PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD



Each year on this Sunday we follow the events of Jesus' life from the time he entered Jerusalem until the point where he was laid in the tomb after his crucifixion. Jesus first entered Jerusalem riding a donkey amid waving palm leaves. It was in Jerusalem that he foretold Judas' betrayal, Peter's denial, and established the Eucharist at the Passover meal. Jesus took his disciples into Gethsemane to pray, but they could not stay awake with him. In the garden, Jesus was turned over to the authorities, tried before the Sanhedrin, brought to Pilate, and sentenced to death. When offered a choice during the festival to release a prisoner, the people chose the release of Barabbas. Their choice was beyond Pilate's comprehension, so he symbolically washed his hands of the whole deal. Jesus was turned over to the Roman authorities for crucifixion and mocked by them. Finally, Jesus died on the cross. The earth darkened and quaked. He was prepared quickly for burial and laid in the tomb.

GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

Easter Sunday

John 20: 1-9

Our scientific age always looks for evidence. The story we tell next weekend fails when it comes to evidence. Rolled up, folded cloths prove nothing. We are told that one of the men at that tomb believed, but we do not know what he believed. It does tell us that they did not understand raising an important question: "How can you believe what you do not understand?" All we are told is that the tomb is empty. These are people Jesus once called: "people of little faith." What we see is that the "little faith" they had was something to grow on, and they did. We can too. One thing that beloved disciple understood was that he did not understand. At that point, he could begin to be drawn into the mystery and the message that love is never overcome when it comes to God. The three in this Gospel had just enough faith to allow them to distrust their verdict that this was the end of Jesus. There was more to come as there always is, and it is not logical. We will be in church next week as people of little faith who do not understand a lot these days. Those three teach us not to flee from tragedy, but stand in front of it with a little faith and a little hope and not be terrified by what we do not understand and yet believe. If anyone still wants proof for the Resurrection, we are all they get. Those wanting proof must look at us, how we live and face evil.

PALM SUNDAY MEANINGS

✠ Palm Sunday commemorates the entrance of Christ into Jerusalem (Matthew 21:1–9), when palm branches were placed in His path, shortly before His arrest on Holy Thursday.

✠ Jesus wanted His disciples to understand that He was not sending them on a simple errand—the equivalent of a modern-day Starbucks run. Little did these two disciples know that their task was essential to the events of Palm Sunday.

✠ Instead of riding on a horse, which symbolizes power and victory in battle, Jesus chose to ride on a donkey, a sign of humble service and peace. By doing so, He reveals that He brings a message of peace from God to His people.

✠ God invites us today to enter into the Paschal Mystery through the liturgies of Holy Week. He calls us to walk humbly with Jesus, uniting our journey with His—embracing humility and obedience as we follow Him on the way of the cross, striving for holiness and simplicity of heart. May we grow in faithfulness as we journey with Him this week.

✠ This day marks the beginning of Holy Week. It is a time to walk with Jesus during His final days before the cross. Palm Sunday (Year A) invites us to reflect on the contrast between the joyful cheers of the crowd and the suffering that is to come.

✠ We hold palm branches to remember that Jesus’ kingdom is built on peace and service. His way is different from the world’s understanding of power. As we reflect on this day, we are called to follow Him in humility and love.

✠ En lugar de montar a caballo —lo cual simboliza poder y victoria en la batalla—, Jesús eligió montar en un asno, signo de servicio humilde y de paz. Al hacerlo, revela que trae un mensaje de paz de parte de Dios para su pueblo.

✠ Hoy, Dios nos invita a adentrarnos en el Misterio Pascual a través de las liturgias de la Semana Santa. Nos llama a caminar humildemente junto a Jesús, uniendo nuestro propio camino al suyo; a abrazar la humildad y la obediencia mientras lo seguimos por el camino de la cruz, aspirando a la santidad y a la sencillez de corazón. Que crezcamos en fidelidad mientras caminamos junto a Él durante esta semana.

✠ Este día marca el comienzo de la Semana Santa. Es un tiempo para caminar junto a Jesús durante sus últimos días antes de la cruz. El Domingo de Ramos (Ciclo A) nos invita a reflexionar sobre el contraste entre los vítores jubilosos de la multitud y el sufrimiento que está por venir.

✠ Sostenemos ramas de palma para recordar que el reino de Jesús se edifica sobre la paz y el servicio. Su camino es diferente de la concepción que el mundo tiene del poder. Al reflexionar en este día, somos llamados a seguirlo con humildad y amor.

A tradition of those with Polish and Eastern European ancestry is the traditional blessing of Easter Food Baskets on Holy Saturday. In earlier times, the priest came to people's homes to bless the food, but today, the people go to church for these blessings and prayers. It has been a tradition at St. Agnes for people to bring baskets of food that they will serve on Easter to be blessed in the church in English and Polish at 2 p.m. on Holy Saturday. There is a symbolic meaning to some of the foods included in the baskets; Bread for new life with Jesus seen as the "Bread of Life;" Sausage or ham for health, prosperity and the belief in the Resurrection; horseradish/vinegar to ensure physical strength and remind us of the agony suffered by Christ on the cross; and salt for wisdom, justice and purification. Candles also signify Jesus as the Light of the world and finally, eggs indicate hope, new life and Jesus' Resurrection which may or may not be colored. These are just a few!

DOMINGO DE RAMOS: ENTRADA DEL SEÑOR EN JERUSALÉN



Con el Domingo de Ramos iniciamos solemnemente la Semana Santa, recordando la entrada triunfal de Jesús en Jerusalén, donde fue recibido con alegría y aclamado como el Mesías.

En esta celebración se entrelazan dos grandes tradiciones litúrgicas: la de Jerusalén y la de Roma. La tradición de Jerusalén destaca el gesto profético de Jesús, quien entra como Rey de paz y Mesías esperado, siendo aclamado por el pueblo, pero encaminándose también hacia el cumplimiento de las profecías mediante su pasión.

Por su parte, la tradición de Roma nos invita a entrar conscientemente en la Semana de la Pasión del Señor, mediante la proclamación solemne del Evangelio —especialmente el relato de la Pasión según san Mateo— que conviene escuchar en su totalidad para el bien espiritual de los fieles. Por ello, este día también es llamado Domingo de la Pasión.

Así, el Domingo de Ramos une en un solo misterio el anuncio del triunfo real de Cristo y el anuncio de su entrega redentora en la cruz.

Como explica el papa Benedicto XVI en su obra Jesús de Nazaret: Desde la entrada en Jerusalén hasta la Resurrección, el gesto de Jesús al entrar montado en un burro —un animal no usado anteriormente— expresa su condición real. Este detalle, junto con los mantos extendidos en el camino, evoca la tradición de la realeza en Israel, especialmente la monarquía davídica, y señala la esperanza mesiánica que se cumple en Él.

Asimismo, el grito “¡Hosanna!” es una aclamación de júbilo y súplica, que reconoce la llegada del Mesías y proclama que el Reino de Dios se hace presente en medio de su pueblo. Hoy, como entonces, acompañamos a Cristo con fe y devoción, reconociendo en Él al Rey humilde que viene a salvarnos. Que esta celebración nos disponga a vivir con mayor profundidad el misterio de su Pasión, Muerte y Resurrección.

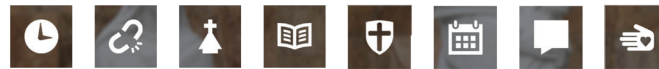



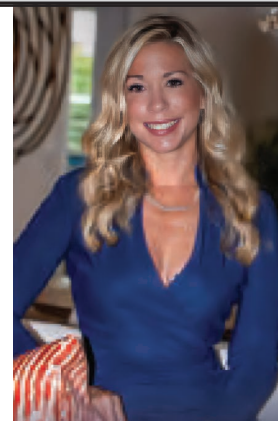
