our faith requires action.

#### WAYS TO ACT:

- Advocate for life-affirming policies that protect the unborn and support families, the elderly, the disabled, veterans, and the dignity of migrants and refugees.
- Work to end the death penalty, embracing restorative justice over vengeance.
- Firmly denounce all forms of violence, whether in homes, schools, or public places, and teach children that mercy and love are the foundations of true justice.
- Before posting on social media, pause and ask: "Does this reflect the human dignity I'm called to uphold?" Choose empathy over fearmongering.
- Stand firm against racism and ethnocentrism. Challenge harmful stereotypes and commit to examining your own assumptions.
- Combat hunger by donating food and advocating for free and reduced meals in schools. Share a meal with someone in need.

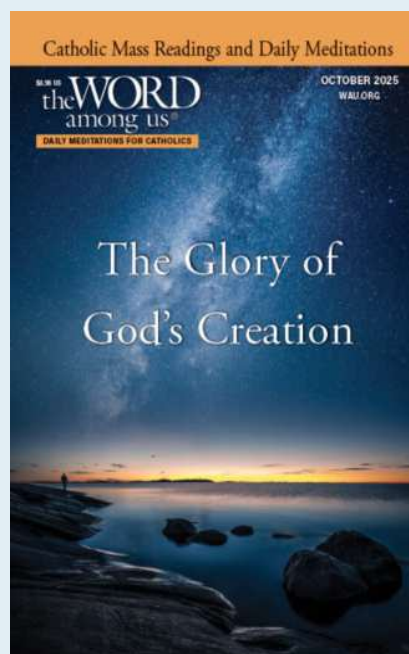

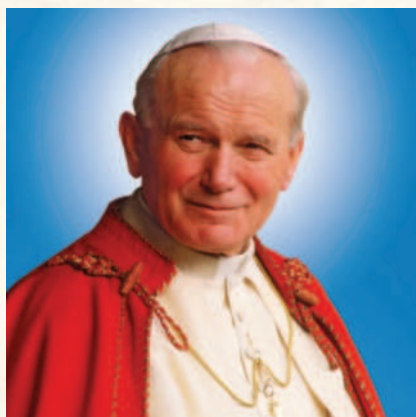

### TRES SANTOS QUE BRILLARON POR SU AMOR A JESÚS EUCARISTÍA

En el mes de octubre, la Iglesia Católica celebra a tres santos muy queridos que se destacaron por su profundo amor y devoción a la Eucaristía, presencia real de Cristo.

Los santos son: San Juan Pablo II, cuya fiesta se celebra el 22 de octubre; Santa Faustina Kowalska, conmemorada el 5 de octubre; y San Carlo Acutis, cuya memoria recordamos el 12 de octubre.

Para San Juan Pablo II, la Misa era el centro y el inicio de su día. Pasaba 10 minutos con los asistentes en preparación antes de la Misa, y 10 minutos después en acción de gracias, profundamente recogido en la presencia del Señor. Visitaba el Santísimo Sacramento alrededor de 20 veces al día, generalmente postrado en forma de cruz. Escribió varios documentos sobre la Eucaristía, siendo el más importante su encíclica *Ecclesia de Eucharistia*. Buscaba renovar la fe y la devoción hacia la Eucaristía como presencia, sacrificio y comunión. Afirmó que cada congregación que asiste a Misa debe estar unida en asombro y acción de gracias por lo que está ocurriendo, y que María, Mujer de la Eucaristía, es nuestro modelo.

Santa Faustina Kowalska Religiosa polaca que recibió revelaciones sobre la Divina Misericordia, Santa Faustina fue guiada por Jesús para llevar un diario espiritual y promover: una imagen especial de la Divina Misericordia, una fiesta, una coronilla, una novena, y una oración diaria a las 3:00 p. m.

Ella experimentó lo que llamó un "conocimiento infundido" sobre la Eucaristía. En su diario escribió sobre una experiencia mística durante la Última Cena: "Durante esta hora de oración, Jesús me permitió entrar en el Cenáculo y fui testigo de lo que allí sucedió. Sin embargo, me conmovió profundamente cuando, antes de la Consagración, Jesús levantó los ojos al cielo y entabló una misteriosa conversación con su Padre. Solo en la eternidad entenderemos este momento."

San Carlo Acutis, nacido en 1991 en Inglaterra y fallecido en 2006 debido a una leucemia agresiva, Carlo fue un joven apasionado por el fútbol, la fotografía y especialmente por las computadoras. A pesar de que sus padres no eran practicantes, su vida estuvo profundamente guiada por su fe católica. La Eucaristía fue el centro de su vida, y su lema era: "La Eucaristía es mi autopista al cielo."

No solo un camino con semáforos y señales de alto, sino una autopista sin obstáculos, directa a su destino. Movido por este amor, estudió 126 milagros eucarísticos documentados en Europa, recopilando información y elaborando paneles informativos que hoy circulan por todo el mundo en varios idiomas. Todas las iglesias de Asís —su ciudad favorita, donde está enterrado— tuvieron adoración eucarística el día de su beatificación en octubre de 2020, convirtiendo a Asís en una verdadera ciudad eucarística.



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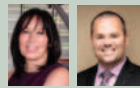
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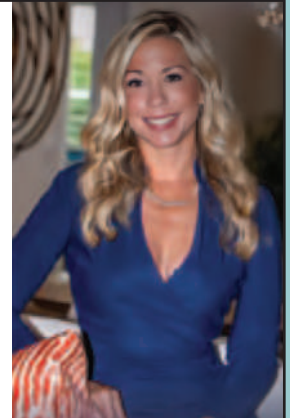
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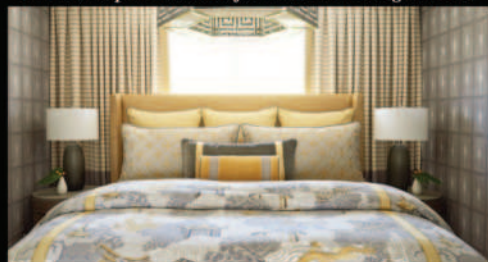
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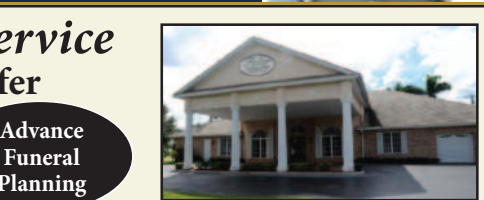
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
