Roche Bobois St. Pete Tower: French Design Meets Florida Luxury

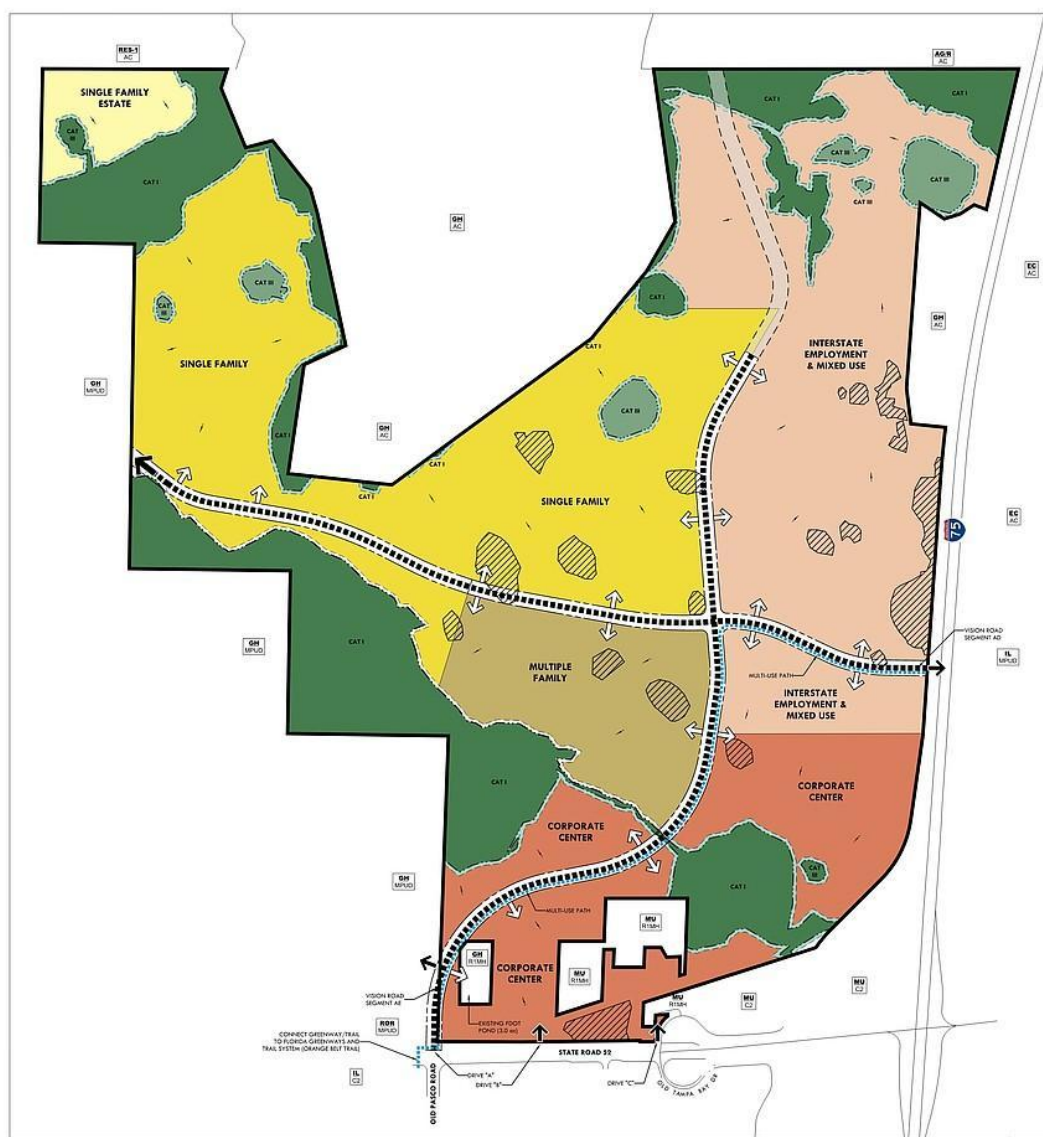


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A site plan for the 785-acre Kinfield development in Pasco County.

The southern counties of the Tampa Bay area are not to be outdone, with their own large-scale developments that are attracting new residents and transforming the landscape.

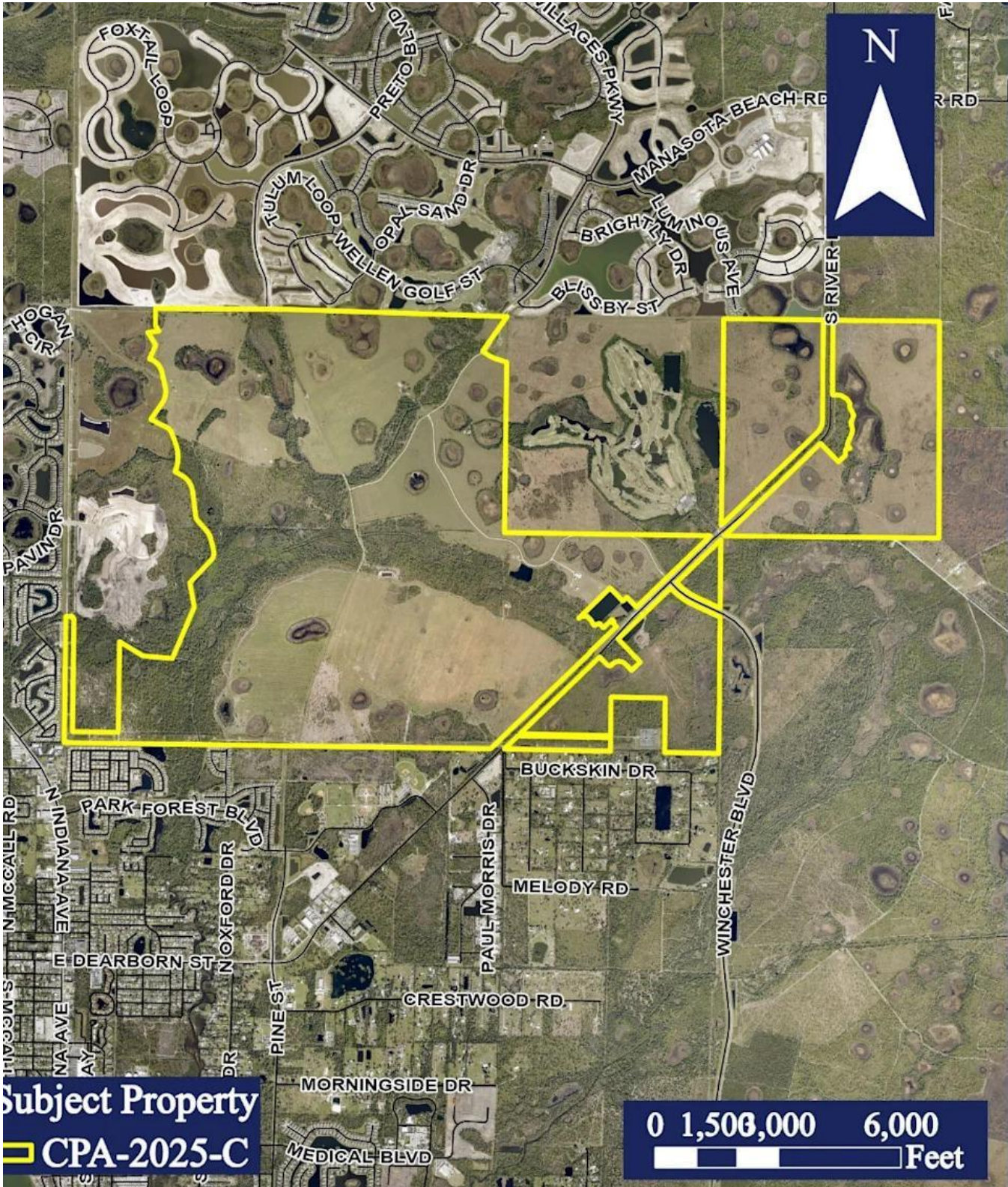


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An aerial map of the proposed Winchester Ranch development site.
