# Joining instructions for Muirtown (Top lock), Inverness

We will be ready to welcome you aboard between 2.00 and 2.15 pm on the Saturday at the start of your cruise. Please try not to arrive before 2pm - our 'turnaround' time is short and busy and we may not be available to give you the welcome we'd like to.

## From Edinburgh & the South

### BY CAR

- Inverness is reached by the A9 via Perth. Travel on the A9 with the city to your left. At the roundabout, before the Kessock Bridge, take 1<sup>st</sup> left off the A9 and follow the signs into the city centre. Go straight over two roundabouts and on the third follow the 4<sup>th</sup> exit and the A862 to Beaulay (Telford Street). Look for a roundabout with a PC World store on the left and a Co-op to the right. Go straight across this roundabout and after about 100 yards cross a small bridge which crosses the canal. Then take the 1<sup>st</sup> left immediately after the bridge along Canal Road. Fingal / Ros Crana will be moored at the top of Muirtown flight of locks which are on the left-hand side.

## From Glasgow/Fort William

- take the A82 along the Great Glen through Spean Bridge and Fort Augustus. Shortly after passing the "Welcome to Inverness City" sign post take the 1<sup>st</sup> left on to the General Booth Road, signposted for Beaulay and just before the Torvean Golf Club small car park on the right. Follow this road for just over a mile. The road changes its name to King Brude Road after a set of traffic lights. Turn first right, after the lights, on to Canal Road which goes down hill to the canal at the top of Muirtown Locks where Fingal / Ros Crana will be moored. Unload at the barge and we will direct you to the secure parking nearby at Muirtown Basin.

## Other Transport

### BY RAIL

- The rail journey to Inverness is via Edinburgh and passes through interesting and dramatic scenery as well as going over the famous Forth Bridge. The railway station is in Inverness city centre about a mile from Ros Crana' / Fingal's berth at the canal. Taxis can be taken from outside the station, ask for the Top of Muirtown Locks, Canal Road (not Muirtown Basin).

### BY BUS/COACH

- There is a coach service from Edinburgh to Inverness. The bus station is near to the train station in Inverness town centre, about a mile from Ros Crana' / Fingal's berth at the canal. Taxis can be taken from the bus station, ask for the Top of Muirtown Locks, Canal Road (not Muirtown Basin).

### BY AIR

- There are airports at Glasgow and Edinburgh but the nearest is Inverness Airport - about 12 miles out of town off the A96 Nairn road. See our 'Useful Contacts' sheet for relevant airlines. Take a taxi from the airport or a bus into town followed by a taxi to the Top of Muirtown Locks, Canal Road (not Muirtown Basin) where Fingal / Ros Crana will be moored.

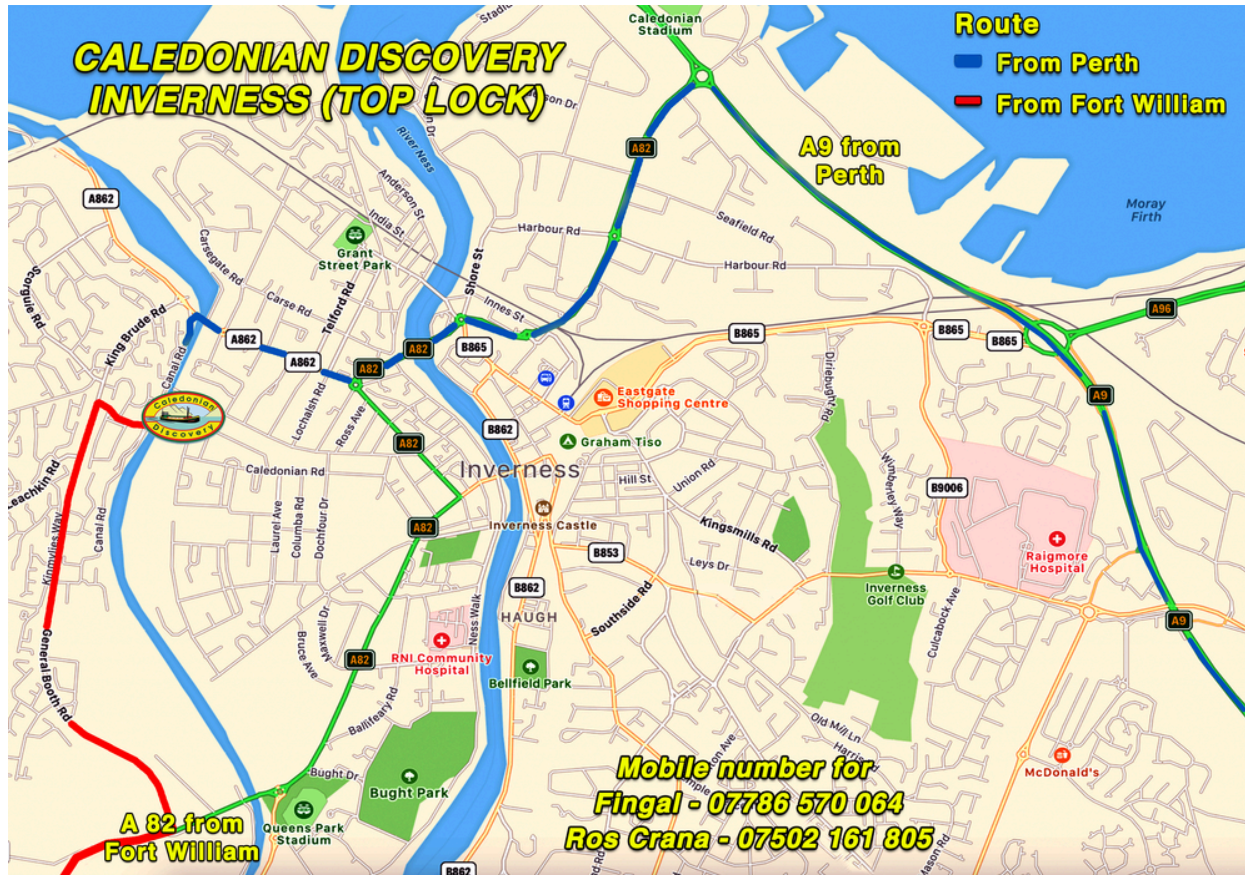
## Journey's End
