<b>Advanced Life Support 2</b>	<b>(ALS-2)</b>	<b>\$2,750.00</b>
<b>Specialty Care Transport</b>	<b>(SCT)</b>	<b>\$3,250.00</b>
<b>Loaded Mileage Rate</b>		<b>\$30.00/MILE</b>
<b>Treatment and No Transport</b>		<b>\$360.00</b>
<b>ALS Disposable Fee</b>		<b>\$200.00</b>
<b>BLS Disposable Fee</b>		<b>\$150.00</b>
<b>Oxygen Fee</b>		<b>\$10.00</b>
