JOB DESCRIPTION

POSITION FUNCTION

TRANSPORTATION OF CLIENTS WHO REQUIRE ASSISTANCE TO ACCESS TO THE HEALTH CENTRE SERVICES AFTERHOURS. BASED AT THE HEALTH SERVICE 3-4 NIGHTS A WEEK WITH A NURSE. BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CLEANING OF THE HEALTH CENTRE AS A SECONDARY DUTY.

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Health Centre Services Primary Responsibilities

The following are the core responsibilities:

- Support the RAN on shift to facilitate the safe and practical transport of clients accessing the Health Centre after hours
- Support the RAN on shift to respond to emergency call outs as directed
- Participate in BLS (Basic Life Support) when needed and be familiar with the location of emergency equipment in the Emergency Room and retrieval vehicle
- Be responsible for the cleaning of the Health Centre in-between clients
- Complete risk assessments to identifying potential hazards, and collaborate with nursing staff to plan and implement control measures to address hazards associated with call-outs/home visits
- Check afterhours vehicles (including emergency vehicle) and associated equipment to ensure safe working function at all times
- Equipment cleaning and maintenance
- Provide immediate response to assist in managing aggressive individuals and related security incidents within or around the Clinic
- Ensure patient privacy and dignity is considered and maintained at all times
- Provide excellent, helpful service to patients, visitors and staff
- Actively seek to understand patients and their families' expectations and issues
- Provide general assistance in the Clinic as requested/required
- Assisting with setting up clinical rooms ready for patients



Health Centre Cleaning

- Cleaning clinical rooms and other designated areas of the Clinic ensuring a safe and hygienic environment for staff and patients by maintaining the cleanliness of the clinic floors, rooms, bathrooms and furniture. Ensure where applicable areas are:
 - Vacuumed
 - Damp mopped
 - Damp dusted
- Safely empty and subsequently clean clinical and general waste bins, ensuring waste is placed in the appropriate receptacle
- Adhere to the periodic cleaning schedule, ensuring all activities are completed
- Use cleaning equipment in a safe and effective manner, adhering to manufacturer's instructions
- Replenish all consumable items (soap, hand towels, toilet roll etc.) as required
- Adhere to the colour coding system for cleaning equipment at all times, seeking appropriate guidance if required
- Ensure all cleaning materials are stored in a safe and secure manner, adhering to WHS legislative acts and guidance
- Report any defects found during the cleaning process to line management in a timely manner
- Ensure Infection Prevention and Control measures are maintained at all times as per local policies and procedures to ensure a safe and hygienic environment for staff and clients.
- Reporting any maintenance or repair needs to the Clinical Operations Coordinator
- Security checks of building

Information Systems

- Adhere to the information technology policies of Mala'la Health Service

Professional Development

- Participate in appropriate professional development to maintain and develop professional expertise, skill and knowledge
- Emergency response
- Infection Prevention and control

Work, Health and Safety

- Minimise risks to self and patient through consistent adherence to safe manual handling principles and infection prevention and control guidelines in completion of all duties.
- Be familiar with and apply safety guidelines, policies and procedures
- Report safety hazards within the workplace
- Identify and assist in rectifying safety hazards within the workplace environment
- Remaining calm and effectively promoting the safety of patients, staff and visitors, when dealing with people who are, or may become, aggressive or violent



Mandatory Requirements

- Satisfactory Criminal History Check
- Current NT Working with Children Clearance Ochre card
- Confidentiality is a mandatory requirement; any breach of this requirement may compromise ongoing employment
- Compliance with all policies and procedures of Mala’la Health Service
- Report to the CEO immediately of any personal criminal charges or convictions that arise
- Participate in annual essential training
- Participate in annual performance review with the Workforce Coordinator

- Satisfactory Criminal History Check
- Current NT WWCC Ochre card
- Experience working and communicating with people, having a friendly and respectful approach to work sensitively within a cross cultural setting
- Demonstrate and adhere to safe work practices at all times
- Adhere to work procedures and be willing to embrace change
- Be committed to the delivery of safe patient centered care

Desirable

- Experience working within an Aboriginal Medical Service
- Experience living in a remote Aboriginal community
- Demonstrated ability to engage and work effectively within a remote Aboriginal community
