4TH SUNDAY OF LENT



Using saliva and earth, Jesus made a paste to heal the blind man. The healing became a true conversion for the man, but created some problems for Jesus with the Jewish leaders. Because this healing took place on the Sabbath, the Pharisees accused Jesus of breaking Jewish law. The Pharisees tried to get confirmation of this action from the blind man's parents and from the blind man himself. In the end, the authorities were unable to charge Jesus with any wrongdoing and had to recognize that Jesus was gaining many disciples. In order for parents to help their children follow the light of Christ, they too must open their eyes. As Jesus helped the blind man understand, it is not enough to see only with our eyes. We need also to see with our hearts and allow our every action to reflect this sight. Jesus healed the man of his blindness, but in the end the man recognized Jesus as the Messiah and worshiped him.

GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Fifth Sunday of Lent

John 11: 1-45

The apostle Thomas speaks only three times in the Gospels. This is the second time, and he speaks to us just as much as he spoke to his earlier companions who follow Jesus Christ. Thomas challenges fear. His companions were afraid to go to Jerusalem, and they did not want Jesus to go there. So, Thomas speaks up suggesting that anyone living in fear is already dead. Fear drains the life out of us. It leaves us paralyzed and unable to fulfill God's plan for us. Jesus knows what God wants, not just from him but from us all, and so, fearless he goes. There is much more to this episode than a story about a dead man being called from a tomb. This is not the first time Jesus has called someone to life. There are dead people trapped in tombs of fear everywhere afraid of what people will think or say about them if they speak up for the values of our faith and the Gospel. There are people who fear death itself, and that fear keeps them from really living in the present with joy and gratitude. There are people who live in fear of change and what it might ask of them. They resist with minds and hearts closed to the movement of the Holy Spirit in their lives, a Spirit that makes all things new. Whatever fear lurks in our lives can be relieved by Jesus Christ who calls to us all to be unbound and set free to live with joy and glorify the Lord.

THE BLIND MAN SEES!

In today's Gospel, Jesus heals a man born blind, an act rich in theological meaning. The symbolism within this miracle invites deeper reflection.

- Jesus' use of earth and saliva recalls the creation narrative in Genesis, suggesting a moment of new creation.
- The man's restored sight signifies rebirth and a transition from darkness to light.
- Jesus, the Light of the World, illuminates both physical and spiritual blindness.
- The washing in the pool reflects the cleansing power of Baptism.
- Though created to know God, humanity remains in need of renewed spiritual vision because of sin.

The Pharisees, focused solely on the law, reject the miracle and refuse to acknowledge Jesus' divine authority, ultimately casting out the healed man.

This passage prompts an important question: What do we fail to see? Are we attentive to what God reveals in prayer and silence? As Saint Augustine notes, the blind man represents the human condition—wounded by spiritual blindness inherited through pride and separation from God. Like him, we cannot heal ourselves; we require Christ's transforming grace.

Lent offers an opportunity to seek true understanding rather than remain in darkness. Just as the blind man's physical healing led him to faith, we are invited to open our eyes to God's presence and respond with belief. May we, like him, witness boldly to our faith in Jesus Christ.

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús sana a un hombre ciego de nacimiento, un acto rico en significado teológico. El simbolismo de este milagro invita a una reflexión más profunda.

- El uso que Jesús hace de la tierra y la saliva evoca la narración de la creación en el Génesis, sugiriendo un momento de nueva creación.
- La vista restaurada del hombre significa renacimiento y una transición de la oscuridad a la luz.
- Jesús, la Luz del Mundo, ilumina tanto la ceguera física como la espiritual.
- El lavamiento en la piscina refleja el poder purificador del Bautismo.
- Aunque creada para conocer a Dios, la humanidad sigue necesitando una visión espiritual renovada debido al pecado.

Los fariseos, centrados únicamente en la ley, rechazan el milagro y se niegan a reconocer la autoridad divina de Jesús, expulsando finalmente al hombre sanado.

Este pasaje plantea una pregunta importante: ¿Qué no vemos? ¿Estamos atentos a lo que Dios revela en la oración y el silencio? Como señala san Agustín, el ciego representa la condición humana: herido por la ceguera espiritual heredada del orgullo y la separación de Dios. Como él, no podemos sanarnos a nosotros mismos; Necesitamos la gracia transformadora de Cristo. La Cuaresma nos brinda la oportunidad de buscar la verdadera comprensión en lugar de permanecer en la oscuridad. Así como la curación física del ciego lo condujo a la fe, estamos invitados a abrir los ojos a la presencia de Dios y responder con fe. Que, como él, demos testimonio valiente de nuestra fe en Jesucristo.



A tradition of those with Polish and Eastern European ancestry is the traditional blessing of Easter Food Baskets on Holy Saturday. In earlier times, the priest came to people's homes to bless the food, but today, the people go to church for these blessings and prayers. It has been a tradition at St. Agnes for people to bring baskets of food that they will serve on Easter to be blessed in the church in English and Polish at 2 p.m. on Holy Saturday. There is a symbolic meaning to some of the foods included in the baskets; Bread for new life with Jesus seen as the "Bread of Life;" Sausage or ham for health, prosperity and the belief in the Resurrection; horseradish/vinegar to ensure physical strength and remind us of the agony suffered by Christ on the cross; and salt for wisdom, justice and purification. Candles also signify Jesus as the Light of the world and finally, eggs indicate hope, new life and Jesus' Resurrection which may or may not be colored. These are just a few!



SAN JOSÉ

TERROR DE LOS DEMONIOS.

San José, como hombre justo y casto, es modelo de pureza y fidelidad. La tradición de la Iglesia siempre ha visto en él a un varón que vivió una castidad perfecta, amando profundamente a la Virgen María con un amor puro y desinteresado. Precisamente por esa pureza y castidad –virtudes que la espiritualidad cristiana considera especialmente odiadas por el demonio– San José ocupa un lugar privilegiado en la lucha contra el mal.

Cuando supo que María estaba embarazada, pensó en repudiarla en secreto. No fue por desconfianza, sino –como han explicado varios autores espirituales– porque su amor y su humildad eran tan grandes que no se consideraba digno de permanecer junto a un misterio tan santo. El evangelio lo llama “hombre justo” (Mt 1,19), subrayando su rectitud delante de Dios.

En la tradición espiritual también se le invoca como “terror de los demonios”, título que expresa su poderosa intercesión en el combate espiritual, siempre unido a María, la mujer que pisa la cabeza de la serpiente (cf. Gn 3,15). El imaginario popular incluso lo representa, como buen carpintero, cortando con su hacha la cola de la serpiente, símbolo del mal.

Muchos sacerdotes y fieles recomiendan renovar la consagración al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús, al Inmaculado Corazón de María y al castísimo corazón de San José, confiando en su protección especial. Además, la Iglesia lo reconoce como Patrono de la buena muerte, ya que, según la tradición, tuvo la gracia de morir acompañado por Jesús y María.

Como enseñó el Papa Benedicto XVI, a través de José vamos a María, y por medio de María llegamos a la fuente de toda santidad: Jesucristo. San José y la Santísima Virgen nos conducen siempre hacia Él.
