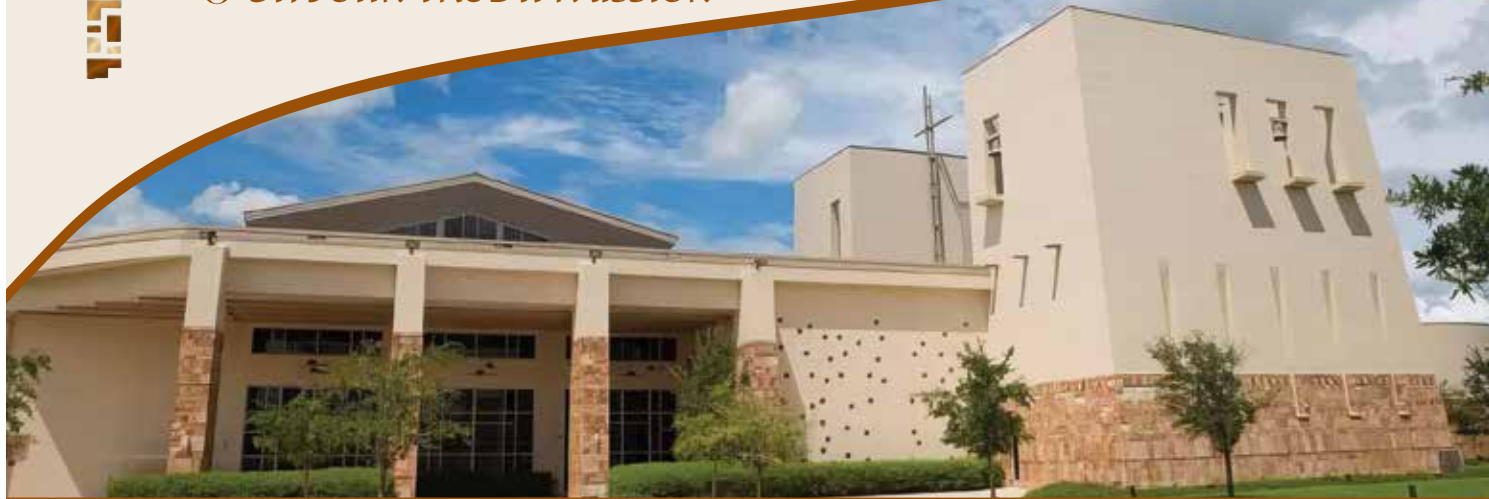

### 23RD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



Jesus set for his followers a three-step procedure for reconciling differences among the community. In the first step we are told to go one-on-one to the person and try to work out the problem. If that doesn't work, we are to take some witnesses, or in the final case, bring the offender before representatives of the Church.

If reconciliation does not occur in the end, there is nothing more we can do and are told to walk away from the person. Reconciling differences is one of the most challenging jobs of parenthood. When our children jump immediately to step three (we sometimes call it tattling), we need to remind them and guide them through the first steps. Our children need to see us model this as well. How often do we fly off the handle and accuse someone of wrongdoing rather than approach him/her rationally.

When our children see us calmly, but firmly, address someone, naming the infraction and saying how the action made us feel, they learn that there are other ways besides hostile confrontation to work out differences.

## GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

**24th Sunday of Ordinary Time**

*Matthew 18: 21-35*

Jesus speaks to us about mercy next weekend which is more healing, deeper and richer than forgiveness. Peter seems to be more into arithmetic than mercy. He ends up looking silly because of it. Forgiveness is a gift, but there is something greater. Mercy goes further than forgiveness because it is undeserved and comes without asking. It is pure gift that cannot be experienced until it is accepted. Forgiveness comes from a humble person. The prideful can never forgive because there is a thirst for revenge and a driving need to be right no matter what, always playing God. Anyone trapped in that mood needs to start praying for mercy. Forgiveness is never a business deal. I'll forgive you if you do this or that. Here is where mercy enters the experience, because with mercy there is no "if". There are no conditions. We give what we hope to receive. Forgiveness, and its motive, mercy, is really a decision we make. It is a decision to be different from the offender, a decision to not let what has been done to me dictate how I act to that person or anyone else for that matter. It is mercy that takes the arithmetic out of Peter's idea of forgiveness. A parable about the Kingdom of God tells us that mercy is for those who are merciful. Those without mercy shall live without the Kingdom of God.

## WHAT DO WE OWN AND WHAT OWNS US?

The accumulation of possessions can become a stumbling block on our spiritual journey. How can we put our possessions to use for the coming Kingdom while setting healthy limits on what we acquire?

### What Owns Us?

Owning possessions places responsibilities and costs upon us. We must maintain them, care for them, pay to acquire them, and find a place to store them. Are our possessions beginning to own us?

### Motivation

Someone once said that we spend the first half of our lives accumulating possessions and the second half giving them away. Why do we accumulate so much? Is it to feel good, find a bargain, feel secure, or simply have more than others?

### Worker Justice

Many of the goods we purchase, or the raw materials used to make them, come from places where workers are exploited. How do our purchasing decisions affect others? Do our choices support fair wages, safe working conditions, and human dignity?

### Stewardship

We are all stewards. We do not truly own anything; all that we have and all that we are is a gift from God. How can we make sure that these resources are used wisely and for the best possible purpose? Can we call on someone to help when we cannot maintain or care for them ourselves?

### Sharing

Many of the possessions we purchase are used only for a short period of time. What could we share with our neighbors so that every household would not need to own the same things?

### Distraction

Some of our possessions can become a distraction from living the life God calls us to lead. In some cases, the pursuit of possessions—or simply searching for the best deal—can itself become a distraction.

### Care for Creation

The material resources we use have an impact on the environment, which in turn affects people, especially those who are poor and vulnerable. How much of the earth's resources are we entitled to use? How can we use God's creation responsibly and leave enough for others and for future generations?
