

GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica Luke 20: 27-38

We interrupt the counting of Sundays next week to remember something as we did last week. This time as the whole Western Church recalls the Dedication of the first Christian Church, a gift of Constantine on the Lateran Hill of Rome. It is not, however about Rome's Cathedral no matter how lovely it is. It has been in ruins more than once. The fact that the Pope now lives across the river on another Hill is a reminder that it was once uninhabitable. This feast is about Christ Jesus and his presence among us. The first name of that building, "Church of the Savior" gives the reason for this celebration every November 9. Every civilization has certain places that it sets apart as holy. We have done that with our churches. These are places of covenant, feasting and proclaiming. These are places of sacrifice and the meeting place where God is revealed in sacrament, song, and service. Our churches are a mirror that reminds us who we are. Churches remind us of our deepest identity as people of diversity who become one in Christ Jesus and in whom dwells the Spirit of the Living God. We are reminded by churches that we are not alone, but are surrounded by statues and icons to remind us as Paul says: that "we are fellow citizens with the saints."

This sense of scarcity makes us desperate, and we turn to competition, hoarding, and a kind of parody of self-preservation. This greed extends not only to material goods but also to knowledge, friendships, and ideas. We worry that everything we possess is threatened. This is especially true in a society that grows more affluent, experiences more opportunities for hoarding and more fears of losing what has been stored, and in the process creates enemies and war.

STEWARDSHIP AND THE FAMILY

We refer to the family as the "domestic Church." This phrase, drawn from the writings of the early Church Fathers and emphasized by the Second Vatican Council, describes family life as the center of Catholic spirituality and faith. Yet those of us living in modern families know how challenging it can be to fully live up to that image—especially in the busy autumn months of the year.

Hectic schedules often make family members feel like ships passing in the night. Job demands, class schedules, school events, church groups, business trips, commutes, and sports—the list goes on. Experts note that the family dinner, once a nightly tradition, is becoming increasingly rare. Even when everyone is home, screens—smartphones, televisions, and tablets—can keep family members isolated from one another, even when they're in the same room.

So, what can we do to make our homes truly reflect the sacredness of the "domestic Church"? How can we be better stewards of our families?

Start with the family meal. Try planning a big breakfast or brunch on Sunday after Mass. Make it a special occasion, featuring everyone's favorite foods. Involve the whole family—from preparation through clean-up. Keep a large, visible calendar where everyone's schedule is posted, and use it to plan and prioritize family dinners. These meals should be social events, not times for reprimands or academic reviews. No electronic devices allowed—just pleasant conversation. And don't worry if it's not a home-cooked roast; pizza and salad can be just as meaningful when shared with love.

Next, create a plan for family prayer time. In addition to attending Sunday Mass together, set aside a few moments in the evening when everyone pauses for prayer before bedtime. Use commute times—drives to school or practice—as opportunities for brief, heartfelt prayers with your children. Let your children see you pray with Scripture. Show them that prayer is a priority.

Saint John Paul II emphasized the power of prayer in family life: "Prayer makes the Son of God present among us," he wrote.

What else can you do to elevate the sacredness of your domestic Church? Do your children see you honor special time with your spouse? Do you spend quality one-on-one time with each child? Are you fully present when they speak—or are you distracted by your phone?

Communicate clearly that family comes first, and your children will follow your example. As a steward, prioritize your own sense of family stewardship. If our children grow up understanding that "church" and "family" are intimately connected, their faith will be all the stronger for it.







We make every effort to provide pastoral care and the sacrament of anointing to all who request it; however, families are encouraged to call sooner rather than later. If a loved one is at home and needs the sacrament, please call the office at 592-1949 to arrange for a priest to visit.

In the Hospital?

Please ask the nurse to contact the parish that serves the Hospital you are in for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick.

This is the most efficient way to be sure you or your loved one will receive the sacrament. Be aware that because of HIPAA Privacy regulations, hospitals do not necessarily notify the parish regarding your hospitalization unless requested by the patient.







LA CORRESPONSABILIDAD Y LA FAMILIA

Nos referimos a la familia como la "Iglesia doméstica". Esta expresión, tomada de los escritos de los Padres de la Iglesia y resaltada por el Concilio Vaticano II, describe la vida familiar como el centro de la espiritualidad y la fe católicas. Sin embargo, quienes vivimos en familias modernas sabemos lo difícil que puede ser vivir plenamente esa imagen, especialmente durante los ocupados meses de otoño.

Los horarios agitados hacen que los miembros de la familia se sientan como barcos que se cruzan en la noche. Las exigencias del trabajo, los horarios de clases, los eventos escolares, los grupos parroquiales, los viajes de negocios, los traslados y los deportes... la lista es interminable. Los expertos señalan que la cena familiar, que antes era una tradición diaria, es cada vez más rara. Incluso cuando todos están en casa, las pantallas —teléfonos inteligentes, televisores, tabletas— pueden mantener a los miembros de la familia aislados, aunque estén en la misma habitación.

Entonces, ¿qué podemos hacer para que nuestro hogar refleje verdaderamente lo sagrado de la "Iglesia doméstica"? ¿Cómo podemos ejercer una mejor corresponsabilidad con nuestra familia?

Empecemos con la comida familiar. Intenta planificar un desayuno o brunch especial los domingos después de la Misa. Haz que sea una ocasión especial, con los platillos favoritos de cada uno. Involucra a toda la familia, desde la preparación hasta la limpieza. Coloca un calendario grande y visible donde se anoten los horarios de todos, y úsalo para planificar y priorizar las cenas familiares. Estas comidas deben ser momentos sociales, no ocasiones para regañar ni revisar tareas escolares. Nada de dispositivos electrónicos—solo una conversación amena. Y no te preocupes si no hay carne asada; una pizza con ensalada puede ser igual de significativa cuando se comparte con amor.

Después, crea un plan para el tiempo de oración en familia. Además de asistir juntos a la Misa dominical, reserva unos minutos por la noche para que todos se reúnan y recen antes de dormir. Aprovecha los traslados—el camino a la escuela o al entrenamiento—para compartir una breve pero sincera oración con tus hijos. Deja que tus hijos te vean orar con la Sagrada Escritura. Muéstrales que la oración es una prioridad.

San Juan Pablo II destacó el poder de la oración en la vida familiar: "La oración hace presente entre nosotros al Hijo de Dios", escribió.

¿Qué más puedes hacer para elevar lo sagrado de tu Iglesia doméstica? ¿Tus hijos te ven dedicar tiempo especial a tu cónyuge? ¿Dedicas tiempo de calidad con cada hijo individualmente? ¿Los escuchas con atención cuando hablan, o estás revisando el móvil mientras te hablan?

Comunica claramente que la familia es lo primero, y tus hijos seguirán tu ejemplo. Como corresponsable, prioriza tu propio sentido de corresponsabilidad familiar. Si nuestros hijos crecen entendiendo que "Iglesia" y "familia" están profundamente conectadas, su fe será mucho más fuerte.




