



## Discover Loch Ness Cruise Sample Itinerary Inverness to Fort Augustus

This holiday offers an opportunity to really appreciate the uniqueness of the waterway and immediate countryside along the Caledonian Canal, Loch Dochfour and iconic Loch Ness. Our barges, lovingly converted for 12 guests, make the perfect base from which to explore this Scottish Highland waterway and all it has to offer. From the bustling village of Fort Augustus to the capital city of the Highlands – Inverness. Enjoy the space to breathe offered by Loch Ness and the Caledonian Canal.

### Inverness to Dochgarroch

- Day One After arriving on the barge and settling in, the first 5-mile stretch of canal takes us to the small village of Dochgarroch. You have a choice of staying on board to enjoy the views over the city and the River Ness as we cruise to our first overnight stop. Alternatively, you could cycle along the towpath to Dochgarroch to meet up with the barge which will have passed you on route.

### Dochgarroch to Foyers

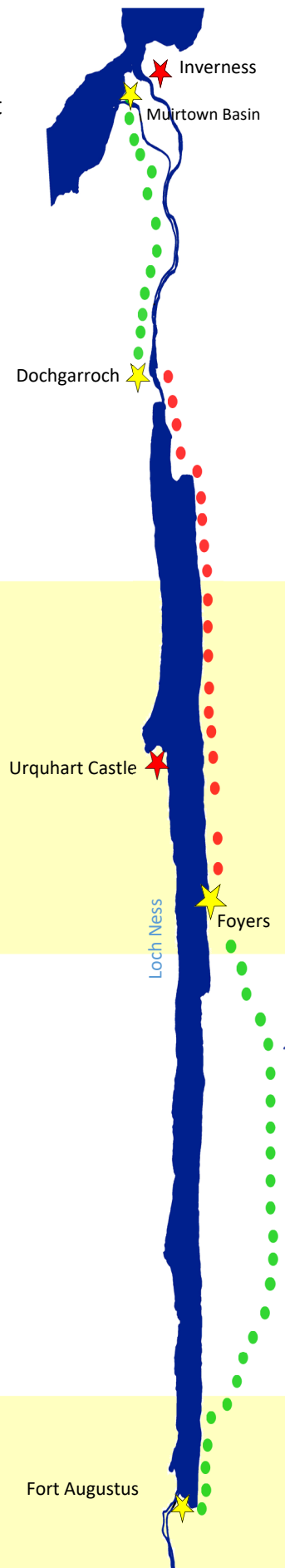
- Day 2 Your first full day aboard will begin with a morning cruise through Loch Dochfour and out onto Loch Ness, taking in Urquhart Castle, one of Scotland's most popular historic sites. We then cruise across the deepest part of Loch Ness, arriving at Foyers around lunchtime. In the afternoon you will have plenty of opportunities to explore ashore and, weather permitting, try your hand at some canoeing. We stay the night at Foyers with superb views across Loch Ness.

### Foyers to Fort Augustus

- Day 3 The morning will start with a choice of either a scenic cruise along the "wild side" of Loch Ness into Fort Augustus. Or for the more adventurous there is an active cycle available, taking a quiet road high above Loch Ness. This trip offers wonderful panoramic views of the Monadhliath hills beyond the glen, before descending back to Loch Ness at Fort Augustus. In the afternoon the barge will make her way through the flight of locks at Fort Augustus, a bustling little village. If you wish to explore some of the surrounding countryside by bike or on foot, our crew will be able to direct you to the best routes for any ability. The barge will stay overnight at the top of the locks.

### Fort Augustus

- Day 4 On the final morning there will be a final chance to stretch your legs and explore the countryside around the town, before returning to the barge for tea and coffee in before the end of the cruise.
