Dear friends in Christ,

Next Saturday (13th September) we will be holding our Parish Meeting & AGM at 10.00am. Please do try and attend in order to see what is happening in our Parish as well as our vision for the future. We will also be launching our new Parish Handbook and will have different stalls representing the groups we have in our parish. Finally, we will seek the approval of our four new parish councillors, as well as the re-election of the existing Parish Pastoral Council.

This week, we have the two feasts of Our Lady. It is her Birthday on Monday and on Friday, we celebrate the Feast of her Holy Name. This used to be a memoria but has been raised to the rank of a Feast since it was the day when our new united Archdiocese of Cardiff-Menevia was announced last year. As a result, this is the Patronal Feast for the Archdiocese and it is only right that it is celebrated as a Feast.

Next Sunday, we celebrate the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross which replaces the $24^{\rm th}$ Sunday in Ordinary Time. It commemorates the finding of the true Cross by St Helena in 326. The importance of celebrating the Holy Cross for Christians is twofold: we can rejoice that something so terrible has been transformed into a means of redemption for the whole human race. Secondly, we are reminded that Christianity is not an abstract religion. It springs from God's direct intervention in the affairs of the world, a real historical event involving real people and, in the end, a real execution on a real cross.

The monks of Belmont Abbey have been invited to sing Ecumenical Vespers at Tintern Abbey on this Feast Day at 3.00pm. As a result, there will be no celebration of Vespers and Benediction in the Abbey Church next Sunday.
