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ORDER AMENDING LAKE LEVEL ORDER

At a session of said Court, held in the Isabella County
Circuit Court, State of Michigan, this 5th day of
March, 2026.

PRESENT: Honorable Eric R. Janes, Circuit Judge

On reading of the filed Petition to Amend Lake Level Order, after full hearing of the
allegations and proofs with respect to the matters set forth:

IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to this Court's continuing jurisdiction under MCL
324.30707(5) the normal levels of Stevenson Lake are established as follows:

- (1) The normal summer level is established at 848.42 feet North American Vertical Datum
of 1988 ("NAVD88"). The normal summer level shall be effective each year from May
1 to October 1, or as late as November 1 if permitted or otherwise authorized by the

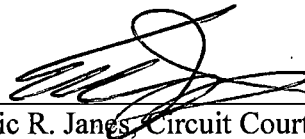
Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy or other applicable or successor state agency ("EGLE").

- (2) The normal winter level is established at 848.12 feet NAVD88. The normal winter level shall be effective each year from October 1, or as late as November 1 if permitted or otherwise authorized by EGLE, to May 1. Isabella County shall commence the drawdown during the month of September but after Labor Day to achieve the normal winter level by October 1 each year. If a later date for the normal winter level is authorized by EGLE, then Isabella County may determine to commence the drawdown on a comparable later date.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the normal levels may be subject to reasonable variations due to reasons such as approved and permitted construction work, weather or natural conditions, and/or permitted operations of lake level infrastructure intended to result in maintaining the normal levels. The normal levels of Stevenson Lake may deviate during any construction activities permitted by EGLE or other applicable or successor state agency.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the boundaries of a Stevenson Lake – Lake Level Special Assessment District are confirmed under MCL 324.30707(5) to finance lake level improvements and activities necessary to maintain the normal levels of Stevenson Lake as permissible under Part 307, Inland Lake Levels, of the Michigan Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, MCL 324.30701 *et seq.* A map depicting the confirmed boundaries of the Stevenson Lake – Lake Level Special Assessment District is attached to this Order as ***Exhibit 1*** and is incorporated herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all permits required by law shall be obtained prior to performing work to achieve or maintain the ordered normal levels of Stevenson Lake. This includes, but is not limited to, permits related to lake level fluctuations under Part 301, Inland Lakes and Streams, of the Michigan Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, MCL 324.30101 *et seq.* All provisions in other valid previous lake level orders for Stevenson Lake that do not conflict with this Order shall remain in full force and effect.



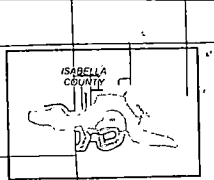

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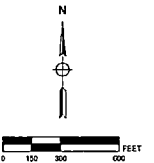
