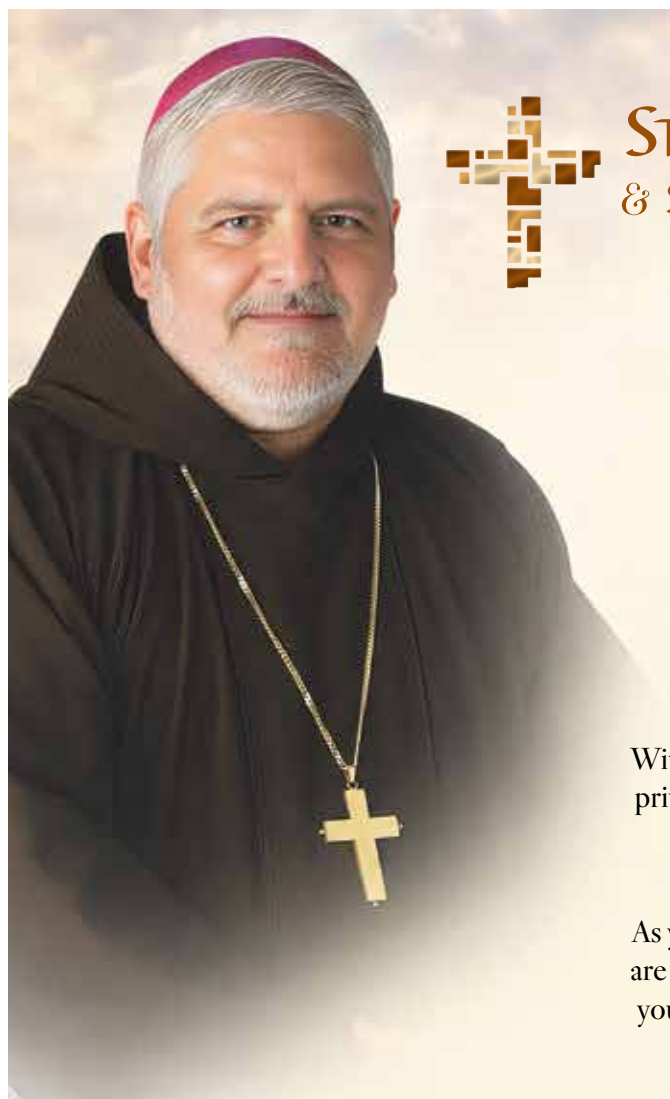

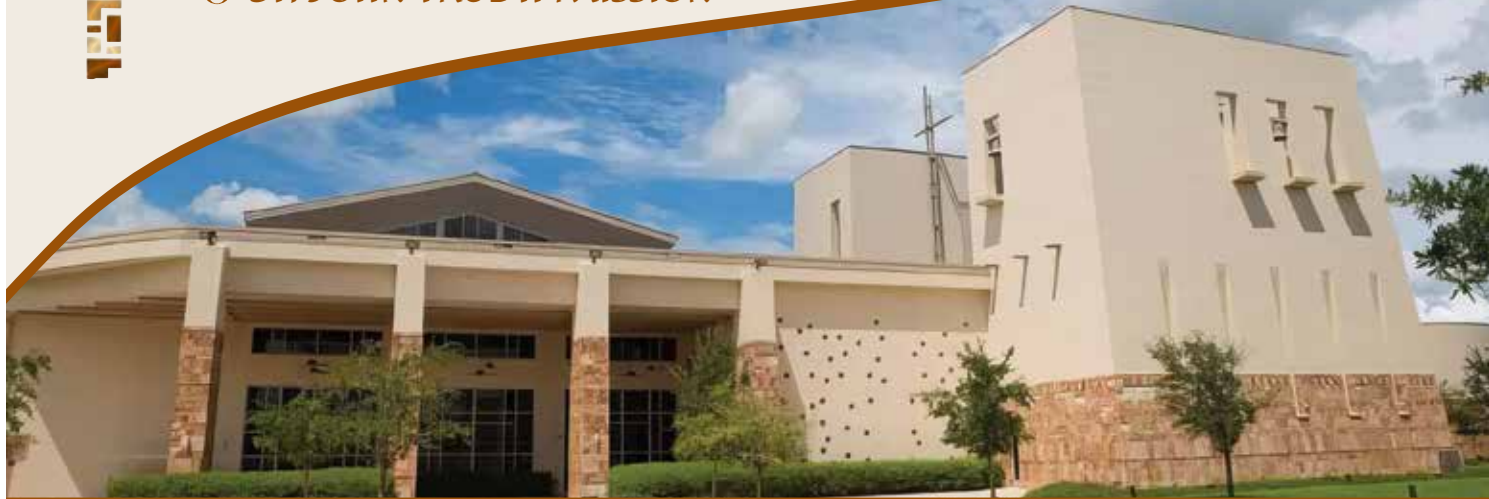

## GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

23rd Sunday of Ordinary Time

*Matthew 18: 15-20*

Something about us always makes us like the idea of binding. We often find that binding easier than loosening. We like being enforcers. The rules are everything, and those who don't keep them should be punished, and we are ready to do it. It makes us feel good which usually distracts us from our own rule breaking. As long as we can keep people focused on someone else's offences, our own may not show. That seems to be the method of many in leadership positions these days. While the verses we hear next weekend may seem to be an instruction on discipline, it's really not about that at all. What is revealed to us is God's desire for us to take care of each other, help one another and seek what is best for us all as we make our way to the Father. This is the way to make sure that no one is lost. We have been created to live in unity with God and with each other. We can know that because God's only Son removed everything that separated and divided us, even death. Two Popes in our life-time have tried to teach us what this Gospel encourages, that the first step toward healing our brokenness, binding up what is broken and gathering in the lost is to listen. Four times that verb shows up in these five verses. If we can listen to each other, there is every chance to discover a brother or sister.

### SPIRITUALITY AND STEWARDSHIP

The spirituality of stewardship is one of the best responses to the problem of declining Sunday Mass attendance. The Eucharist means thanksgiving, and the first step on the road to becoming a good steward is “to receive God’s gifts gratefully.” If we can enrich an “attitude of gratitude” in our own lives and in the lives of the people we love, then we will be on the road to recovery.

Once we rediscover that everything we have is a gift from God, we will be ever more vigilant in our search for ways to thank God for all that He has given us. There is no better way to thank God than to gather with our fellow believers, acknowledge our sinfulness, give glory to God, open our minds and hearts to His Word proclaimed, offer our gifts, pray together that those gifts may be transformed into the Body and Blood of Christ, receive Holy Communion, and then be sent forth into a waiting world with the message that God gives us the gift of His love.

The Second Vatican Council, in its Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, reminds us: “The liturgy is the summit toward which the activity of the Church is directed; at the same time, it is the fountain from which all her power flows” (#10).

It has been many years since the Council issued its teaching on the liturgy. Much has been done to restore the liturgy to its significant role in the life of the Church. Yet more remains to be done until the vision of “full, active, and conscious” participation in the Mass becomes the norm rather than the exception.

It is impossible to actively participate in the celebration of the Mass without having our hearts filled with gratitude. Whenever we gather to celebrate the Eucharist, we come to give thanks to God for all His gifts—and a miracle happens. We come to give thanks, we receive even more gifts, and we go forth with even more reasons to be thankful.

The best way to explore the miracle and mystery of the Eucharist is to enter into an extended meditation on what happens when we gather to break bread as the People of God.

Una vez que redescubrimos que todo lo que tenemos es un regalo de Dios, estaremos siempre atentos a buscar maneras de agradecerle por todo lo que nos ha dado. No hay mejor manera de dar gracias a Dios que reunirnos con nuestros hermanos en la fe, reconocer nuestra condición de pecadores, dar gloria a Dios, abrir nuestra mente y nuestro corazón a su Palabra proclamada, ofrecer nuestros dones, orar juntos para que esos dones sean transformados en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo, recibir la Sagrada Comunión y luego ser enviados al mundo que nos espera, llevando el mensaje de que Dios nos concede el don de su amor.

El Concilio Vaticano II, en su Constitución sobre la Sagrada Liturgia, nos recuerda: “La liturgia es la cumbre a la cual tiende la actividad de la Iglesia y, al mismo tiempo, la fuente de donde mana toda su fuerza” (#10).

Han pasado muchos años desde que el Concilio presentó sus enseñanzas sobre la liturgia. Se ha hecho mucho para devolver a la liturgia su papel fundamental en la vida de la Iglesia. Sin embargo, todavía queda mucho por hacer hasta que la visión de una participación “plena, activa y consciente” en la Misa se convierta en la norma y no en la excepción.

Es imposible participar activamente en la celebración de la Misa sin que nuestros corazones se llenen de gratitud. Cada vez que nos reunimos para celebrar la Eucaristía, venimos a dar gracias a Dios por todos sus dones, y sucede un milagro. Venimos a dar gracias, recibimos aún más dones y salimos con todavía más razones para estar agradecidos.

La mejor manera de descubrir el milagro y el misterio de la Eucaristía es entrar en una profunda meditación sobre lo que sucede cuando nos reunimos para partir el pan como Pueblo de Dios.

Iglesia. Fue un brillante orador, filósofo y teólogo, autor de muchos textos entre los que se encuentran la Confesiones y la ciudad de Dios.
