

TENTATIVE ITINERARY

WEDNESDAY, JULY 22 - DAY 1

- * We will depart from the Lewes, Delaware for Lenox, Massachusetts making rest stops and a lunch stop on your own en route. Welcome to the Berkshires! Serene mountain vistas, lush forests and clear blue lakes define the landscape of this famous western Massachusetts region. Upon arrival we will check in to the lovely **Hampton Inn, Lenox, MA**. Take time to freshen up after our long ride.
- * Tonight, dinner is included at a Berkshire area Restaurant.

THURSDAY, JULY 23 - DAY 2

- * Each morning an **Expanded Continental Breakfast with Hot Choices** is served inside our hotel.
- * This morning we'll travel to the **Berkshire Botanical Gardens**, a 24-acre botanical garden in Stockbridge, MA. We will enjoy a guided tour through the garden collections containing over 3,000 species and varieties, with an emphasis on plants that thrive in the Berkshires.
- * Our next stop brings us to "**The Mount**", the country home of American author Edith Wharton. Wharton designed the house and its grounds and considered it her "first real home". We will enjoy a guided tour of the home followed by a delicious **picnic buffet lunch** served on the terrace. Following lunch we will have a little time to continue exploring the grounds and gift shop.
- * We will now make our way to historic downtown **Lenox, MA** for shopping and free time before heading out to **Hilltop Orchards** for a tour and tasting of Craft Ciders and Wines.
- * Dinner is included this evening at another Berkshire area restaurant.

FRIDAY, JULY 24 - DAY 3

- * Following breakfast we will make our way north to **Williamstown, MA**
- * Visit the **Sterling and Francine Clark Art Institute**. The vast collection includes European and American paintings, sculptures, drawings, photographs and decorative arts. Lunch will be on your own today at the museum.
- * This afternoon we will take in a performance at the **Williamstown Theater Festival** OR have an evening performance at **Jacob's Pillow**. (The performance we attend will depend on the release of the 2026 schedules- neither venue has released their dates for next year)
- * Dinner will be on you own this evening.

SATURDAY, JULY 25 - DAY 4

- * Following breakfast this morning we will make our way to **Tanglewood**, the summer home of the Boston Symphony Orchestra.
- * We'll take a guided tour of the grounds and buildings at **Tanglewood** before taking in a **Musical Performance**.
- * Following the performance we will journey to downtown Stockbridge, MA for lunch and shopping time on your own.
- * This afternoon we will visit the **Norman Rockwell Museum**, where we take in the largest and most significant collection of Rockwell's work.
- * Dinner is included this evening at a local restaurant.

- * After breakfast this morning it will be time to check out of our rooms and say goodbye to the Berkshires.
- * We will begin our journey home making a stop at the **Old Rhinebeck Aerodrome**, located in Red Hook, NY. Trip cancellation & trip interruption

Travel delay
