It is common for us in our times to be careful about the salt we use. However, in Jesus' day, salt was a very important commodity. It was used to pay salaries. Like us, people used salt to flavor food. But, because there was no refrigeration, salt was also used to preserve food. That is why, when Jesus called his disciples "salt" and "light," he declared their great importance. What was of significant importance to Jesus was the enthusiasm with which the disciples spread the Good News. Gather all the candles in the house and set them on the table at meal time. Try to have enough candles burning so that theirs is the only light you have in the room. As you eat, talk together about how each member of the family is light to one another and to others. You might get the conversation going by asking what difference the candlelight makes in your otherwise dark room.

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GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Sixth Sunday of Ordinary Time

Matthew 5: 20-22, 27-28, 33-37

It is still the "Sermon on the Mount" in next week's Gospel, and Jesus speaks to those who think that just keeping the law makes them righteous. What Jesus says is that the law leads to righteousness. It is a guide not the goal. We have an uneasy relationship with the law, and we have to keep careful watch over the civil law and the moral law. While they ought not conflict, the truth is, sometimes they do and we need to be clear about which one we choose to obey. If anyone thought that Jesus was abolishing the law, they did not listen to Matthew 5. If the law was tough before, it gets tougher after Jesus. Now, it's not just murder that will put someone on trial.

It is anger. No longer is it adultery, but now it is the lust that leads to it. Truly keeping the law means going beyond it, or maybe getting behind it to explore why the law is there. Fulfillment of the law means going deeper, getting into the very heart of what the law protects or points to. Perhaps in the end, it is really all about a profound respect for others. Perfect righteousness is the imitation of God. It is not found in the perfect observance of the law except in the perfect observance of the law of love. Becoming the perfect imitation of God in whose image we are made makes me think: "Lord, have mercy," and then continue by grace and faith at steady and unending business of conversion.

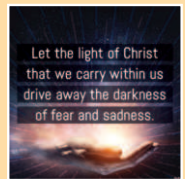

STEWARDSHIP, LEADERSHIP, AND RELATIONSHIP: HOW THEY WORK TOGETHER

Relationships are the substance of leadership. A congregation is a web of relationships. To practice the people skills needed for leadership, we must ask ourselves: What kind of human being do I need to become in order to lead well?

As Catholics, we are committed to inner change. Jesus calls us to form our hearts out of his love (Luke 10:27). The ashes we receive during Lent are one example of how we acknowledge this commitment—to change our hearts, our minds, and ourselves in order to become better human beings.

Research shows that we can become compassionate communicators by nurturing inner silence, being fully present to the moment, and listening deeply to others. For Catholics, this involves cultivating a rich spiritual life through prayer and reflection on Scripture. Prayer has a powerful effect on the one who prays: it transforms our hearts, our minds, and our actions.

Leadership is an inside-out activity. It begins with work on the inside and moves outward toward engaging people. The formation of the heart is our path to both leadership and holiness. The heart is the place where we find the quiet of the soul, connect with God, and develop the capacity to know, love, and serve God and one another—heart to heart—before we can lead one another.

Neuroscientists teach that the key to happy, healthy, and spiritually fulfilling lives lies in forming strong connections between the heart and the brain. When we actively participate in the Mass, pray the Rosary with full awareness, or spend prayerful time in Eucharistic adoration, we strengthen the connection between head and heart.

Scripture teaches us to form our hearts in love and then to listen attentively to those carefully formed hearts. We are called to be intentional about following the message the Spirit places within us. Forming the heart prepares us for leadership.

Para los católicos, esto implica una vida espiritual rica, basada en la oración y la reflexión sobre la Sagrada Escritura. La oración tiene un poderoso efecto en quien ora: transforma nuestro corazón, nuestra mente y nuestras acciones.

El liderazgo es una actividad que nace desde el interior. Comienza con el trabajo interior y se proyecta hacia el exterior, en el encuentro con los demás. La formación del corazón es nuestro camino hacia el liderazgo y hacia la santidad. El corazón es el lugar donde encontramos la quietud del alma, nos conectamos con Dios y desarrollamos la capacidad de conocer, amar y servir a Dios y a los demás —de corazón a corazón— antes de poder guiarnos unos a otros.

Los neurocientíficos enseñan que la clave para una vida feliz, saludable y espiritualmente plena es formar conexiones sólidas entre el corazón y el cerebro. Cuando participamos activamente en la Santa Misa, rezamos el Rosario con plena conciencia o dedicamos tiempo de oración en la adoración eucarística, fortalecemos la conexión entre la mente y el corazón.

Formerly called Last Rites or Extreme Unction, this Sacrament is for those experiencing a serious illness, facing an operation or dying. Anointing of the Sick should be performed before death is imminent, when a person is conscious and able to receive comfort from the sacrament.

We make every effort to provide pastoral care and the sacrament of anointing to all who request it; however, families are encouraged to call sooner rather than later. If a loved one is at home and needs the sacrament, please call the office at 592-1949 to arrange for a priest to visit.

In the Hospital?

Please ask the nurse to contact the parish that serves the Hospital you are in for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick.

This is the most efficient way to be sure you or your loved one will receive the sacrament. Be aware that because of HIPAA

Privacy regulations, hospitals do not necessarily notify the parish regarding your hospitalization unless requested by the patient.

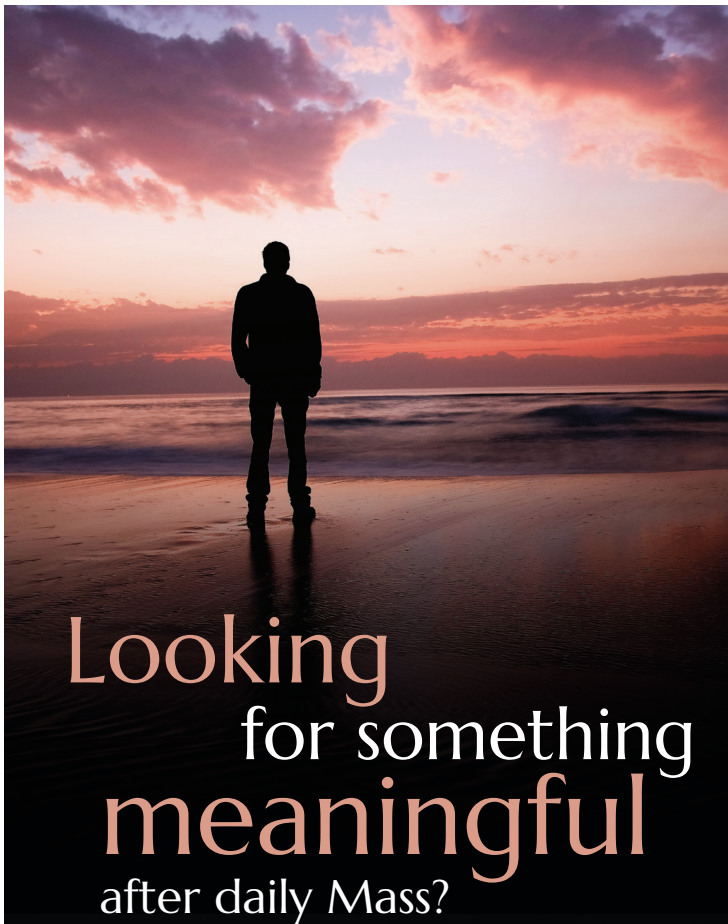

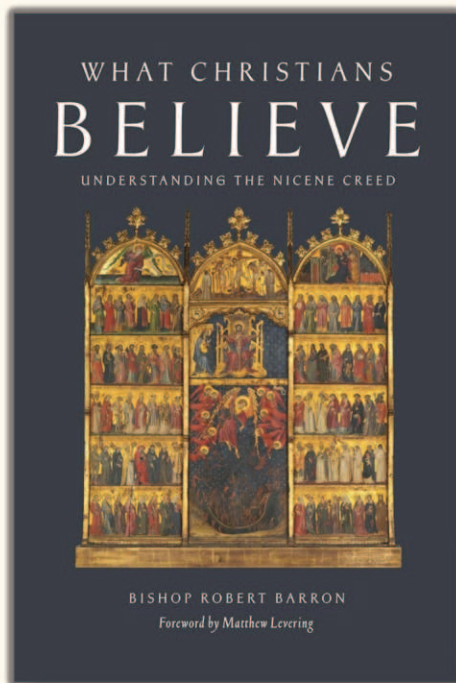

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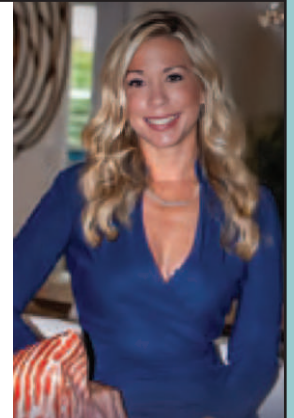
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
