# Safety to OTAP

Before entering our park grounds you must first go over the rules. Please Note and Understand that we take safety at our park seriously and will not tolerate any unsafe activities that may result in injury.

# The Rules are as follows:

- 1. When on the Field, Keep Your Mask On.
  - Your Mask will protect your eyes as well as your mouth.
  - We at OTAP would like it if you left our park able to see and eat solid foods.
- 2. 10ft Rule (Depending on Experience)
  - When firing upon a player, please ensure that your distance is more than 10 feet.
  - At 10ft we ask that you ask the player to surrender. (Please see Surrender rule)
  - Giving the player the chance to surrender always shows true sportsmanship.
- 3. No Blind-Firing.
  - Player must be able to see the opposing player from behind the barrel of his/her marker.
  - Hiding behind a barrier and pointing the marker down lanes is not allowed.
  - If caught doing this action, it will result in a call out of the player doing the action.
- 4. 90 Degree Rule.
  - Do not shoot directly up or directly down on someone.
  - The mask only protects the front of the face.
  - Firing directly on top of the head may cause a concussion, and shooting directly underneath the head may cause a choking hazard.
- 5. Barrel Bags
  - Barrel Bags must be on in the pavillon area.
  - The only time barrel bags come off is to play on the map of the reffs choosing.
  - To keep all guests safe, you must follow the barrel bag rule for the safety of ALL PERSONNEL
- 6. No Crack (Hole) Shooting
  - At no time, firing through a crack will not be sportsmanlike.
  - You must fire through a window opening.
  - IF a player shoots from out in the opening, and the projectile goes through the crack smaller than a window, and breaks on the opposing player, the player is hit.

### 7. Call 'Paint Check'

- When a player is hit, Player can call 'paint check' to a ref for an inspection.
- Know this does not stop game play. Player is still an active player and can still fire or be fired upon after calling 'paint check'
- 'Paint Check' can be used to check a player you think you hit.
- Call paintcheck and inform the ref the direction the other player is in.

#### 8. 'Cease Fire'

- When a cease fire is being called, put barrel bags on and take a knee.
- 'Cease Fires' will be called for the following reasons.
  - o Fire started by smoke or grenade
  - Emergency Due To Injury
  - Large Misunderstandings
  - Lighting Strike in the sky
  - Tree Falling
  - o Flooding
  - o Storm
- When called, it is required for all guests to listen to the ref at that time. Safety is priority.

### 9. No Cheating

- Anyone caught cheating will be removed from play for the day.
- The first warning and last warning is given in the beginning of the day with the safety brief.
