From time to time our children live in a "me first world," but Jesus wasn't too impressed with the self-centeredness of the Pharisee in today's Gospel. The Pharisee was quite certain that he was a good and righteous man–better than most. For sure, he was better than the tax collector. But as Jesus often did in his teachings, he turned society's ideas upside down. It was really the humble tax collector recognizing his own sinfulness that Jesus said would be exalted. Prayer is an important part of this scripture. With your child(ren), create a prayer space in your home. Allow them to place objects they find appropriate such as candles, the Bible, pictures, fabric, figures and other items. Use the space together every day.



GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Commemoration of the Faithful Departed Luke 19: 1-10

We stand in a tradition that proclaims life, not death; honor and respect, not disposable life. In our tradition every life, born, unborn, dead, or alive has value and eternal significance. No one is expendable. We treasure our memories with photos, mementos, medals, or rings. With tenderness and gratitude, we remember smiles, hugs, and tears, and all the love we have known from those who have died. We are with them in faith. We are in communion with them at the altar for we believe in the communion of saints. All heaven and earth bears witness to it. So, All Souls Day is about our memory and our will to remember what has been done for us, what has been given to us, and what has been asked of us. We share life with all who have gone before us, and we remember them because they still live with us, and they are all around us. Remembering is one of the great commands Jesus asks of us. If we forget, we sin. If we forget, we lose our way. If we forget, we repeat mistakes. If we forget, war comes again on the face of the earth. If we forget, we fail to see God in those beside us. Forgetfulness does nothing for life, and it has no place among the faithful. The very notion of faithfulness contradicts the notion of forgetfulness.

HUMBLE STEWARDSHIP

Stewardship means living a conscious and committed life in Christ.

The word "humility" comes from the Latin humus, meaning "earth" or "ground." To be humble is to recognize that we are not the creators of life, but stewards of what God has created.

What is Humble Stewardship?

- We come to understand that all we have—and all that we are—comes from a loving and generous God. This realization is deeply humbling.
- God created the heavens and the earth and entrusted us with the responsibility to care for His creation.
- Scripture also teaches that we are created in the image and likeness of God, with inherent dignity and worth.
- We are each important in God's eyes, but humility means we do not assert our importance at the expense of others or of God's creation. Doing so would contradict the essence of humility.

Living Humble Stewardship

- A life of daily stewardship provides many opportunities to grow in humility:
- Choosing to let others shine in conversation.
- Accepting feedback without becoming defensive.
- Surrendering control or power in order to empower others.
- Being fully aware of both our strengths and weaknesses, while acknowledging that everything we are and have is a gift from God.

Humility is not self-deprecation or having an inferiority complex.

Rather, it is seeing ourselves truthfully—neither more nor less than we are. A humble person sees reality clearly and responds accordingly.

"All who exalt themselves will be humbled, but all who humble themselves will be exalted."

— Luke 18:14



ALL SAINTS DAY/ ALL SOULS DAY

Why do Catholics do that?

All Saints Day: Catholics have celebrated this feast since the 4th Century, although it was not aways observed on November 1. On this day, we honor the witness of the saints, those holy men and women who show us what it means to dedicate our lives to God. By reflecting on their example, we draw strength to live more fully in union with Christ, with the hope that one day we might join their ranks in heaven. It is customary that relics of the Saints be exposed for veneration of the faithful. At St. Agnes the following relics will be displayed:

- St. Dominic of Guzman
- St. Therese of Lisieux
- St. Faustina Kowalska
- St. Bernadette Soubirous
- St. Maria Goretti
- St. John Neumann
- St. Elizabeth Seaton
- St. John Bosco
- St. Francis of Assisi
- St. Thomas Aquinas
- St. Agnes (relic housed in the altar)

We pray with the saints not as an act of worship, but as a way of seeking their intercession—asking them to pray to God on our behalf. We pray "with" or "through the intercession of saints"; we do not pray "to" saints. Our prayer is always directed to God.

We believe that saints, having lived holy lives and now being in heaven are spiritually united with God and can intercede for us, on Earth. It's like asking a friend, you trust, to pray for you during a difficult time—except saints are believed to have a special closeness to God. Intercessory prayers are often directed through certain saints who exemplified particular virtues or faced struggles similar to our own. For example, someone might seek the intercessions of St. Jude in times of hopelessness or turn to St. Anthony when something is lost.

Relics are physical objects associated with saints, and they're revered because they connect believers to the holy lives

of these individuals. Whether a bone fragment (first-class), an item the saint used (second-class), or something touched to a relic (third-class), these sacred objects are seen as tangible links to the divine grace that flowed through the saint's life. We embrace the idea that God works through material things—water in baptism, bread and wine in the Eucharist, and relics as conduits of grace.

Praying with saints and venerating relics reflect our understanding that holiness is not abstract; it is embodied, communal, and accessible. Saints are not distant figures; they are spiritual companions, and their relics help us experience that connection in a very visible way.

All Souls Day: Rooted in Christian tradition since the 10th Century, All Souls Day is a time we pray for those who have died and for those who are grieving. Taking place after All Saints Day where we pray for those already in heaven; All Souls Day focuses on those still on their way to heaven. Ultimately, it is a day of love and remembrance for our dearly departed; a day set aside to pray for those who have gone before us and renew our hope in the promise of enteral life.

At all Masses, on Sunday, November 2 we will project the names of the parishioners who passed away in the last year and had funeral services at St. Agnes, honoring them of them in prayer after Communion. At the conclusion of the 9:00AM Mass, we will process to the columbarium where the priest will offer prayers for those laid to rest there.

An annual tradition at St. Agnes; the **Book of the Names of the Dead** is placed on a podium in the back of the church near the baptismal font. Over the coming weeks we invite you to add the names of your loved ones who have passed. These names will be included in our prayer intentions throughout the month of November. The book will remain available through Thanksgiving. Additionally, a small basket is placed on the altar during Mass in the coming weeks. This basket will hold the prayer intentions of our parishioners for their departed loved ones, which will be lifted up in prayer during our liturgies.



CLASIFICACIÓN DE LAS RELIQUIAS

Las reliquias son restos físicos (como cuerpos, huesos o cabello) u objetos (como ropas o utensilios) que pertenecieron a santos o a Cristo, y que se veneran como testigos de santidad y fuentes de intercesión y gracia divina. El propósito de su veneración es buscar la intercesión de los santos y obtener beneficios espirituales, sanaciones o milagros. Es una forma de acercarnos a los "héroes de la fe" y, por extensión, a Dios.

Ejemplos de reliquias famosas:

- La Santa Cruz: Se conservan astillas de la cruz de Cristo como reliquias.
- La Sábana Santa (Santo Sudario): El sudario con el que fue cubierto el cuerpo de Cristo antes de la resurrección.
- Sangre de San Genaro: La sangre de San Genaro se licúa milagrosamente tres veces al año. Se encuentra en la Catedral de Nápoles.
- El cuerpo de Santa Catalina de Bolonia: Su cuerpo incorrupto se conserva sin protección en una iglesia de Bolonia.
- **El cuerpo de Carlo Acutis**: Su cuerpo incorrupto se encuentra en Asís, Italia, en el Santuario de la Spogliazione, expuesto en una vitrina para la veneración de los fieles.
- Otros cuerpos incorruptos de santos: Santa Bernardita (Francia), San Juan María Vianney (Francia), San Padre Pío de Pietrelcina, San Antonio de Padua, Santa Cecilia, entre otros.

Clasificación de las reliquias:

- Primer grado: Son los cuerpos de los santos o cualquiera de sus partes corporales, como miembros, cenizas o huesos.
- **Segundo grado:** Objetos que estuvieron en contacto con los santos mientras vivían, tales como sus ropas, instrumentos o pertenencias personales.
- Tercer grado: Fragmentos de tela u otros objetos que han sido tocados a una reliquia de primer grado.

En St. Agnes tendremos exposición de reliquias el domingo 2 de noviembre.




