Matthew's Gospel this week highlights what seem to be an unattainable ideal. What Jesus asks of his followers requires an extraordinary interior conversion of heart. Mere external compliance seems impossible; only love as the basis for action could render possible the ethic proposed here by Jesus. Jesus' teaching — how he deliberately pushes his hearers beyond mere observance of the Law to a way of following the commandments that springs from a radical love of God and neighbor — is our focus. At mealtime, talk together about the day's choices, from the most basic to the more complex. As a parent you might talk about choices made at work, in traffic, at a social gathering. You might talk about the American enthusiasm for freedom, and the responsibility that comes with that freedom — to make moral choices in all we do.

LENTEN REGULATIONS

Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics between the ages of 18 years and 59 years (inclusive). On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed.

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. *Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent (and Good Friday) are days of abstinence.*

Note: If a person is unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, they are urged to practice other forms of self-denial that are suitable to their condition.

GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The First Sunday of Lent *Matthew 4: 1-11*

Historians may one day refer to our age as the "Age of Blame" or the "Age of Denial." We do not have sinners any more. Many will look at sinful patterns in their lives and be heard to say: "I have a few issues." There is denial in your face. So, into the desert goes Jesus where he confronts sin not issues. There, he teaches us how to do the same. Satan tempts Jesus to be something other than God intended, a child of God. The suggestion is made that he should use his gifts for himself, feed people so they will make you special, do spectacular things to call attention to yourself, and use power to get what you want. In the end, all sin might be reduced to one thing: the choice to be something other than what God has created us to be. All too often we see heroes falter and ordinary people compromise. Each is a step into sin making it easier than the step before. This season takes us to the desert to know our need for grace, wisdom, and strength in crises with the insight and knowledge to know and recognize sin for what it is. Now is the time to look to God in whose image we are made. Now is the time to look to others to see the image in which they are made. Now is the time to practice saying "no" to what we know is wrong without any compromise. Only when we say, "NO" and mean it will our "Yes" to God's will be credible in God's sight.

This ministry will meet on the **First Thursday of every month at 9:00am** in the **Rome Room**

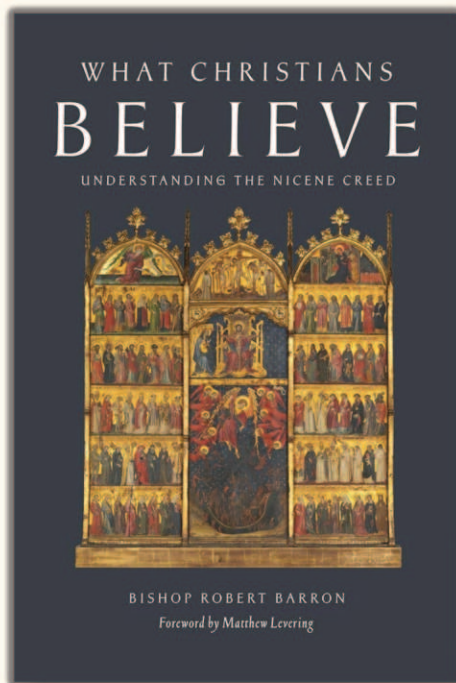
