### 1ST SUNDAY OF LENT



Following his baptism in the Jordan River, Jesus went out to the desert to pray and understand God's will. He was alone in the desert for 40 days and nights. Satan waited until Jesus emerged from the desert before tempting Jesus to use his powers. Of course, Jesus was hungry after fasting for 40 days, so the devil tempted him first with food. "Command these stones to become loaves of bread," was the first dare. Later the devil tempted Jesus to use his power to prove that God would send angels to help Jesus if he jumped from the top of the temple. Finally, Satan offered Jesus the glory and power of all the world if he would but worship Satan. To each temptation, Jesus held fast to what he knew was God's will for him. One of our primary goals as parents is to help our children discover their gifts and use them generously in a way that glorifies God. From a very early age we can remind our children of the source of their gifts and encourage them to use them humbly.


**FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT**

**GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY**

**The Second Sunday of Lent**  
*Matthew 17: 1-9*

Next week, we should notice how the passage begins: “Six days later.” So, it is the seventh day. In other words, it is a replay of creation and now it is the day of completion. New creation begins on that mountain top. With that in mind, what we get with this moment on a mountain top is a glimpse of what the future has in store for those willing to take up the cross, willing to choose the Will of the Father over their own will. I have always found it thought provoking that the Greek word Matthew uses for “Transfiguration” comes into English as metamorphosis, which is what happened when Greek gods took on human form. The God that Jesus reveals to us in this human form is a God of mercy and compassion, a God who knows suffering and has already shared it with us. This is a God who suffers with us because his only Son has suffered for us. We might well wonder about what it meant for Jesus to hear once more the affirmation of his relationship with the Father. There is a dark night of hopelessness lurking around this scene, but the light of God suddenly breaks through that darkness with the promise of victory for those willing to die.



In 1972, Pope Paul VI abolished the formal order, and this important role was entrusted to the laity.

- Distributing bulletins
- Taking an accurate head count of attendees

- Guiding parishioners during Holy Communion
- Maintaining order in the church before and after Mass
- Locating parishioners to present the gifts

Ushers serve with a spirit of hospitality, helping everyone feel welcome in the house of God.

# HOW TO MAKE A GOOD CONFESSION

## Before Confession

Take time to pray and examine your conscience, asking God for the grace to see your sins honestly and to trust in His mercy.

## Prayer Before Confession

Heavenly Father, I come before you with a humble and contrite heart. Help me to recognize my sins and to confess them sincerely. Give me the courage to turn away from sin and the grace to live according to your will. Through the intercession of Mary, Mother of Mercy, I ask for your forgiveness and healing. Amen.

## Examination of Conscience

- Prayerfully reflect on these areas of your life:

## My Relationship with God

- Have I made time for daily prayer?
- Do I attend Mass every Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation?
- Have I used God's name irreverently or in vain?
- Do I trust in God, or do I rely only on myself?

## My Relationship with Others

- Have I been patient, kind, and forgiving with family and others?
- Have I gossiped or spoken unkindly about others?
- Have I held grudges or refused to forgive?
- Have I been honest in my words and actions?
- Have I been generous with my time, talents, and resources?

## My Personal Life

- Have I been faithful to my responsibilities and commitments?
- Have I struggled with anger, jealousy, envy, or pride?
- Have I viewed inappropriate or harmful content?
- Have I been grateful for God's blessings?
- Have I respected the dignity of my body and the bodies of others?

## In the Confessional

1. Begin by saying: "Bless me, Father, for I have sinned."
2. Tell the priest how long it has been since your last confession.
3. Confess your sins honestly and clearly.
  - Be specific; mention serious sins by kind and number.
  - If unsure, ask the priest for guidance.
4. Listen to the priest's counsel and accept the penance given.
5. Pray an Act of Contrition (one option):

## Act of Contrition (traditional):

*O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee, and I detest all my sins because of Thy just punishments, but most of all because they offend Thee, my God, Who art all-good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the help of Thy grace, to sin no more and to avoid the near occasions of sin. Amen.*

6. Receive absolution and make the Sign of the Cross.
7. The priest will dismiss you. Respond: "Thanks be to God."

## After Confession

- Complete your penance as soon as possible
- Thank God for His mercy and forgiveness
- Resolve to avoid sin and grow in holiness

## Prayer After Confession

*Thank you, loving Father, for your mercy and forgiveness. Help me to walk in newness of life and to grow closer to you each day. Strengthen me with your grace, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.*

## Remember

- The priest is bound by the **seal of confession** and can never reveal what you confess
- God's mercy is infinite—no sin is beyond His forgiveness
- Regular confession (monthly is recommended) helps us grow in holiness

  - Si no está seguro de algo, pida orientación al sacerdote.
4. Escuche el consejo del sacerdote y acepte la penitencia asignada.
5. Recite un Acto de Contrición (una opción):

## Acto de Contrición (tradicional):

*Oh Dios mío, me arrepiento de todo corazón de haberte ofendido, y detesto todos mis pecados, no solo por el justo castigo que merecen, sino principalmente porque te ofenden a Ti, Dios mío, que eres toda bondad y digno de todo amor. Propongo firmemente, con la ayuda de tu gracia, no pecar más y evitar las ocasiones próximas de pecado. Amén.*

6. Reciba la absolución y haga la Señal de la Cruz.
7. El sacerdote lo despedirá. Responda: «Demos gracias a Dios».






