**GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY**

**13th Sunday of Ordinary Time**

*Matthew 10: 37-42*

All of us, for all kinds of reasons, find ourselves, now and then, attaching great importance to very unimportant things. Being able to sort that out requires knowing the difference between a want and a need. Needs must be met. It is everyone's natural right, and it becomes immoral to refuse another's need. To refuse someone's right to health care, food, clean water, or even life itself is immoral. Wants are a different thing. They do not have to be met. Of course, life would be more pleasant or comfortable, or even more fun if they were met, but if the wants are not met, nothing really terrible happens. With that in mind, there is really only one great need in life, and that is Salvation. It is the only thing that can ever really last. Everything else, even our deepest relationships, become less important. They are not unimportant, but certainly less. Christ does not call us to leave or ignore our family and friends and embrace an empty life without relationships. He is calling us to a balanced life realizing that nothing is more important than our relationship with God simply because it is on that relationship that everything else begins to depend. It is from that relationship that real good begins to flow, that justice and peace become possible. Any other relationship that endangers it is not worth having.

## STEWARDSHIP

Through prayer, service, work, ministry, and financial support of the Church, we have both the opportunity and the responsibility to give back in gratitude for all that we have received.

Stewardship strengthens our relationship with God and with one another. In thanksgiving for God’s blessings, we offer our first and best gifts in service to Him and His people. Stewardship is our response as active participants in the life and mission of Jesus Christ.

We begin our stewardship journey with prayer, asking God how He desires us to use the gifts He has entrusted to us. As we discover His call, we are invited to serve our parish and community with generosity and joy. (Adapted from *St. Louis Review*)

In today’s Gospel, Matthew lists the names of the Twelve Apostles. The word apostle means “one who is sent.” Jesus sends the Apostles to proclaim the Kingdom of Heaven through both word and action. 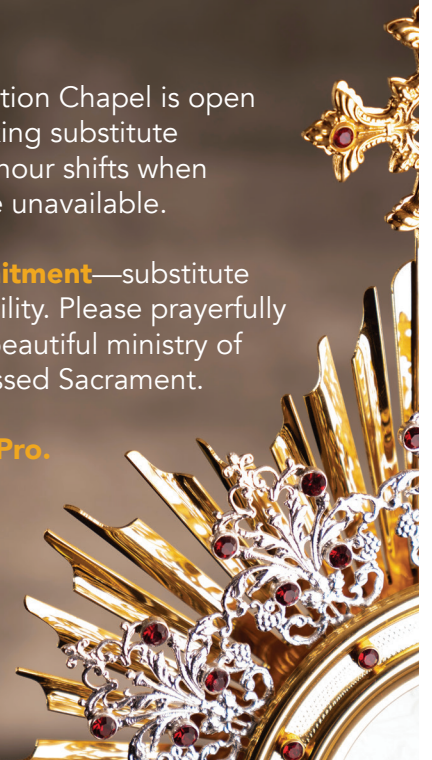

# Why should I become a *member* of a Parish?



Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish, they automatically belong. Membership requires formal enrollment in the parish, but it is more than just filling out some forms. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to participate in the religious, social and ministerial activities of a parish.

Registration not only shows you belong, **but it is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, letters for Immigration, participating in Faith Formation and receiving donation statements for tax purposes.**

**Belonging to a parish is a commitment. Just as you want the parish to provide Masses, Sacraments, Faith Formation and ministries, the parish needs to be able to count on you to help and assist in their mission; to be an active member.**

## **Being an active member at St. Agnes involves several key aspects:**

- **Registration:** Active members are formally registered in the parish
- **Worship:** Active members attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation (except for illness or emergency)
- **Stewardship:** Active members serve the community in various ways by sharing their time and talent
- **Financial Support:** Active members support the parish financially, using offertory envelopes or online giving (WeShare)

**Are you registered with us?** One way to know is if you receive regular communications from us, such as offertory envelopes, or occasional emails. If you do not, then perhaps you are not officially registered, or you have been marked as inactive. If you are unsure, please call the parish office.

**Registering at St. Agnes** is a statement of faith and support in the life and work of our parish. As a faith community, we are here to help each other on our journey of discipleship. Registration forms are found in the Parish Office, at each entrance of the Church, and on our website, [stagnesnaples.org](http://stagnesnaples.org).

San Luis Gonzaga vivió entre 1568 y 1591. Nació en Italia en el seno de una familia aristocrática. Su padre era duque y tuvo una destacada carrera militar. Debido a ello, San Luis estuvo en contacto desde pequeño con el ambiente castrense y adquirió algunos modales rudos propios de la vida militar.

Deseando corregir y suavizar su carácter, sus padres lo pusieron bajo la guía espiritual de San Carlos Borromeo, quien se convirtió en una influencia decisiva en su vida. Fue él quien le dio la Primera Comunión y lo inspiró a cultivar las virtudes cristianas y una profunda vida moral.

Con el tiempo, Luis sintió el llamado a entregarse por completo a Dios e ingresó en la Compañía de Jesús. Como novicio, se distinguió por su fidelidad, obediencia y observancia de las reglas. Rechazaba toda vanidad y se ejercitaba con gusto en los oficios más humildes.

Durante ese tiempo, Roma fue azotada por una grave epidemia. Los jesuitas abrieron un hospital y se dedicaron personalmente al cuidado de los enfermos. San Luis destacó por su entrega como enfermero. Además, recorría la ciudad solicitando limosnas, víveres y abrigo para quienes sufrían necesidad.

Desafortunadamente, contrajo la enfermedad mientras servía a los enfermos, lo que le ocasionó la muerte cuando apenas tenía 23 años de edad.

Su vida fue un ejemplo de obediencia, entrega a Dios y servicio a los más necesitados y desamparados. Por ello alcanzó la santidad. Fue canonizado por el Papa Benedicto XIII en 1726 y posteriormente proclamado Patrono de la Juventud.

San Luis Gonzaga afirmaba que Dios le había concedido un gran fervor para ayudar a los pobres. Por eso se esforzaba constantemente en socorrerlos y en procurarles todo lo necesario para aliviar sus necesidades con prontitud y dedicación. Solía decir: «Cuando uno tiene que vivir pocos años, Dios lo impulsa con mayor fuerza a realizar estas obras», refiriéndose al ejercicio de la caridad.

Asimismo, San Luis cuidó siempre con esmero la pureza de su corazón. Evitaba las ocasiones de pecado y las tentaciones, refugiándose en la oración, la penitencia y las prácticas espirituales.

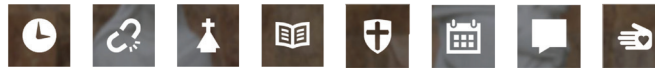

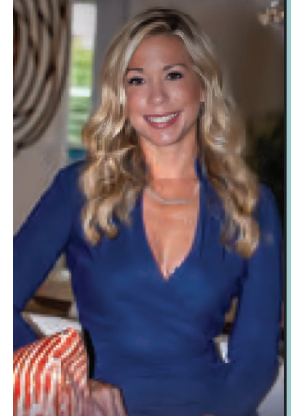

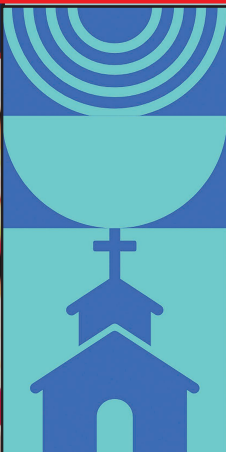
