### WHEN DOES WINTER SEASON START?



- Winter season commences April 22 (After-School Wednesdays) & Saturday 2nd May 2026 to Sunday 6th September 2026 (U8-U20 Domestic Comp)
- We aim to announce teams by the 18th April in the absence of any delays
- Training typically commences the week prior to the season commencing pending court allocations from Mckinnon Basketball Association

### I'VE REGISTERED - NOW WHAT?



- It takes time to organise our teams & court allocation
- We will be in touch around 1 week before the season begins
- We will then advise of your team, and training times & venues
- We know it's difficult when you may have other kids and other activities but we need time to work through logistics so your patience is greatly appreciated
- We typically play across: Bentleigh, Brighton & Mckinnon Secondary, GESAC, Cheltenham, Coatesville, Carnegie & Tucker Road Primary Schools (others TBC)

## FEES

- Domestic Weekend Comp: \$447.50 per season (2 terms)
- This includes Carnegie Chargers club fee of \$330 and MBA player fees of \$117.50
- An additional service fee will be charged at checkout. This is in addition to the above quoted fees
- After-School Wednesday U8 & U10 (VOFS): \$527.50 per season.
- This includes Carnegie Chargers club fee of \$380 and MBA player fees of \$147.50
- An additional PlayHQ service fee will be charged at checkout.



## IS THERE A DISCOUNT FOR A SIBLING?

- YES!
- A sibling discount of 8% is automatically applied at checkout

## WHAT'S THE TIME COMMITMENT?

- Weekly training and game
- Boys play games on Saturday and Girls play on Sunday.
- Game times vary each week. Game times can be found via PlayHQ and your Team Manager
- Please ensure your child is on time, and in correct uniform



## WHAT AGE GROUP DO I REGISTER MY CHILD IN?

- Under 8's: Child is born 2020/2019
- Under 10's: Child is born 2018/2017
- Under 12's: Child is born 2016/2015
- Under 14's: Child is born 2014/2013
- Under 16's: Child is born 2012/2011
- Under 18's: Child is born 2010/2009
- Under 20's: Child is born 2008/2007 (Boys)
- Open: 2007 and 2008 GIRLS move to open comp
