AN ORDINANCE TO LEVY AND ASSESS A TAX FOR THE
REDDICK PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICT
OF THE COUNTY OF LASALLE, STATE OF ILLINOIS
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2025 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2026

BE IT ORDAINED, that the Reddick Public Library District of the County of LaSalle and State of Illinois shall levy a tax of .02% of the value of all taxable property within said Library District, for building and maintenance purposes, subject to the right of the electors in said Library District to petition and require an election concerning the imposition of such tax, pursuant to 75 ILCS 16/35-5.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that within fifteen (15) days from the date of adoption of the ordinance, it shall be published in the Times, a newspaper of general circulation in the Reddick Public Library District and it is effective immediately upon adoption.



BE IT ORDAINED, that the Reddick Public Library District of the County of LaSalle and State of Illinois shall levy a tax of .02% of the value of all taxable property within said Library District, for building and maintenance purposes, subject to the right of the electors in said Library District to petition and require an election concerning the imposition of such tax, pursuant to 75 ILCS 16/35-5.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that within fifteen (15) days from the date of adoption of the resolution, it shall be published in the Times, a newspaper of general circulation in the Reddick Public Library District and it is effective immediately upon adoption.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we have hereunder set our hands at Ottawa, Illinois this 14th day of July, 2025.

1. The specific number of voters required to sign a petition requesting that the question of adoption of the ordinance be submitted to the electors of the Library District is 1,661.
2. The petition must be filed on or before August 20, 2025.
3. The referendum would be held March 17, 2026.
