## SUNDAY OF DIVINE MERCY



Following Jesus' crucifixion the disciples were still uncertain of his message. They lost hope and in fear locked themselves in a room. Without entering through the door, Jesus appeared before them with a greeting of peace and a mission to spread the Good News. The disciple, Thomas, was not in the room. When he learned of Jesus' visit, he would not believe it. But about week later, Jesus appeared in a similar way when Thomas was with the others. Jesus invited Thomas to touch the wounds in his hands and side. Thomas knew immediately that it was Jesus and believed in him. Parents are often the source of hope and encouragement for their children. When a child falls repeatedly while learning to walk or ride a bike, it is a parent who coaxes, encourages and praises the child. Parents provide hope and comfort when a child falls short of a goal in academics, relationships, sports, or whatever. Parents can relate to the role of Jesus with his disciples.

## GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

### The Third Sunday of Easter

*Luke 24: 13-35*

All of us are way too familiar with grief and disappointment. So, it is not much of a challenge to understand the mood that begins next weekend's Gospel. We have all had times when God fails to live up to our expectations of what God should do or how God should act. What is more difficult to understand is the failure on the part of these disciples to recognize this one in whom they have placed their hope. I wonder sometimes if perhaps their hopes simply did not match God's hopes. They hoped for a Messiah who would lift them from the oppression of the Romans, but the Romans destroyed the one they had hoped for. They could not imagine a Messiah who would be rejected and murdered even though the Scriptures they knew and the prophets they had read should have prepared them. This story is more about hope than about the resurrection. Their problem was that they thought hope was the conviction that something would turn out well. It didn't, and they were about to give up on hope. A better way to think about hope is to see it as the certainty that something can make sense no matter how it turns out because it is God's plan. As they walked reviewing the Scriptures, taking, blessing, and breaking bread in a shared meal, the Jesus they thought they knew was transformed into the risen Christ who stays with them.

## WHERE ARE WE GOING?

The International Theological Commission is an important “think tank” of the Church, overseen by the Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith.

One particularly fascinating section of its document is the treatment of the importance of vocation. Properly understood, a vocation is not merely about a career choice, but about the fundamental relationship with God and others that has been given to each person. Vocation is a gift bestowed upon every individual.

Yet contemporary culture, the ITC observes, often views life as a self-directed project, suggesting that we need to create ourselves. In contrast, the document presents vocation as a gift to be received. We do not “invent” ourselves; rather, we “discover” ourselves by responding to a call that originates outside of us—from God.

Because we are created in the image of God, our vocation is to reflect the relational nature of the Trinity; therefore, it is inherently social. Our vocation calls us to move away from the “isolated I” toward the “united we” of community. As such, vocation involves the responsibility to care for creation and to use our intelligence and gifts to promote the dignity of all God’s children.

The document also highlights the connection between responding to God’s call and the call to holiness. Answering God’s call authentically is the path to true holiness.

Becoming fully human and becoming holy are one and the same. Holiness is not limited to the priesthood or religious life; rather, every state of life—marriage, single life, and professional work—is a path to living out the radical call to love through ongoing conversion, turning away from dehumanizing ways and toward a life of grace.

This insight is especially relevant in a time when so many people are treated inhumanely. We must never fail to raise our voices against rhetoric that demeans immigrants, commentary that trivializes the loss of human life in war, or arguments that diminish the value of life in the womb. We are called to urge all people to turn away from these dehumanizing paths.

We are invited to reflect on our own calling from God. The path before us involves becoming who we were meant to be by responding to God’s love, serving the common good, and journeying toward the fullness of life in the Kingdom of God.

It also means doing everything possible to ensure that every person has the freedom and opportunity to flourish as God intended.

But the question remains: Where are you going? Where is God calling you to go?

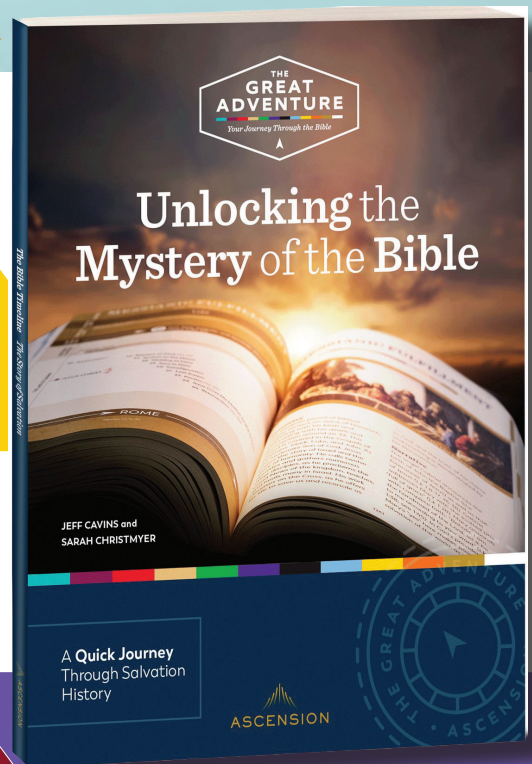

## Why should I become a *member* of a Parish?



Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish, they automatically belong. Membership requires formal enrollment in the parish, but it is more than just filling out some forms. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to participate in the religious, social and ministerial activities of a parish.

Registration not only shows you belong, **but it is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, letters for Immigration, participating in Faith Formation and receiving donation statements for tax purposes.**

Belonging to a parish is a commitment. Just as you want the parish to provide Masses, Sacraments, Faith Formation and ministries, the parish needs to be able to count on you to help and assist in their mission; to be an active member.

### Being an active member at St. Agnes involves several key aspects:

- **Registration:** Active members are formally registered in the parish
- **Worship:** Active members attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation (except for illness or emergency)
- **Stewardship:** Active members serve the community in various ways by sharing their time and talent
- **Financial Support:** Active members support the parish financially, using offertory envelopes or online giving (WeShare)

**Are you registered with us?** One way to know is if you receive regular communications from us, such as offertory envelopes, or occasional emails. If you do not, then perhaps you are not officially registered, or you have been marked as inactive. If you are unsure, please call the parish office.

**Registering at St. Agnes** is a statement of faith and support in the life and work of our parish. As a faith community, we are here to help each other on our journey of discipleship. Registration forms are found in the Parish Office, at each entrance of the Church, and on our website, [stagnesnaples.org](http://stagnesnaples.org).

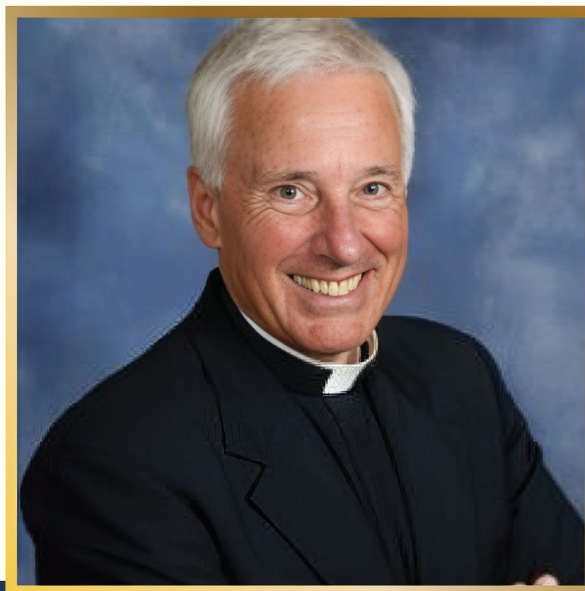

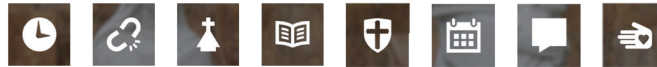

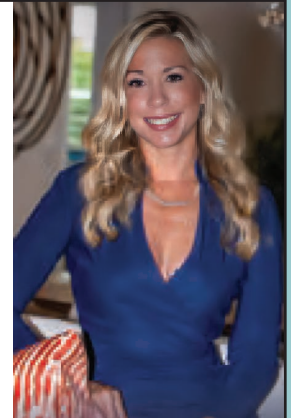
