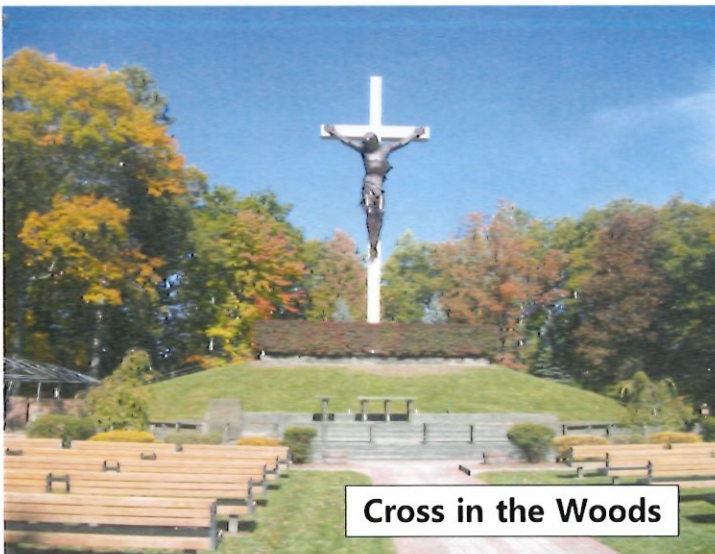

TENTATIVE ITINERARY

FRIDAY, JUNE 18 - DAY 1

- * We will depart from the Lewes Senior Activity Center and travel to Cuyahoga Falls, OH making rest stops and a lunch stop on our en route. Upon arrival we will check in to the **Sheraton Cuyahoga Falls OH** for (1) night.
- * Tonight we'll enjoy dinner at the **Sheraton**.

SATURDAY, JUNE 19 - DAY 2

- * Wake up to a **full hot breakfast at our hotel**.
- * After breakfast we'll continue on to Dearborn, Michigan and home to the Ford Motor Company. Today we are scheduled to visit **The Henry Ford Museum and Greenfield Village**. Set on 254-acres, this is an indoor-outdoor complex that preserves a panorama of American life of the past. Greenfield Village is comprised of more than eighty 18th & 19th century buildings moved here from all over the country.
- * This afternoon we'll check in to the **Hilton Garden Inn, Romulus, Michigan** for (1) night.
- * After checking in we'll enjoy an included **dinner at the Hilton Garden Inn**.

SUNDAY, JUNE 20 - DAY 3

- * Enjoy an **expanded continental breakfast with hot choices** before we check out and depart for **Mackinaw City, Michigan**.
- * This afternoon we board our passenger ferry for transfer over to **Mackinac Island**. Labeled the "Bermuda of the North", Mackinac Island is where "time stood still" from the 19th century. There are no automobiles allowed on the island, just bicycles and horse drawn carriages that are reminiscent of a much simpler time.
- * When we step off the ferry, our **horse-drawn taxi** will be waiting to take us to our home for the next (2) evenings, the magnificent **Grand Hotel**. Since 1887 Grand Hotel beckons guests to a bygone era of old-world hospitality and charm. Experience Afternoon Tea in the parlor, dressing up for dinner, nightly dancing to the sounds of the Grand Hotel Orchestra, and sitting in a rocking chair on the world's longest porch!
- * Tonight sit-down to a **5-Course Dinner in the Main Dining Room** of the Grand Hotel. Dine while enjoying music by the orchestra while overlooking the glistening Straights of Mackinac. You may even catch a glimpse of the bellmen taking down the flags for the day - a sunset tradition.

MONDAY, JUNE 21 - DAY 4

- * Enjoy a **full Breakfast in the Main Dining Room** before we meet our local Horse & Carriage for a **Guided Tour of the Island** featuring many historical sites.
- * Our tour includes admission to **Fort Mackinac** where we will observe demonstrations of Colonial Military life.
- * After returning to the Grand Hotel, lunch will be on your own. The Grand Hotel offers a "Grand Luncheon Experience" which you may choose to purchase. There is also the Gate House Restaurant and the Jockey Club at the Grand Stand available for lunch on property.
- * This afternoon is free time to enjoy the amenities of our hotel.
- * Tonight enjoy another **5-Course Dinner in the Main Dining Room** of the Grand Hotel.

TUESDAY, JUNE 22 - DAY 5

- * This morning enjoy another **full breakfast** in the Main Dining Room before we must check out and be on our way.
- * It's time to board our **carriage taxi** for transfer back to the docks and board our ferry for the mainland.
- * Once back in Mackinaw City, we'll board our motorcoach and depart for Frankenmuth, MI, also called "Little Bavaria". It's a place of horse-drawn carriages, covered bridges and riverboats.
- * On our way to Frankenmuth, we'll make a stop at the **National Shrine of the Cross in the Woods**. The sculpture of the crucified Christ is titled "The Man on the Cross" by the renowned Michigan sculpture Marshall Fredericks. It weighs seven tons and is twenty-eight feet tall from head to toe.
- * When we arrive in Frankenmuth we will visit **Bronner's Christmas Wonderland**, thought to be the world's largest Christmas store! Enjoy some shopping & browsing time, but don't get lost!
- * We'll check in to the famous **Bavarian Inn Lodge** of Frankenmuth.
- * This evening, enjoy a traditional **family-style dinner at the Bavarian Inn Restaurant**.

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 23 - DAY 6

- * Wake up to a **Full German Breakfast** at our hotel.
