TENTATIVE ITINERARY

MONDAY - DAY 1

- ◆ This morning we'll board our motorcoach and depart for the Buckeye State of Ohio. We will be making rest stops and a lunch stop on your own along the way.
- ◆ We arrive in Canton, Ohio late afternoon and check in to the **Hampton Inn & Suites** for the next four evenings.
- ◆ Tonight we sit down to a delicious plated dinner at **Bender's Tavern**.

TUESDAY - DAY 2

- ◆ Start off with an expanded continental breakfast with hot choices at our hotel this morning.
- ◆ Today, our first stop will be at the **Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens** in Akron, Ohio. Here we will enjoy a guided tour of the 65-room Tudor Revival Manor House followed by time to explore the Gate Lodge, Corbin Conservatory and formal gardens.
- ◆ Next, we make our way to Cleveland for a visit to the **Rock & Roll Hall of Fame**. Take time to explore seven levels dedicated to the roots of rock & roll.
- ◆ Lunch will be on your own today at the café inside the Hall of Fame.
- ◆ After visiting the museum we will take a short walk to the **Voinovich Bicentennial Park** for magnificent views of Lake Erie.
- ◆ Tonight a Dinner Buffet is served at **D'Angelo's Ristorante**

WEDNESDAY - DAY 3

- ◆ Following breakfast this morning we will journey to the **McKinley Presidential Library & Museum** and the McKinley Monument. We take a guided tour through our past, present and future as we visit the museum dedicated to the life of the 25th President of the United States, William McKinley.
- ◆ A plated lunch will be served today at **Menches Brothers Restaurant**, where the hamburger was invented in 1885. Lunch choices today include a Premium Cheeseburger and Fries, Grilled Chicken Sandwich and Fries, Marinated Chicken Salad, Chef Salad, or Veggie Burger
- ◆ This afternoon brings us to the **MAPS Air Museum** run by the Military Aviation Preservation Society. Take a guided tour through the museum housing more than 50 aircraft on loan from the U.S. Air Force or Navy.
- ◆ We finish the day with a sweet visit to **Harry London Candies**.
- ◆ After returning to the hotel, dinner will be on your own this evening

THURSDAY - DAY 4

- ◆ After breakfast this morning we take a short trip to the **Pro Football Hall of Fame**, where you will have the opportunity to learn about the Legends of the Game and experience the interactive exhibits at your leisure.
- ◆ Our next stop will be in Dover at the **Ernest Warther Museum and Gardens**. We begin the visit with a **delightful buffet lunch** before setting out for a guided tour. Learn all about the man dubbed "The World's Master Carver", while visiting the site of his original home, workshop and the first museum opened in his backyard in 1936.
- ◆ A short distance brings us to the **Breitenbach Wine Cellars** where you will have an opportunity to sample several of over 40 varieties of wines. Breitenbach is the exclusive producer of award-winning grape, fresh fruit, berry and Dandelion wines.
- ◆ We then head to **Bunker Hill and Heini's Cheese Chalet**, where we will be met by our local step on guide. Experience the wide selection of cheeses before boarding the coach for a **narrated tour of the Amish Backroads**.
- ◆ We finish our tour with an **Amish Style Wedding dinner** at a private family home. Set atop a picturesque hilltop, enjoy Roasted Chicken, Fresh Vegetables, Handmade Noodles, Breads, Pies and Fresh Squeezed Lemonade.
