



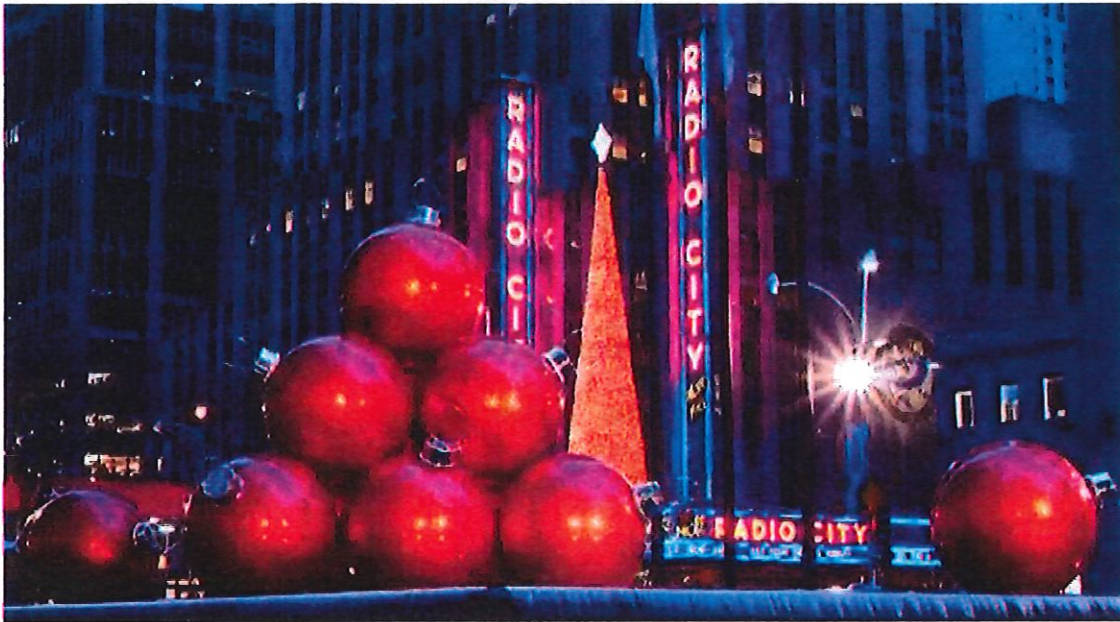

Day 1, Sunday, November 16, 2025

- 8:30am DEPART Lewes Senior Activity Center. Rest stop prior to arrival in NYC.
- 1:00pm Arrive in NYC
- 2:00pm Enjoy **Orchestra** seats to the **Rockettes Christmas Spectacular** at **Radio City Music Hall**.
The Rockettes are the longest-running precision dance company in America! Enjoy colorful costumes, stunning choreography and heartwarming performances including a breathtaking number that transforms the stage into a glistening winter wonderland!
- 3:30pm Show ends. Depart Radio City and head to hotel.
Check in to **Tempo by Hilton New York Times Square** (1568 Broadway)
On-site Restaurant, Fitness Center and free wi-fi.

- 6:15pm Take a brief 5-minute walk to **Hurley's Restaurant & Bar**, restaurant and pub in the heart of the theater district just off Times Square. Enjoy a welcome **DINNER**.

Shop, dine and explore at one of New York's most inspiring locations. Enjoy a bit of free time at Rockefeller Center while the guide checks group in and gets tickets for **Top of the Rock**.
- 9:50am Visit **Top of The Rock**, an experience in history and scenery that culminates with unparalleled views of New York City from the newly renovated Observation Deck on the 70th floor of 30 Rockefeller Plaza, in the heart of midtown Manhattan at Rockefeller Center. There's a certain peace 70 stories above the city. Panels of fully transparent safety glass — the only thing between visitors and the city — are crystal clear for unobstructed, open-air viewing.

- **Stop to see NBC Studios (from the exterior)**. NBC Studios are located in the historic 30 Rockefeller Plaza in the borough of Manhattan, New York City. The building houses the NBC television network

- headquarters, its parent NBC Universal, and NBC's flagship station WNBC, as well as cable news channel MSNBC. Some of the most famous studios include The Today Show, Dateline NBC, NBC Nightly News, Late Night with Jimmy Fallon, Football Night in America, and Saturday Night Live.
 - See **St. Patrick's Cathedral**- the largest decorated gothic-style Catholic Cathedral in the US and has been recognized throughout its history as a center of Catholic life in this country (tour not included).
- 12:30pm Enjoy lunch on your own and free time in **Times Square**. The world's busiest intersection has enough shops, restaurants, digital billboards and theatres to keep you entertained for your entire stay. There you will find Planet Hollywood, M&M's World, Gulliver's Gate, Ripley's Believe It or Not, MTV Studios, Good Morning America, many street performers, vendors, and much more!

- 3:00pm Visit the **Bryant Park Holiday Market** (1065 Avenue of the Americas). Bank of America Winter Village at Bryant Park is Manhattan's winter wonderland. Enjoy New York City's only free admission ice skating rink, the Holiday Shops, and rink-side eats and drinks at The Lodge Deck by Urbanspace. Enjoy an European inspired open-air market hosting artisans from New York City and around the world. Located along Bryant Park's allées, plazas, and terraces, the Shops are housed in custom-designed kiosks.

- 5:00pm Arrive for **DINNER** included at **Ellen's Stardust Diner**. This unique dinner features singing wait staff and variety shows that perform nightly.
