2ND SUNDAY OF LENT



The second Sunday of Lent always gives us an account of the transfiguration. Jesus asked Peter, James and John to go with him to the mountain top. While they were there, Jesus was transfigured and became dazzling white before them. Along with Jesus stood Moses and Elijah. The voice of God announced that Jesus was his son and that all should listen to him. The disciples were frightened, but Jesus calmed them. When Peter, James and John looked up, Jesus was the only one left . . . the one to whom we need to listen. Consider your community, family, relatives, and people at work or school. Who is struggling right now because of a recent change? How is this change darkening their world? Once you have identified the person (or people) and their situation, think of one way as a family you can be a light to them. Our action is our response to listening to Jesus.





GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Third Sunday of Lent
John: 4: 5-42

Many who study social and political things believe that the next big war will not be over oil, but over water, and we already have evidence that it might so. The conversation in this familiar Gospel story is about a shared need, thirst. When they recognize that they share the same need, the hostility between them begins to break down. They listen to each other, and as they do, their perceptions of each other begins to soften and shift. Jesus listens, sharing his own need. She listens and begins to recognize him as a prophet and then as the Messiah running to tell others. It all happens because of a simple conversation and the willingness of two people who could not be more opposite to discover their common need and listen to each other. I am always struck that she leaves her bucket behind, and Jesus never seems to get a drink from that well. Maybe this was not about water at all, but rather a mutually shared desire and need for respect, peace, and someone to listen and understand. I think our faith will be more easily embraced and joyfully lived if we can simply see that in spite of whatever divides us, we all need the same thing, some good love and respect. When we start to listen instead of argue, call names, and point the finger of blame at people we might get what we really need and so will everyone else.

TWENTY WAYS TO EXERCISE GOOD STEWARDSHIP OF LENT AND EASTER

Are you looking for ideas to enrich your Lenten experience? Don't worry—you still have the end of February, the month of March, and the beginning of April to be good stewards of the gifts of Lent and the Easter Triduum. Here are twenty ideas to help fill the days of Lent and the beginning of the Easter season with purpose and grace:

1. Commit to a more intentional prayer life—establish a habit of prayer in the morning and before bedtime, and embrace moments of silence each day.
2. Read a book on Christian spirituality that will enrich your spiritual journey. Consider keeping a journal during Lent to reflect on your spiritual highs and lows.
3. Attend a weekday Mass.
4. Pray the Rosary.
5. Make a point of celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least at the beginning and end of Lent.
6. Abstain from meat on Fridays—but don't substitute lobster. Let your fasting be truly sacrificial.
7. Resolve to stop engaging in rumors, gossip, and negative talk that diminishes others.
8. Begin and end each week by sending a message thanking someone for all they do.
9. Say grace whenever you eat at a restaurant—and don't hesitate to make the Sign of the Cross.
10. Seek reconciliation with someone you have hurt or with whom you are not speaking.
11. Invite someone who has been away from the Church to attend Mass with you.
12. Make a gift to a charitable cause. Let it be sacrificial, not merely what is “left over.”
13. Thank a bishop, priest, or member of a religious community for their witness. Consider inviting them for coffee or a meal.
14. Visit someone who is alone.
15. Reflect on the most pressing challenges facing our Church and pray for a Spirit-filled response.
16. Pray the Stations of the Cross.
17. Find out if someone in your parish is participating in the OCIA program and send a note of encouragement.
18. Learn how your diocese serves the poor and discover ways you can help.
19. Attend your parish's Good Friday liturgy.
20. Invite someone who might otherwise be alone to share Easter Sunday dinner.





Why should I become a *member* of a Parish?



Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish, they automatically belong. Membership requires formal enrollment in the parish, but it is more than just filling out some forms. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to participate in the religious, social and ministerial activities of a parish.

Registration not only shows you belong, **but it is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, letters for Immigration, participating in Faith Formation and receiving donation statements for tax purposes.**

Belonging to a parish is a commitment. Just as you want the parish to provide Masses, Sacraments, Faith Formation and ministries, the parish needs to be able to count on you to help and assist in their mission; to be an active member.

Being an active member at St. Agnes involves several key aspects:

- **Registration:** Active members are formally registered in the parish
- **Worship:** Active members attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation (except for illness or emergency)
- **Stewardship:** Active members serve the community in various ways by sharing their time and talent
- **Financial Support:** Active members support the parish financially, using offertory envelopes or online giving (WeShare)

Are you registered with us? One way to know is if you receive regular communications from us, such as offertory envelopes, or occasional emails. If you do not, then perhaps you are not officially registered, or you have been marked as inactive. If you are unsure, please call the parish office.

Registering at St. Agnes is a statement of faith and support in the life and work of our parish. As a faith community, we are here to help each other on our journey of discipleship. Registration forms are found in the Parish Office, at each entrance of the Church, and on our website, stagnesnaples.org.

SANTA PERPETUA Y SANTA FELICITA



Santa Perpetua y Santa Felicitas fueron mártires de la fe en Jesucristo del siglo II, nacieron en el norte de Africa. Estas extraordinarias mujeres entregaron la vida con valor, testimoniando que la confianza en Dios es capaz de suscitar hazañas. Por eso, en memoria de su sacrificio, realizado mientras experimentaban el don de la maternidad, la iglesia honra y pide por todas las madres del mundo. Sus nombres quedaron inscritos en la Letanía de los santos y en la Liturgia Eucarística. Felicitas es patrona de las madres que dan a luz en condiciones difíciles, mientras que Perpetua es la patrona

de las madres lactantes. Las razones estriban en lo siguiente: Felicitas se encontraba embarazada cuando fue apresada, y Perpetua era madre de un bebe lactante al momento de su martirio. ¿Cuál fue su delito? Ser Cristianas. Perpetua pertenecía a una familia rica e influyente, que se había convertido gracias a la predicación de un diacono de nombre Saturo. Las dos conversas trascendieron las diferencias sociales y llegaron a verse como hermanas, porque eran hijas del mismo Padre celestial. Que hoy ellas sean un ejemplo de fortaleza en defender nuestra fe, profesarla y compartirla con todo el que aún no conoce el verdadero amor. Perpetua y Felicitas rueguen por nosotros.




