THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD



The Magi from the east arrived in Jerusalem, asking the whereabouts of the newborn king of the Jews. Herod was troubled by this news of the birth, as was all of Jerusalem.

He sent the Magi to Bethlehem to search for the child, asking that they bring the child to him so that he could do the child homage. The Magi set out and followed the star to the place where the child was. They did the child homage and offered him their gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. But they were warned in a dream not to return

to Herod, and they left for their country by a different route. The star led the Magi to the place where Jesus was. With your family, cut out several yellow construction paper stars. On each star write either a way you can find Jesus—such as “read God’s Word”—or the name of a person who has helped you find Jesus, such as “Grandma Joan.” Create a mobile of your stars using coat hangers and yarn or string. Hang your stars in a place where all family members will see them.

GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Baptism of the Lord

Matthew 3: 13-17

If you have never wondered why Jesus, the Son of God, was Baptized, you should. There is something important and profound here next week. This feast does not always fall on a Sunday during the Christmas season, but when it does, it provides an opportunity to go deeper into what this season really celebrates, which is far more than the birth of a baby in Bethlehem. What we celebrate next week is part of the Incarnation. It is a deeper look into the wonder of God becoming one of us. This baptism reinforces the message we have heard in the Christmas story. God has chosen to be with us not as an awesome ruler of the universe, but as one who chooses solidarity with us in all our weakness. As a faithful Jew, Jesus believed that John was a prophet. This Baptism is a proclamation that God is up to something and John was part of it. What this Baptism says to us is that God's solidarity with us is total. God is with us in every circumstance: in hope and love, in weakness and sin, disgrace and desperation. This baptism brings Jesus into communion with us. Our baptism invites us into union with God and all of God's own. The baptism we tell of next weekend was a sign of his communion with us. Our baptism calls us into communion with God and one another. That's all there is to it.

EPIPHANY: A REVELATION OF DIVINE LOVE



Epiphany, derived from the Greek word meaning “manifestation” or “revelation,” marks key moments in Christ’s life: the visit of the Magi, His baptism in the Jordan, and His first miracle at Cana. Each event unveils the divine presence and mission of Jesus.

Established in the fourth century, the Feast of Epiphany highlights the universal scope of Christ’s mission. As we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord in 2026, we reflect on the symbolic gifts offered to Jesus: gold, signifying His kingship; frankincense, representing His divinity; and myrrh, foreshadowing His sacrificial death and redemptive love.

Epiphany proclaims the Good News of God’s love revealed to humanity. It recalls the Magi’s determined search for truth.

Despite prophetic words—“And you, Bethlehem of Judah, a Savior shall arise from you”—many hearts remained hardened. Herod exploited this knowledge for power, while the Magi pursued wisdom, guided by a star whose destination was unknown. Their courage and openness led them to Christ.

Like the Magi, we too must seek the Lord with perseverance. God is not encountered through Scripture alone; rather, His presence becomes clear when we interpret life’s experiences through the lens of His Word. Each time we do so, we experience a personal epiphany—a moment of divine revelation.

Epiphany speaks of the trials of the spiritual journey and the generosity of offering gifts. Above all, it calls us to embrace Jesus as the center of our lives, the guiding light amid uncertainty.

In our Christmas crèches, shepherds and wise men often appear together, forming concentric circles around the manger. At the center lies Jesus, flanked by Mary and Joseph. Surrounding them are humble shepherds and animals, and finally, the Magi—pilgrims from afar, drawn by faith and light.

The Feast of Epiphany celebrates Christ revealed to the nations. It recalls the Magi—foreign seekers of truth—who journeyed across great distances, following a star that led them to the newborn King. Their homage affirms that Christ came for all people, transcending boundaries of culture and creed.

The Magi’s story reminds us that anyone who earnestly seeks truth will find it in Christ. Their gifts and adoration symbolize the universal invitation to share in God’s grace and light.

May Christ Jesus dwell with us, keep us from all harm, and make us one in mind and heart, now and forever.

The legendary names of the three Wisemen are: **C**asper, **M**elchior, and **B**althasar. Also, the initials **C+M+B** also abbreviate the Latin words, “**C**hristus **M**ansionem **B**enedicat” which means: “**May Christ bless this house.**” The markings over the doors should be left all year round.

¿POR QUÉ LOS REYES MAGOS SON EJEMPLO DE BUSQUEDA DE LA VERDAD?



Monseñor Demetrio Fernández puso como ejemplo de la búsqueda de Dios a los Magos de Oriente, quienes finalmente encontraron al Mesías, lo adoraron y le ofrecieron sus dones. A pesar de las dificultades y obstáculos, fueron honestos en su búsqueda de la verdad, y esta se les manifestó de manera desbordante en el encuentro con Jesús y su Madre.

Algo apareció en el firmamento, alguna señal que impulsó a aquellos sabios a ponerse en camino. Al parecer, fue una estrella fugaz –o un cometa– la que los orientó en la dirección que debían seguir. Guiados por sus conocimientos científicos, avanzaron hasta llegar a Jerusalén, donde preguntaron por el Rey de los judíos que acababa de nacer. Esto despertó en el rey Herodes el temor de perder su reino, al pensar que ese recién nacido venía a arrebatarle el trono, cuando Jesús no ha venido a quitar nada

a nadie, sino a darlo todo y a llevarlo todo a plenitud.

Los Reyes Magos consultaron a Herodes y a los maestros de la Ley sobre el lugar donde había de nacer el Rey. Sin embargo, cuando el discernimiento no se realiza desde la verdad, sino buscando los propios intereses, el resultado queda falseado. Según Mons. Fernández, esto nos sucede muchas veces en la vida: buscamos la verdad, pero tantas personas influyen para apartarnos de ella, y nosotros mismos hacemos lo mismo con los demás.

Afortunadamente, la verdad puede padecer, pero no perece. La verdad atraviesa momentos difíciles, pero siempre reaparece, sin violencia ni extorsión. Así ocurrió cuando la estrella volvió a aparecer: los iluminó y les mostró el lugar exacto donde se encontraba Jesús. Entonces lo adoraron, y esta es la actitud fundamental de quien busca a Dios y lo encuentra.

Los Magos nos enseñan a buscar, a superar las dificultades del discernimiento en el camino y, sobre todo, a adorar cuando hemos encontrado al Señor.
