THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD



The Gospel reading today concludes the Book of Matthew. It was at this point that Jesus, knowing he was about to return to the Father, commissioned the apostles to carry the message of the Good News into the whole world.

They would baptize, make more disciples, and teach the message Jesus had taught them. Jesus made it clear that his ascension did not mark an absence; he would always be with them. This Gospel message is the foundation of the Church and makes clear what we are called to do and be. During the past weeks we have been reminded often by Jesus that he will not leave us alone. Sometimes it's hard to explain to children where someone is who we can't see. Like the people in the early Church we have faith, but we also have doubt. As if it were a scavenger hunt, let family members look for places they find Jesus this week.

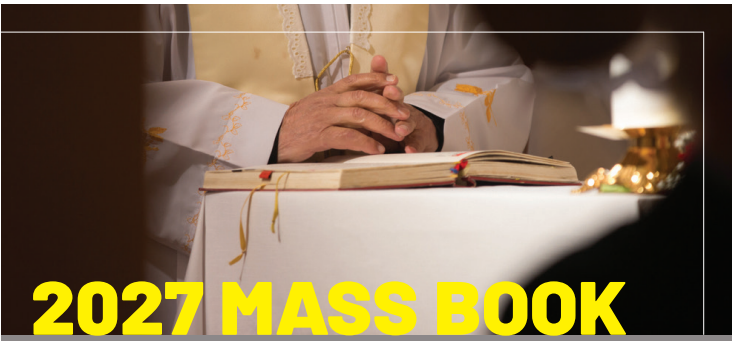

GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

Pentecost
John 20: 19-23

It is a silly distraction to get all curious about how those disciples were able to speak in all those tongues in the Gospel we proclaim next week. That is not the miracle here. It is how a bunch of cowardly and frightened men suddenly got the courage to come out, not peek out, but burst out on fire with news of hope and joy. It stuns me to think of what happens when the Holy Spirit enters into people whose faith has been shaken by tragedy and disappointment. It stuns me to think about what happens when that risen Messiah stands in that locked up room and with a breath drives out fear and brings peace. I am also stunned at how little of that peace has blown around this world, and how few people seem to have enough fire and courage to do anything about it. Pentecost holds the promise of yet another miracle, one that will bring peace from people like us who remember that we have been sent into this wonderful world with the gifts that the Spirit brings. For me, Pentecost is not a date on a calendar. Pentecost is every day because we have all been stunned by grace and by God's mercy. We have been made new, brought to life with nothing to fear. Perhaps we have this date on the calendar simply to remind us, not about what happened to the apostles, but about what can happen to us when we dare to say: Come Holy Spirit.

Why should I become a *member* of a Parish?



Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish, they automatically belong. Membership requires formal enrollment in the parish, but it is more than just filling out some forms. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to participate in the religious, social and ministerial activities of a parish.

Registration not only shows you belong, **but it is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, letters for Immigration, participating in Faith Formation and receiving donation statements for tax purposes.**

Belonging to a parish is a commitment. Just as you want the parish to provide Masses, Sacraments, Faith Formation and ministries, the parish needs to be able to count on you to help and assist in their mission; to be an active member.

Being an active member at St. Agnes involves several key aspects:

- **Registration:** Active members are formally registered in the parish
- **Worship:** Active members attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation (except for illness or emergency)
- **Stewardship:** Active members serve the community in various ways by sharing their time and talent
- **Financial Support:** Active members support the parish financially, using offertory envelopes or online giving (WeShare)

Are you registered with us? One way to know is if you receive regular communications from us, such as offertory envelopes, or occasional emails. If you do not, then perhaps you are not officially registered, or you have been marked as inactive. If you are unsure, please call the parish office.

Registering at St. Agnes is a statement of faith and support in the life and work of our parish. As a faith community, we are here to help each other on our journey of discipleship. Registration forms are found in the Parish Office, at each entrance of the Church, and on our website, stagnesnaples.org.



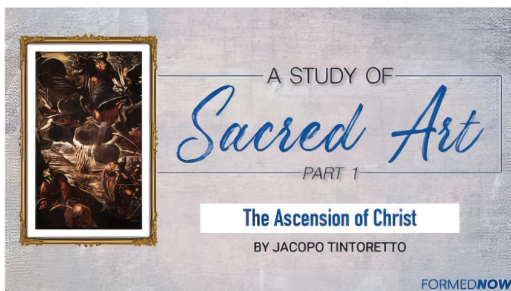

Formerly called Last Rites or Extreme Unction, this Sacrament is for those experiencing a serious illness, facing an operation or dying. Anointing of the Sick should be performed before death is imminent, when a person is conscious and able to receive comfort from the sacrament.

We make every effort to provide pastoral care and the sacrament of anointing to all who request it; however, families are encouraged to call sooner rather than later. If a loved one is at home and needs the sacrament, please call the office at 592-1949 to arrange for a priest to visit.

In the Hospital?

Please ask the nurse to contact the parish that serves the Hospital you are in for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick.

This is the most efficient way to be sure you or your loved one will receive the sacrament. Be aware that because of HIPAA

Privacy regulations, hospitals do not necessarily notify the parish regarding your hospitalization unless requested by the patient.

San Marcos es el evangelista que tiene el más corto de los 4 evangelios: solo 16 capítulos.

San Marcos era primo de San Bernabé y acompañó a éste y a San Pablo en el primer viaje misionero que hicieron estos dos apóstoles. Pero al llegar a las regiones donde había muchos guerrilleros y atracadores, donde según las palabras de San Pablo: "había peligro de ladrones, peligro de asaltos en los caminos, peligro de asaltos en la soledad, Marcos se atemorizó y se apartó de los dos misioneros y se volvió a su patria. En el segundo viaje, Bernabé quiso llevar nuevamente a su primo Marcos, pero San Pablo se opuso, diciendo que no ofrecía garantías de perseverancia para resistir los peligros y las dificultades del viaje. Esto hizo que los dos apóstoles se separaran y se fuera cada uno por su lado a misionar. Después San Marcos llegó a ser el secretario y hombre de confianza de San Pedro. Como le escuchaba siempre sus sermones que no eran sino recordar los hechos y las palabras de Jesús, Marcos fue aprendiéndolos muy bien y dicen que a pedido de los cristianos de Roma escribió lo que acerca de Jesucristo había oído predicar al apóstol. Esto es lo que se llama "Evangelio según San Marcos". El evangelio de San Marcos es una repetición de los que el Apóstol Pedro predicaba. Sus narraciones son agradables por lo frescas y espontáneas. Parece un reportero gráfico narrando lo que sus ojos vieron y sus oídos escucharon. Presenta atractivos cuadros: gestos, miradas, sentimientos de Jesús. Parece que fue el primer evangelio que se escribió y de este sacaron mucho material los otros evangelistas. San Pedro llama a Marcos en sus cartas "Hijo mío", San Pablo, desde la prisión, lo manda a llamar porque necesita su colaboración, dicen los historiadores que fue un compañero muy apreciado por los dos apóstoles. San Marcos fue nombrado Obispo en Alejandría en Egipto, ciudad donde fue martirizado. La ciudad de Venecia (Italia) lo eligió patrono y construyó en su honor la bellísima Catedral de San Marcos .



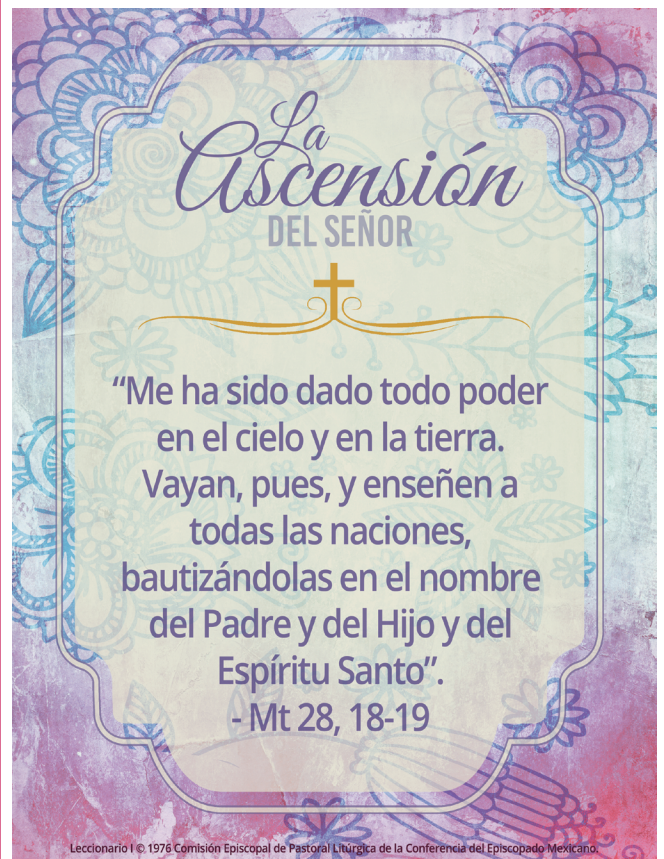

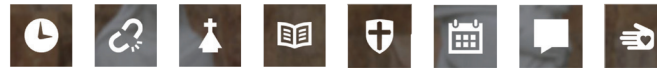

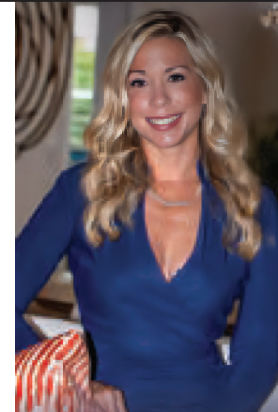
