## MARCH 22, 2026

### 5TH SUNDAY OF LENT



In this Gospel, John tells the story of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead. The story is significant because it is likely that his action was his last miracle before Jesus began the journey toward his own death. Jesus was called to Bethany to save his friend, but instead waited several days to return. This action confused Lazarus' sisters, Mary and Martha, because they knew that Jesus could have healed their brother. Jesus used the incident to strengthen the faith of Mary, Martha, and all who believed. He made sure that Lazarus was raised from death so that the people could witness God's glory. The healing power of Jesus brings new life to all of us. Are there some things in our lives that cause us to die to others? Perhaps we are impatient, ungrateful, critical, or quick to anger. Maybe we're proud, boastful, or envious. Jesus promises us new life if we trust in him and allow our actions to follow his ways.

## GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

### The Sunday of the Passion *Matthew 21: 1-11*

I think that Social Scientists will look back upon our years and call this "The Age of the Victim." Playing the role of a victim has somehow taken over the psyche of many people in the western world. It goes along with the system of blame that we have cultivated. Someone is always responsible for my troubles and misery, and then the victim begins to cry out: "Why me?" "How could this happen to me?" A pity party has almost taken the place of a Birthday Party. We listen once again to Matthew's Passion next weekend and learn how Jesus confronted evil. He was no helpless victim. He knew from listening to the Prophets in Synagogue what was likely to happen and he went straight to Jerusalem. He heard that crowd coming in the garden. He did not run. From every detail it is clear that he believed that God was in charge, and what happens was all according to God's plan. So, he faced those who would betray, torture, and sentence him to death with silence. Refusing to argue, he simply prays just as he taught us to pray: "Thy will be done." Even while feeling deserted, he turned to the God he could never fully understand. There is no greater prayer. At that moment, a veil that separated the holy from the profane was ripped from heaven to earth. A God who has become vulnerable and visible is no longer separate from creation.

## STEWARDS, NOT OWNERS

In *Stewardship: A Disciple's Response*, we read:

“Once one chooses to become a disciple of Jesus Christ, stewardship is not an option.”

**“For if we live, we live for the Lord, and if we die, we die for the Lord; so then, whether we live or die, we are the Lord's.” – Romans 14:8**

This is the essence of stewardship: **everything we have and everything we are is a gift from God.** We are not the “owners” of anything; rather, we are **stewards** of the gifts God has entrusted to us—especially the gift of our own lives.

We are called to pray daily and ask God how He is calling us to live the life He intended for us.

*(St. Louis Diocese)*

### A Stewardship Way of Life Involves:

#### 1. Recognizing that everything is a gift and a blessing.

As stewards, we grow increasingly aware that all we are and all we have come from God. This means accepting the biblical truth that **we own nothing**. Scripture reminds us that we come into the world with nothing and leave the world with nothing (Job 1).

A stewardship way of life acknowledges God as the sole Creator and owner of all things. We accept that we are merely the **stewards or managers of God's gifts and blessings**. Our mission is to manage and use wisely and responsibly everything God has placed in our care.

#### 2. Developing a lifestyle of generosity.

As we grow in stewardship, we gradually cultivate a life marked by generosity. Generosity is a clear sign that we truly believe and accept the biblical truth that **God owns everything**.

Conversely, when we hoard our gifts and talents, we begin to act as if we are the owners of our blessings rather than their stewards, using them only as we please instead of according to God's will.

#### 3. Remembering that we will give an account of our stewardship.

As we strive to live a stewardship-centered life, we remain mindful that one day we will be called to give an account of our lives before God.

We must ask ourselves: **How well did we use the gifts God entrusted to us to bless the lives of others?**

A tradition of those with Polish and Eastern European ancestry is the traditional blessing of Easter Food Baskets on Holy Saturday. In earlier times, the priest came to people's homes to bless the food, but today, the people go to church for these blessings and prayers. It has been a tradition at St. Agnes for people to bring baskets of food that they will serve on Easter to be blessed in the church in English and Polish at 2 p.m. on Holy Saturday. There is a symbolic meaning to some of the foods included in the baskets; Bread for new life with Jesus seen as the "Bread of Life;" Sausage or ham for health, prosperity and the belief in the Resurrection; horseradish/vinegar to ensure physical strength and remind us of the agony suffered by Christ on the cross; and salt for wisdom, justice and purification. Candles also signify Jesus as the Light of the world and finally, eggs indicate hope, new life and Jesus' Resurrection which may or may not be colored. These are just a few!

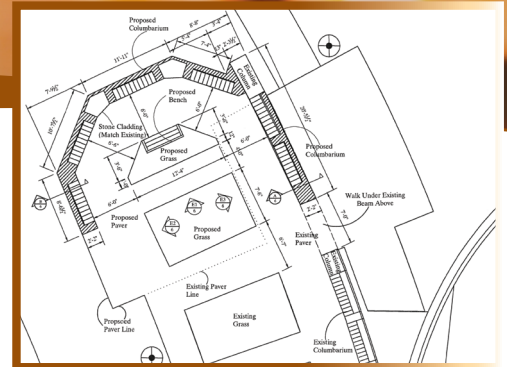

Dear St. Agnes Parishioners,

I hope this message finds you well as we prepare our hearts for the joy of Easter. As many of you have noticed, construction is actively underway alongside our existing Columbarium — and I wanted to take a moment to share an update on this exciting milestone for our parish family.

Our Columbarium expansion has been more than a year in the making. The project contracts received Diocesan approval in December, and permitting began immediately thereafter. Construction officially commenced on March 2 with CJE Construction mobilizing on-site and securing the work area. Since that day, the team has been moving steadily and on schedule.

Per the current construction timeline, we anticipate final inspections to be completed as early as the end of April. While construction timelines can shift, our contractor is confident in meeting that target, and we are cautiously optimistic.

When complete, this expansion will add **620 new niches** to our Columbarium — a tremendous gift to our community. As many of you know, our current Columbarium has been at capacity, and a waiting list has already grown to over 100 families. Once our rollout plan is finalized, we will begin reaching out to those on the waiting list first.

**If you are interested in securing your place in the new Columbarium, please contact the parish office to be added to the waiting list.**

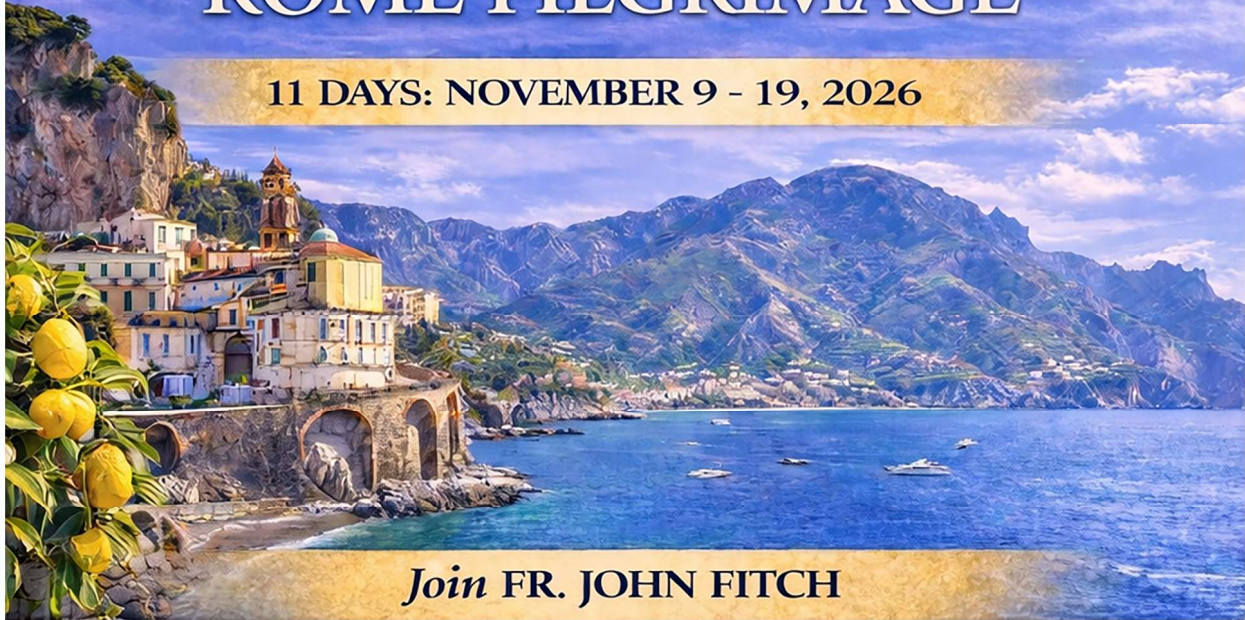
