### 5TH SUNDAY OF EASTER



During Jesus' Last Supper, Jesus explained to the disciples what was to happen next in God's plan. Jesus would no longer be visibly among them, but would return to the Father. In heaven, Jesus would prepare a place for each of us to come when he returned to get us. In his discussion, Jesus also made it clear that if we know him, we would also know God, and that they are one in the same. The way for us to be with the Father is to follow Jesus. Often it is easier for our children to trust the words of Jesus than it is for us. Like the disciples, we can be a bit apprehensive not seeing Jesus. After all, it would be easier to follow someone if we could actually see where he is going! Instead, the words of Jesus challenge us to have faith in him and trust where the journey leads. The example of our lives should always point us and our children toward the rooms Jesus prepares for each of us.

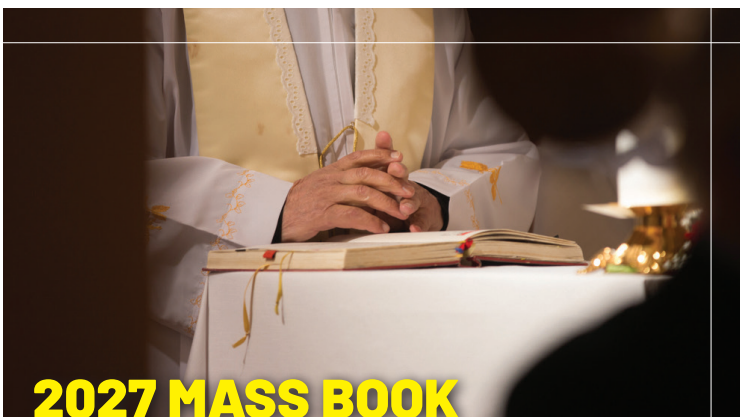

## GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

### The Sixth Sunday of Easter

*John 14: 15-21*

Still at the table of the Last Supper next week, Jesus makes a promise that will draw us into a deep and profound truth. There is something intimate going on, and the only way we can begin to understand this is through the experience of real, true, human love. This is far more than affection. It is a relationship that changes our identity, changes how we think, feel, and look at all creation and one another. Like the true sacramental love of husband and wife, or parents for their children, there is nothing that can separate them, not even death. That loved one is deep within us always present bringing peace and the assurance that we are acceptable and loved unconditionally. That love is the promise made to us all as Jesus shared that final meal with his disciples. To whatever extent we have shaped our lives to be like his, we shall share his experience of union with the Father though union with him. This is more than saying that God is first in our lives. This is to believe that to love all others is to love our creator. This is what it means to be in Christ, because Christ loved everyone, and in so doing, he showed us how to love God and draw us deeply into divine life. So, no one is alone if we are there for them, and we are never alone as long as we come again and again to the altar confirming this covenant of love and service God has made with us.

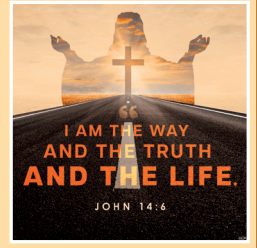

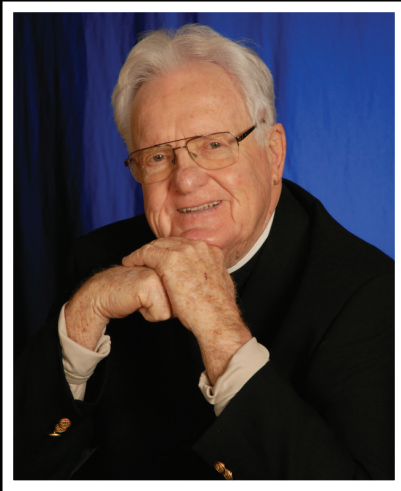

# In Memoriam



**MSGR. ROBERT J. COLL**  
1930 – 2026



It is with great sadness that we share the passing of Msgr. Robert J. Coll, who died on April 20, 2026, in Naples, at the age of 95. A beloved member of our St. Agnes Parish family, Msgr. Coll's kind and generous heart touched all who knew him, and he will be deeply missed.

Born in 1930 in Upper Darby, Pennsylvania, Msgr. Coll was ordained for the Diocese of Allentown on May 7, 1959, after graduating from St. Joseph University and St. Charles Borromeo Seminary. He served parishes in Reading, Allentown, and West Lawn before leaving a lasting mark on the universal Church as the founder of the Catholic Relief Services Operation Rice Bowl — a Lenten practice he began in the Allentown Diocese that was adopted nationwide by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops in 1975.

Msgr. Coll retired to Naples in 1999 and faithfully assisted at St. John the Evangelist and St. Agnes Parishes for 25 years — a testament to his tireless dedication to service and his love for this community.

May he rest in the peace of the Lord he served so well. Please keep Msgr. Coll and all who mourn him in your prayers.

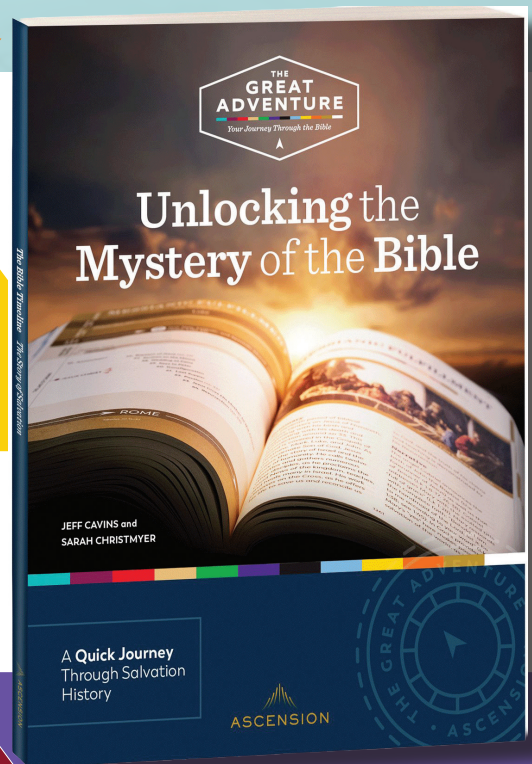

We make every effort to provide pastoral care and the sacrament of anointing to all who request it; however, families are encouraged to call sooner rather than later. If a loved one is at home and needs the sacrament, please call the office at 592-1949 to arrange for a priest to visit.

Please ask the nurse to contact the parish that serves the Hospital you are in for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick.

This is the most efficient way to be sure you or your loved one will receive the sacrament. Be aware that because of HIPAA

Privacy regulations, hospitals do not necessarily notify the parish regarding your hospitalization unless requested by the patient.

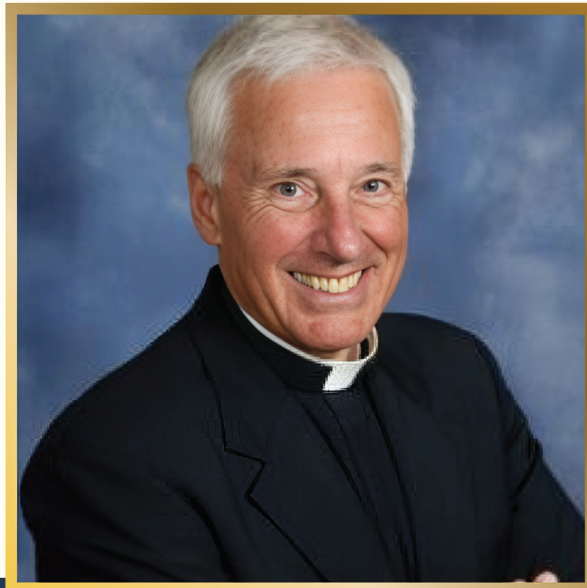

# Why should I become a *member* of a Parish?



Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish, they automatically belong. Membership requires formal enrollment in the parish, but it is more than just filling out some forms. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to participate in the religious, social and ministerial activities of a parish.

Registration not only shows you belong, **but it is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, letters for Immigration, participating in Faith Formation and receiving donation statements for tax purposes.**

**Belonging to a parish is a commitment. Just as you want the parish to provide Masses, Sacraments, Faith Formation and ministries, the parish needs to be able to count on you to help and assist in their mission; to be an active member.**

## **Being an active member at St. Agnes involves several key aspects:**

- **Registration:** Active members are formally registered in the parish
- **Worship:** Active members attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation (except for illness or emergency)
- **Stewardship:** Active members serve the community in various ways by sharing their time and talent
- **Financial Support:** Active members support the parish financially, using offertory envelopes or online giving (WeShare)

**Are you registered with us?** One way to know is if you receive regular communications from us, such as offertory envelopes, or occasional emails. If you do not, then perhaps you are not officially registered, or you have been marked as inactive. If you are unsure, please call the parish office.

**Registering at St. Agnes** is a statement of faith and support in the life and work of our parish. As a faith community, we are here to help each other on our journey of discipleship. ### Santos Felipe y Santiago

Apóstoles y mártires de Cristo

La iglesia celebra a Felipe y Santiago, quienes formaron parte del grupo de discípulos más cercanos a Jesús, los Apóstoles. Ambos coronaron sus vidas, consagradas al anuncio de la Buena Nueva, en el martirio. Ese fue el signo de su santidad y fidelidad absoluta a Jesús de Nazareth, Dios hecho hombre. Felipe nació en Betsaida y antes de seguir a Jesús fue discípulo de Juan el Bautista. Fue uno de los primeros a los que llamó el Señor. Fue Él quien preguntó al Señor "¿Como vamos a darle de comer a tanta gente?" preocupado por aquellos que seguían al Maestro y no tenían que comer. También fue Felipe quien le pidió a Jesús que le "muestre al Padre" mientras compartían la última cena. Después de la Ascension del Señor a los cielos, junto al resto de apóstoles y la Virgen Maria, Felipe recibió el Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés. De ahí partió a la región de Frigia (ubicada hoy entre Turquía, Hungría, Ucrania y el este de Rusia) para anunciar la Buena noticia a las gentes de esas tierras. Felipe murió apedreado y crucificado. Santiago, el menor en la escritura recibe el nombre de "el hijo de Alfeo"; también se le llama el "primo del Señor" porque su madre era pariente de la Virgen Maria. A Él se le atribuye la autoría de la primera epístola católica. En esta se encuentra consignado uno de los principios mas importantes de la vida cristiana: "La fe sin obras, esta muerta". En los Hechos de los Apóstoles se le describe como un personaje muy querido de la iglesia de Jerusalén, a quien se le llamaba con frecuencia "el obispo". Fue obligado a decir que Jesús no era el Mesías, a lo que Él se negó y por esta razón fue apedreado y durante su agonía no cesaba de repetir las palabras de Cristo: "Padre Dios, te ruego que los perdones porque no saben lo que hacen."

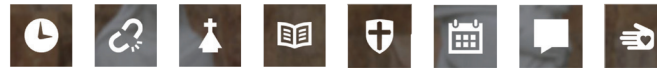

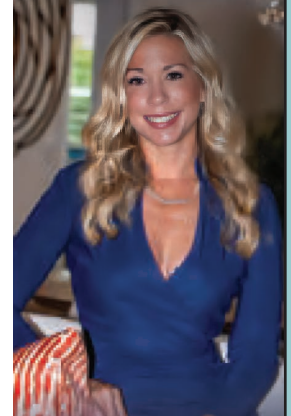
