The beatitudes are the content of this Gospel and they begin what we commonly call, "The Sermon on the Mount." Jesus' words surely turned upside down the understanding his listeners had of the world and society. Jesus told them that the poor would be rich, the hungry would be filled, and the persecuted would be rewarded. In all, there are eight statements that give the people a new understanding of Moses' law and a clearer image of God's Kingdom. Living the beatitudes is nothing new for parents. We often set our needs and desires aside in order to care for others, especially our children. Our greatest challenge, however, is to be a living witness to the first beatitude. If we understand and live out being "poor in spirit," the rest falls into place. For to be "poor in spirit," we rely completely on God. We know what the present situation holds, but recognize that there is a greater glory to come in God's Kingdom.

GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Fifth Sunday of Ordinary Time

Matthew 5:13-16

Next weekend, Jesus speaks to us about the very purpose of our existence here as children of God. We just heard what it is like to be blessed. Now we hear about what God expects of us. Notice that he says: "You are..." It is about us. Like salt in good food, disciples bring out some flavor, some pleasure, and some joy to this world never calling attention to themselves. They bring out the best in others. No one looks at the sun, but without it we can't see color,

beauty or where we are going. We don't look at light bulbs, but because they are there we can read and see one another. Artists know how to use light to draw attention not the light, but to the figure, to the beauty, or a person of creation. We are not here to buy, consume or sustain the economy. We are not here to eat, drink, and be merry.

Nothing we do should call attention to ourselves, but rather call attention to God, to God's glory, God's mercy, and God's love. We are necessary for life, and not just physical life. Once heard, our call can never be revoked just as salt can never total lose its flavor. But, if we ignore the call to our real vocation, we are "no longer good for anything but to be thrown out." Living the values of the Beatitudes will make us salt of the earth and beacons of hope for others, and perhaps signal the dawn of a new day called the Kingdom of God.

9. Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy.
10. Those who show kindness and forgiveness to others will, in turn, receive God's mercy.
11. Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.

We make every effort to provide pastoral care and the sacrament of anointing to all who request it; however, families are encouraged to call sooner rather than later. If a loved one is at home and needs the sacrament, please call the office at 592-1949 to arrange for a priest to visit.

Please ask the nurse to contact the parish that serves the Hospital you are in for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick.

This is the most efficient way to be sure you or your loved one will receive the sacrament. Be aware that because of HIPAA

Privacy regulations, hospitals do not necessarily notify the parish regarding your hospitalization unless requested by the patient.



The Presentation of the Lord Monday, February 2



Why should I become a *member* of a Parish?

Membership requires formal enrollment in the parish, but it is more than just filling out some forms. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to participate in the religious, social and ministerial activities of a parish.

Registration not only shows you belong, but it is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, letters for Immigration, participating in Faith Formation and receiving donation statements for tax purposes.

Belonging to a parish is a commitment. Just as you want the parish to provide Masses, Sacraments, Faith Formation and ministries, the parish needs to be able to count on you to help and assist in their mission; to be an active member.

Being an active member at St. Agnes involves several key aspects:

- **Registration:** Active members are formally registered in the parish
- **Worship:** Active members attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation (except for illness or emergency)
- **Stewardship:** Active members serve the community in various ways by sharing their time and talent
- **Financial Support:** Active members support the parish financially, using offertory envelopes or online giving (WeShare)
