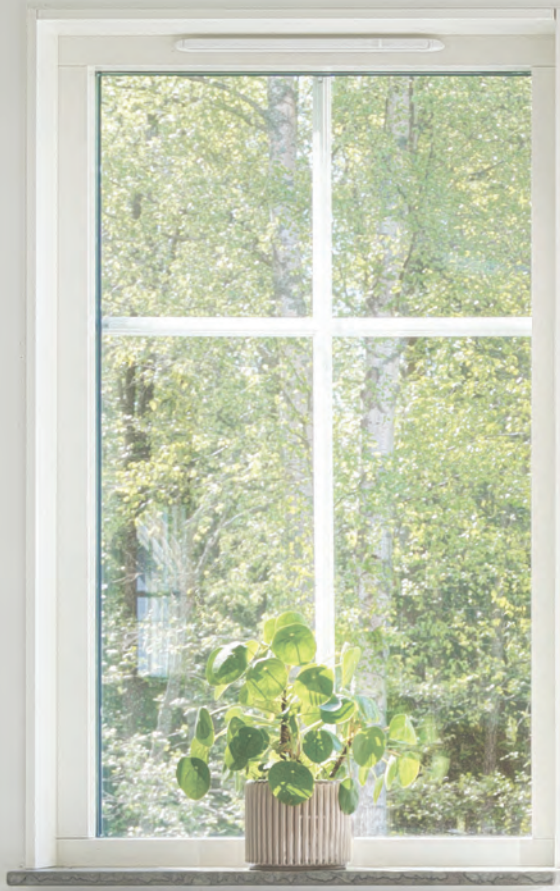

Or you can offer more precise variable-speed performance when you pair it with the new Bryant Smart Thermostat featuring IntelliSense. Either way, you now can offer your mid-tier customers the many benefits of variable-speed technology, including:

HIGH ENERGY EFFICIENCY

The Preferred 249VAN variable-speed heat pump varies heating and cooling capacity to match changing conditions. It delivers high-efficiency indoor comfort – up to 19.0 SEER2 cooling, up to 14.0 EER2 cooling, and up to 10.0 HSPF2 heating. The 249VAN heat pump also provides up to 2.3 COP at 5° F resulting in more budget-friendly heating efficiency.

ENHANCED DEHUMIDIFICATION

The Preferred 249VAN variable-speed heat pump can ease the effects of sticky, humid summers with enhanced dehumidification – especially when compared to single- and two-stage systems. When paired with our new Bryant Smart Thermostat featuring IntelliSense, the system will automatically adjust itself depending on the humidity level inside the home without lowering your temperature setpoint.

OPERATION DOWN TO 25% CAPACITY

Under certain operating conditions, select Preferred 249VAN heat pump models can run at capacities down to 25% to better match changing heating and cooling loads. This reduced-capacity operation helps improve efficiency and enhance summertime humidity control.

LOW-AMBIENT HEATING

The Preferred 249VAN variable-speed heat pump delivers warm indoor comfort – even during the cold days of winter – with low-ambient heating capability down to -10° F. By adjusting its capacity based on changing indoor and outdoor conditions, it can provide significantly higher heating output compared to single- and two-stage systems.

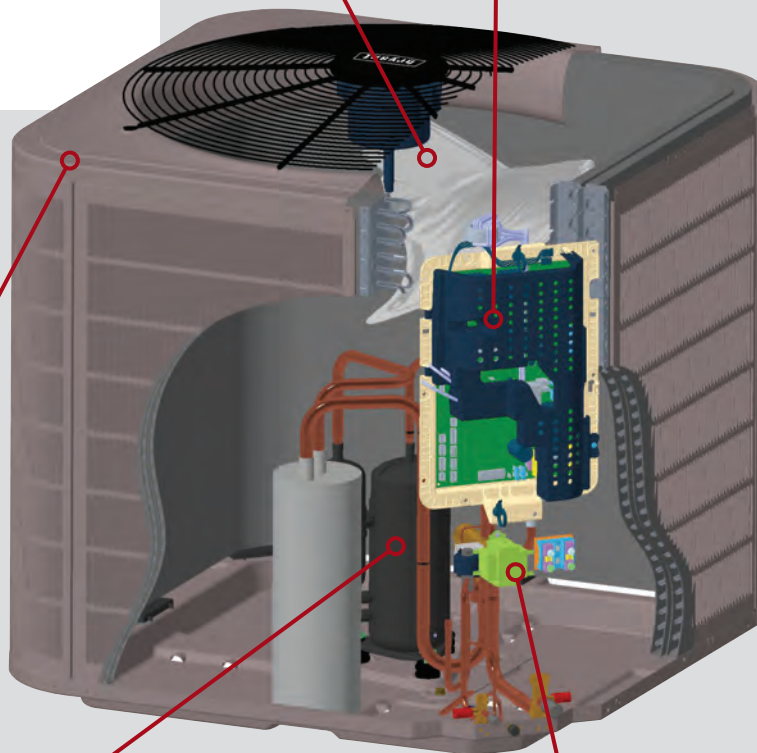

To unlock our patent-pending PerfectAdjust feature - a more precise variable-speed experience with 21 adaptable stages of heating and cooling - pair the Preferred 249VAN variable-speed heat pump with the IntelliSense-enabled Bryant Smart Thermostat. This patent-pending technology delivers extra-consistent comfort with minimal variance from the thermostat's setpoint.

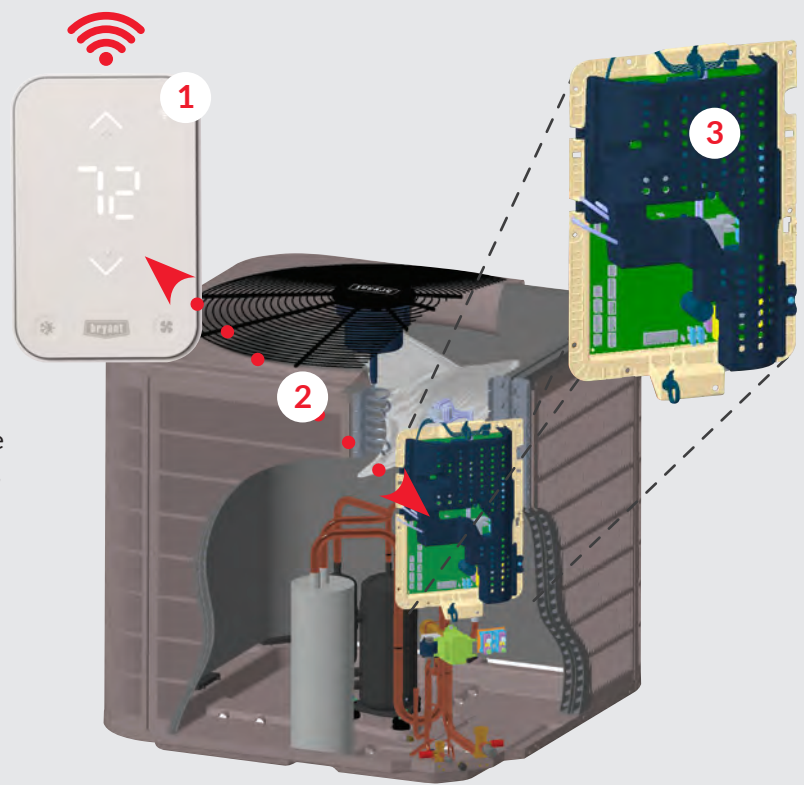
OPTION 2 - FIVE ADAPTABLE STAGES

With any 24V thermostat that can control a two-stage heat pump...

The Preferred 249VAN variable-speed heat pump includes built-in logic that allows it to operate at five adaptable compressor stages, based on outdoor temperature, using Y1 and Y2 signals with any 24V thermostat that can control a two-stage heat pump. This meets industry-defined standards for what can be called a variable-speed unit.

PERFECTADJUST - HOW IT WORKS

- 1 Establish a secure connection -**
The new Bryant Smart Thermostat featuring IntelliSense establishes a connection with the outdoor unit, including cybersecurity verification to authenticate that it's a Bryant thermostat. This authentication allows the system to "fine tune" operation to control 21 adaptable stages of comfort.
- 2 Current/desired conditions data transmission -**
Every thirty seconds, current temperature, desired temperature, current humidity and desired humidity are sent encrypted from the thermostat to the heat pump's primary control module (PCM) microprocessor.
- 3 Microprocessor-controlled staging -**
The heat pump's PCM microprocessor uses an algorithm to determine optimum staging based on the thermostat's data. It sends a command to the Variable-Frequency Drive (VFD) microprocessor to control compressor motor staging.

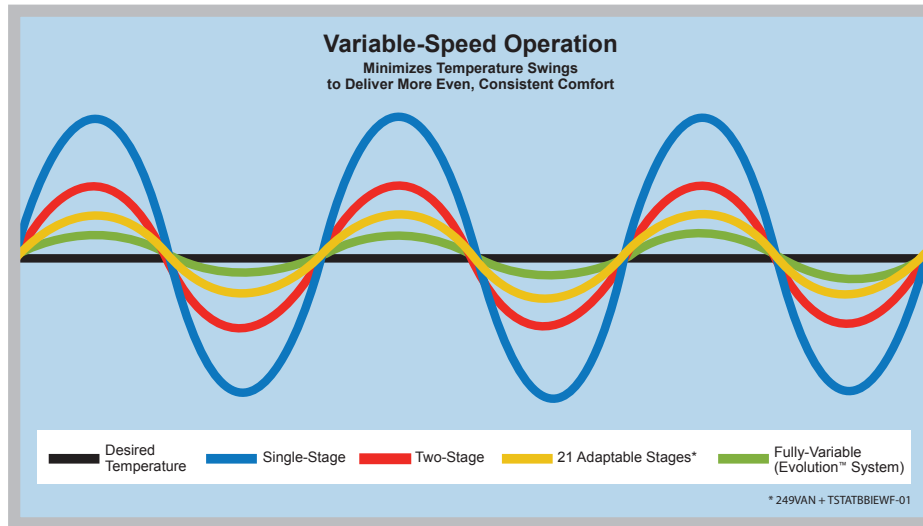


Variable-Speed in the Mid-Tier

With the ability to control staging, our winning combination (249VAN + TSTATBBIEWF-01) can potentially keep the indoor temperature within .25° F (+/-) of the thermostat's setpoint.[†] It also improves efficiency by reducing the compressor speed when the humidity setpoint has been achieved. Homeowners can select their desired indoor humidity, up to 60%, and the system will adjust operation to maintain their comfort preference.

And, while you don't get the same fully-variable precision as Evolution systems, our Preferred 249VAN variable-speed heat pump offers a distinct improvement over our current two-stage products.

† When operating in steady state conditions (constant building load line). If the load changes (e.g., due to OAT changes, opening doors, turning on the oven), then this +/- .25° F will not be maintained.

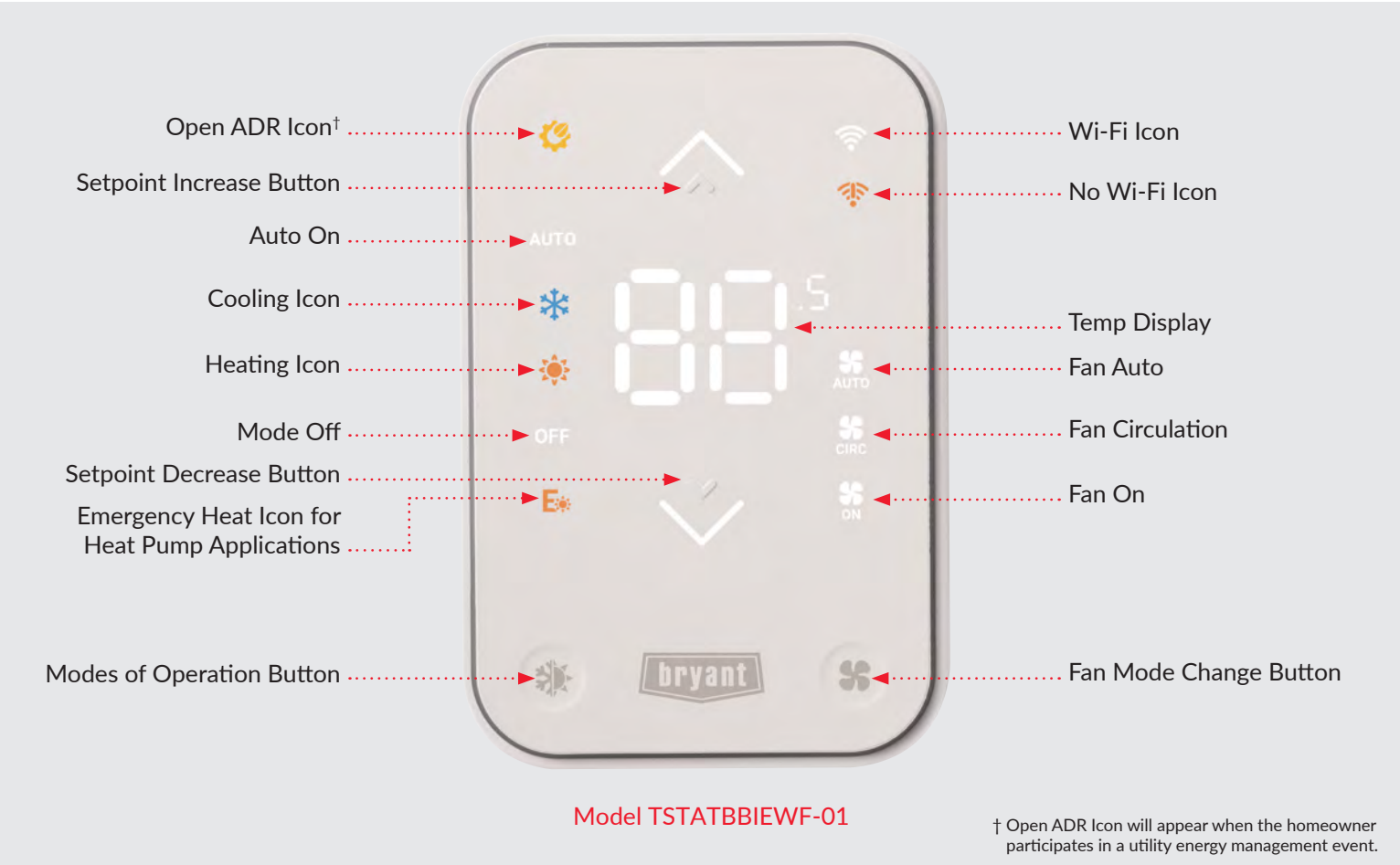

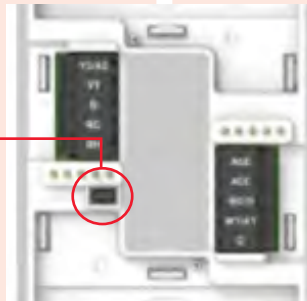

POWER REQUIREMENTS

The Smart Thermostat requires 24VAC connections to the Rh/Rc terminals and the C-terminal for proper operation. It will not operate without these connections. A pre-installed **shunt jumper** connects the Rh and Rc terminals, but can be removed for applications using two 24VAC transformers.

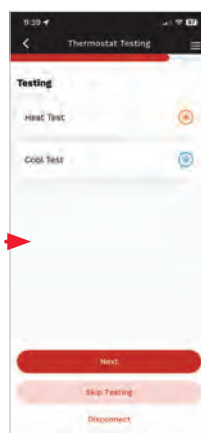
If IntelliSense equipment has been detected (learned by the thermostat), system configuration will automatically populate.

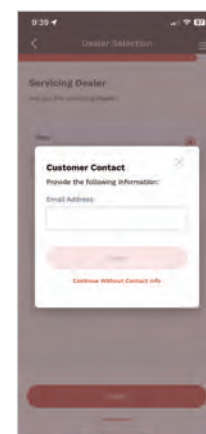
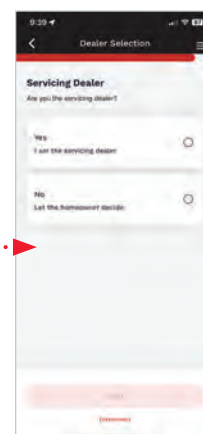
2 CUSTOMIZE SYSTEM SETTINGS

Accept the factory default settings, or customize system settings to optimize airflow, heating/cooling stages, overcool setpoints, lockout, deadband, and more. Available settings will populate based upon the installed HVAC equipment.



3 OPTIONAL TESTING

Once settings are finalized, the app can conveniently guide you through your heating, auxiliary heat and cooling tests. You will still have to check supply vent temperatures to confirm proper operation. Troubleshooting help is available through the app if needed.



4 SERVICING DEALER INFORMATION & THE BRYANT SMARTHOME APP



Take advantage of the digital capabilities by associating yourself with the Smart Thermostat. At that point, you will want to guide the homeowner on how to grant permissions to data sharing via the Bryant SmartHome app, which will allow you to access system operation data through the Connected Portal and Service Tech app.

By completing the system setup through the Service Tech app, you can ensure optimum system operation for improved customer comfort and satisfaction.

THE INTELISENSE EQUIPMENT LEARNING PROCESS

If IntelliSense equipment is present, follow the instructions in the Service Tech app for learning the equipment so the IntelliSense data can be viewed on the digital tools. However, to truly take advantage of its variable-speed nature, pair it with the new IntelliSense-enabled Bryant Smart Thermostat. While competitive thermostats allow for variable-speed operation, they are limited to five adaptable stages. When paired with the new IntelliSense-enabled Bryant Smart Thermostat, the Preferred 249VAN heat pump is capable of 21 adaptable stages to meet building capacity and comfort with much greater precision. It also gives you the ability to remotely view system health using the Connected Portal or the Service Tech app when data sharing permissions are granted by the homeowner.
- 2** Will the Preferred 249VAN variable-speed heat pump be less expensive than other Bryant variable-speed heat pumps?

The Preferred 249VAN variable-speed heat pump was developed to deliver premium comfort at a less than premium price point and is launching with a cost comparable to Bryant's current Preferred two-stage heat pump. Meaning, the Preferred variable-speed heat pump will be priced lower than a Bryant Evolution System heat pump.
- 3** Does the Preferred 249VAN variable-speed heat pump replace other heat pumps offered?

The Preferred 249VAN variable-speed heat pump will be a new addition to Bryant's existing mid-tier heat pump lineup. While Bryant is always evaluating product offerings to ensure we provide a concise lineup with solutions for any application, the Preferred 249VAN variable-speed heat pump will not replace any current heat pump model at launch.
- 4** How does the Preferred 249VAN variable-speed heat pump help the homeowner save money?

The Preferred 249VAN variable-speed heat pump can potentially help reduce homeowner operating costs in multiple ways. First, by providing up to 19.0 SEER2 / 14.0 EER2 / 10.0 HPSF2, the homeowner will see better efficiencies than with single- or two-stage equipment in both cooling and heating.* Additionally, variable-speed operation allows for a higher heating capacity in colder environments. The Preferred 249VAN variable-speed heat pump can run comfortably at longer periods of time in the winter months, reducing the reliance on electric strip heating.
- 5** How does the Preferred 249VAN variable-speed heat pump benefit technicians?

The Preferred 249VAN variable-speed heat pump simplifies servicing for field technicians. Thanks to various sensors and the addition of IntelliSense, the heat pump can collect data for diagnosing and troubleshooting via the Connected Portal and Service Tech app. Additionally, the heat pump uses a single board for Defrost, IntelliSense, and VFD, reducing the number of unique service parts. Its design ensures straightforward piping and wiring and helps eliminate guesswork.
- 6** Does the Preferred 249VAN variable-speed heat pump include Advanced Defrost?

Yes. Advanced Defrost monitors the outdoor coil temperature to detect frost build-up on the coil. As long as the coil remains frost-free, heating cycles will continue normally. When frost is detected, the Advanced Defrost cycle is triggered to start. The compressor will run at defrost speed until the frost melts. If frost remains on the coil as the defrost cycle approaches the time limit, the system kicks into "turbo mode." Turbo mode increases the compressor speed to fully defrost the coil within the cycle time. The defrost cycle ends when the coil temperature indicates that the frost has melted. After allowing time for the coil to drain, normal heating operation will resume.
- 7** Is the warranty for the Preferred 249VAN variable-speed heat pump the same as Preferred two-stage and single-stage heat pumps?

- For the homeowner, the new IntelliSense-enabled Bryant Smart Thermostat can be controlled using the existing Bryant SmartHome app. This app is the only way the homeowner can use a mobile device to onboard their thermostat to Wi-Fi, take advantage of the programmable scheduling capabilities, and receive alerts from the thermostat.
- For dealers, full-system commissioning, advanced configuration, and testing are achieved using the Service Tech app. System commissioning must occur before the homeowner can use the Bryant SmartHome app to connect to Wi-Fi.
- 10** What if my customer doesn't want to use the SmartHome app?
- The Smart Thermostat will operate like a basic, simple thermostat. Your customers will be able to set and change the temperature, select heat, cool or auto mode and set fan operation directly with the thermostat at the wall.
- 11** Will IAQ accessories be compatible with the new Smart Thermostat?
- Yes. The new Smart Thermostat can be used to power a humidifier, a dehumidifier or ventilator.
- 12** Does the new Smart Thermostat support conventional two-stage heating and cooling?
- Yes. The new Bryant Smart Thermostat featuring IntelliSense will support any conventional 2H/2C heating and cooling system as well as any conventional 3H/2C heat pump and auxiliary heat system.
- 13** What is the easiest way to add the Bryant Smart Thermostat featuring IntelliSense to the Bryant Connected Portal?
- Installing technicians can claim their dealership as the "servicing dealer" during installation through the Bryant Service Tech app. If they're already logged in then they simply select "Yes, I am the servicing dealer" during the last step of installation. This will link the thermostat to their dealership. If they are installing as a guest, they will be prompted to login when they select "Yes, I am the servicing dealer." This will add the thermostat to their dealership for viewing in the Connected Portal once the homeowner has completed onboarding. *Please Note: To claim your dealership as the servicing dealer, use your HVACpartners.com credentials when prompted to login to the Bryant Service Tech app.*
- 14** Once a Bryant Smart Thermostat featuring IntelliSense is linked to the Bryant Connected Portal, can I see my homeowner's system data?
- Once the homeowner grants permissions for data sharing, system information will appear on the Connected Portal.
- 15** How many wires do I need to install the Bryant Smart Thermostat featuring IntelliSense?
- The number of wires required will vary based upon the type of heating/cooling system and additional factors such as the number of heating/cooling stages. For example, a heat only or cool only system may only require four wires, while a two-stage heat pump with an auxiliary heat source would require seven wires. The most common need for additional wiring when installing the Bryant Smart Thermostat featuring IntelliSense comes from the lack of a C-wire. A C-wire is required to install the Bryant Smart Thermostat featuring IntelliSense. Bryant's new C-wire adapter, TSTATXXZAW-01, works with IntelliSense systems and will give you the flexibility to "create" an additional wire.

- 16** What is IntelliSense?
- IntelliSense is servicing done smarter. It expands on Bryant's mission of improving the connection between you and your customers through the utilization of select Preferred Series equipment data and comfort settings. It begins by adding sensors to the equipment to collect system data. The data is sent from the equipment to the IntelliSense-enabled Bryant Smart Thermostat, and then to the Cloud. Once in the Cloud, it is made available to dealers via the Connected Portal and Service Tech app for remote troubleshooting and system analysis.
- 17** Will the new Bryant Smart Thermostat featuring IntelliSense work with Legacy Line products or competitive products?
- Yes. The new Smart Thermostat will work as a standard 24V thermostat when attached to non-IntelliSense-enabled equipment. However, system data collection is not possible with non-IntelliSense or competitor equipment.
- 18** If a sensor fails will the equipment still run properly?
- Yes. The equipment will still run properly if a sensor fails. A fault code will be sent if a faulty sensor is detected.
- 19** Are zoning applications possible with IntelliSense-enabled equipment?
- No. Zoning is not supported by the IntelliSense system. Data will not appear in the Connected Portal or Service Tech app for systems that have zoning.
