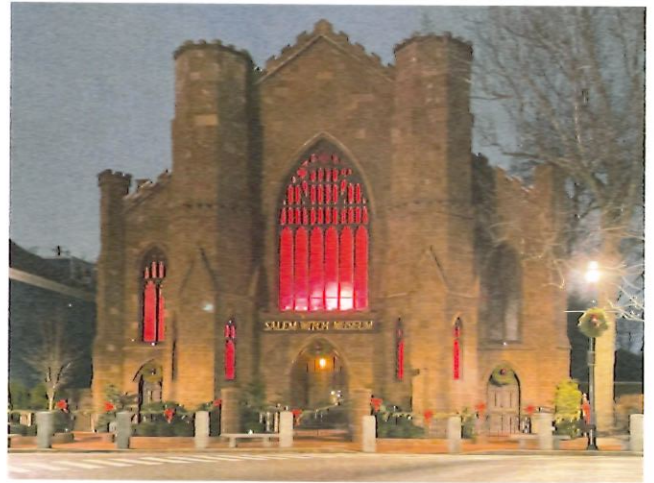

This is a charming not to be missed tour and the house is part of a compound set by the sea with period gardens, outdoor tables and gift shop.

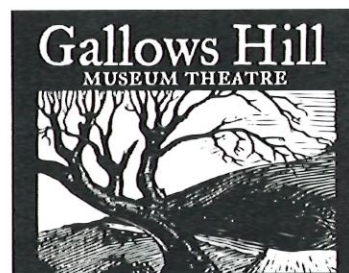
